EXTERMINATES MEALYBUG SUCCESSFULLY

Report by an Expert on E. A. Agriculture.

"The experiments recently conducted with Vermikol, though not extensive, have proved satisfactory These were chiefly on the lines of soil fumigation.

The best results were obtained before or some time after the rains, when the soil was not wet and had a temperature of from 65 to 85 degrees fahr.

The surface soil was levelled round the base of the tree and 2 of an oz. of Vermikol (tully grown coffee tree) was sprinkled round in a continuous band about two inches wide with the inner margin about 4 inches from the bark of the tree: the Vermikol was then covered with soil to the depth of 4 inches and packed well down.

This killed the mealybug on the stem below ground and in some cases kept off the ants
