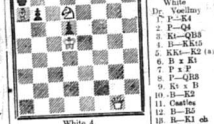

OUR PARIS LETTER.

Mr. Briand Comes to the Rescue.

THE BRIGHT CABINET.

How our own commissioners (France).

After the failure of M. Doumergue and that of M. Herriot to form a Ministry, owing to the disappointing attitude of the Socialists, M. Doumergue found himself compelled to make a second appeal to M. Briand, whom we saw last week as the only man capable of assuming a Ministry sensibly favourable to the Socialists. M. Briand could himself be made a Minister. Once again he has saved the situation at a moment when it seemed that the whole Parliamentary system threatened to disintegrate into hopeless, futile and impotent squabbling. In the past M. Briand could not justify himself to a regular politician. When the Parliamentary system seemed irretrievably broken, it is always to Briand the nation turns, expecting him to pick up the pieces and fit them together again. And such are his qualities as a diplomat and negotiator that he has the habit of winning where others have usually failed.

CONSTITUTION OF MINISTRY.

The parties represented in the Briand Ministry are the Republicans-Socialists, the Radicals and the Republicans (left). The danger in these three parties, comprising some two hundred and sixty members in the Chamber, is that they are not sufficient to guarantee a majority. It will either be necessary to please either the Socialists, the Radicals or the Moderate Republicans of the High Wing. Doubts as to all will depend on the policy of M. Briand, who sees Minister of Finance, whose proposals will not be ready for a week from the date of the letter. The whittling at the time of the discussion of the Doumergue proposals leads one to believe that he will try to obtain the support of the Socialists, who would mean the new Government a considerable majority.

M. LOUBREAU.

One of the candidates against the French Government, M. Loubeau enjoys a reputation calculated to inspire confidence. It is hoped and believed that he will inaugurate a policy of peace, justice and compromise. If any man has a nomination to his present post, one anticipates the realization of a long, but not a short, career. But the situation is tremendously difficult. The Government has a vast mass of inflation because of the financial situation of the State lands on the 31st December. It is no longer a question of the immediate future, but the long term of M. Loubeau's life.

AT THE SOBRIENNE.

Last Saturday a great ceremony took place in the Grand Amphitheatre of the Sorbonne; the traditional gathering which marks the reopening of the University. But on this occasion a special event made it more memorable than usual, the presentation of honorary doctorate degrees to eight foreign scientists who in the time-honoured phrase have "honouris causa" been named doctores honoris causa. The large class were Mr. Edwin R.A. Seligson, Professor of Political Economy at the Columbia University, New York; Sir Paul Vinogradoff, Professor of Jurisprudence at Oxford; M. Paulin, Professor of Physiology at Lausanne; Dr. Ernest Rutherford, Professor of Experimental Physics at Cambridge; M. Charles de la Vallée Poussin, Professor of Mechanics at the University of Louvain; M. Edouard Paucot, Professor of History at the University of Bonn; and Sir Edmund Gosse, poet, novelist, literary critic, and good friend of France, who is now regarded in some measure for his constant efforts to introduce and interpret to his countrymen our often misunderstood French literature. The ceremony took place with traditional solemnity befitting the occasion, and the songs and games of the Professors and Assembly officials, with their various coloured decorations, contributed largely to the splendour and the pompousness of the scene.

THE HOUSING CRISIS.

Much uneasiness has been manifested recently among French tenants and housing critics in all most as acute as ever, and the law which at present protects them expires with the current year. Many landlords have taken advantage

of the fact to give notice to their tenants, hoping perhaps that in view of the Government's attitude the Government would not have time to look after them. But it appears the tenants may stand firm. If no means is found to vote for a proposition of a reduction period for another five years, the existing law will certainly be enforced until the Chamber has leisure to discuss new proposals.

BUREAUCRATIC FRANCE.

France is indisputably the country where bureaucracy flourishes like the proverbial green bay tree. Corruption of functionaries is not the only evil which besets equal-population conditions, but it is a danger to the world. But that is no sense more than our administrations function perfectly. For from it, the more complicated the machinery, the more likely it is to get out of the line. France is it seems trifling to believe that in these first days of December there are still in Paris itself, a great number of telephone subscribers who have not yet received the 1920 directory. Yet such is the case, and after all, why complain? If the delay is prolonged a little further it will soon be possible for one year past without publishing the famous directory, and no one will notice the omission. Which will be one small economy for a harassed nation.

BRIBERY OF PROMISE.

The breach of promise action, which until a few years ago, was a thing unknown in France, became consequently a habit. At Nancy a young man having broken his promise of marriage, apparently without just cause on the very evening of the betrothal, found himself dragged to Court. At first the judge pronounced himself in his favour; but the Court of Appeal has decided otherwise. Being the husband on the "banc" of the bride, he had to be libelled and the defendant suffered the Court ordered him to pay 1,200 francs to the father and 500 francs to the daughter. Not a vast sum in English eyes—but the present rate of exchange? That is another question.

OAKLEIGH PRIVATE HOTEL.

#### IMPORTED LABOUR.

The fact that the Government of Kenya has refused to permit to import foreign labour. Legislation exists to control the emigration of local natives and provision is also made in the constitution for the repatriation of employees of any race brought into the country under contract (introduced originally, we believe, in connection with Kinyasi labourers for railway work) but the existing legislation, both affecting immigration and the relations between master and servant, has no particular provision to deal with the importation of large numbers of foreign labour on long contracts. Right from July, 1920, we have been considering, spontaneously, an Immigration Law. The White Paper of that date suggested the introduction and outlined a scheme which was a direct bearing on the problem of imported labour. The White Paper said that immigration into Kenya controlled from the view of the effect of the activities of any particular immigrant upon the development of the local African; in other words that persons liable, by competition, in the labour market, to retard the legitimate moral and material progress of the native and principle has not yet been embodied in legislation. It is even the intention of the Secretary of State for the Colonies to carry out his proposal, in accordance with the provisions of the White Paper, he must be prepared to limit to some important considerations which are not imported labour. On the other hand, he is to be prepared to suggest that which many people have followed a great deal of hope and expectation. But there are other and more important considerations which must immediately appeal to those who view the position. European labour will develop into a useful asset to the local African, but it is not so bold the case that

...with European civilization in general and with the personal influence and example of the individual white settler in particular. That is a central belief, upon its truth the fact of white settlement is known as the West Coast policy. Yet if we divide upon imported industrial labour, it does not follow that, if the policy is a success from an economic point of view, the average settler, ignoring theories, will eventually end of the industrial local African for the efficient forces of theory, the theory of "division and development by contact" will be seriously undermined and the local white will find his way back to the same old reserves (where there will probably be plenty of work for him) and any claim made by the non-official community the country to be the trustees of the natives, derives thereafter upon the Government and its administrative officers. As an employer of the native, the white settler can claim to-day to be a trustee with legitimate grounds and every detail of native policy is of interest to him in that capacity. It is doubtful, however, whether the same claim could be made by a settler who employs exclusively foreign labour and it is greatly doubtful whether the views of that European in connection with native policy would be entitled to carry the same weight as they do now. Imported labour, carried to its logical conclusion, is certainly expected to lead to the development of European Kenya at a rate and to an extent not achievable with the exclusive use of the local tribes as labourers. But there are larger considerations than private gain; imported labour, as a general policy, must also create a dividing line between the European and the native communities and deprive the fact of remoteness of their effect on the local African. That is why we are critical of the unexplained loss of these people to immigration

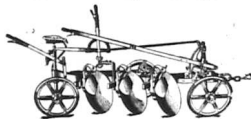


Fig. 2. No. 2 Disc Plough. Observe short handle and clearance between tire and ground. A No. 2 Disc Plough is built to stand the rough usage to which subjected when ploughing in hard clay and. They are constructed from the best of material and the net weight of the No. 2 disc plough is 1200 lbs.

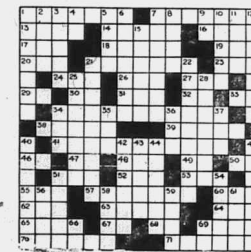

QUESTION OF WEIGHT.

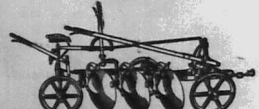

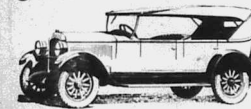
