MOTING TOPICS

WHY DOES AN ENGINE "TRIP"?

Explosion v. Detonation Explained.

CYLINDER DISTORTION.

In the early days of motoring the phenomenon now known as "knocking" was not by any means a common source of trouble, but soon the advent of high compression and with motor spirit of high boiling point, it had become one of the most frequent signs of trouble in petrol engines.

Although the terms "knocking and pre-ignition are commonly used as synonymous there is a distinction for the demand of an engine as not for instantaneous explosion, but rather for the maintenance of a steady pressure throughout the power stroke, and the sound known as knocking is produced by irregularities resulting from the explosion even in the case of knock does not occur before the top of the stroke is reached.

DEFINITION.

It has long been established that the noise is not due to actual knocking of metal parts. A definition which appears to fit the case exactly is as follows: "Knocking is the sound produced when the pressure reached within the cylinder itself is sufficiently high to cause the cylinder to distort with a velocity exceeding the velocity of sound." In other words the cylinder itself is the object which initiates the sound wave which we call knocking.

Being of metal the cylinder naturally distorts to a minute extent with every increase of the internal pressure, but when this distortion is so great that the velocity of sound is caused to initiate a sound wave." The definition states that when the cylinder

expands with sufficient violence to give a kick, as it were, to the surrounding atmosphere, this knocking is heard and pinking is stated to be taking place.

The rate of explosion of petrol vapor and air, in case pre-ignition and under normal compression and under normal compression is high to produce this effect. There is, however, a limit of explosion which is known as detonation, which is even more rapid and is propagated in an ordinary manner.

DETONATION.

Ordinary petrol vapor explosion occurs in the case of a gunpowder fire—that is to say, the heat of the one grain burning sets fire to the next, which fire the next neighbour, and so on. The process of detonation is quite different.

Heat is not the only means of initiating chemical action; it can be brought about by a violent mechanical disturbance, as the conditions in question are the conditions of a violently sensitive explosive. The top of a piston acts as a wave in point, the blow of the hammer being sufficient to start the action. Other means are dynamite and high explosives in general. The heat of a body of light explosive is diminished at once proceeding subatmospheric pressure through the mass from itself to set off the velocity of sound—1300 feet per second which is faster than any gas grain-to-grain ignition (pre-ignition). Hence it means that a plethoric comes into action with economy greater speed than an explosion in which the heat from the gas itself ignites the next, and the destructive effect is correspondingly greater.

Ordinary flame propagation, even at its greatest speed, is not sufficient to cause pinking in a petrol engine. Before pinking occurs, therefore, we must have the gas in a condition which is susceptible to igniting by itself.

The sign of the temperature of the mixture, and the higher the pressure, the less effort will be required to cause it to have the composition ratio, so high that the pressure above, plus the heat generated during the compression stroke is sufficient to cause self-ignition of every part of the charge, almost instantaneously. This may be said to be instantaneous ignition, and naturally results in pinking.

With slightly lower temperature of the gas and lower compression ratio, it is possible to have smooth running with a reduced speed, and yet have the mixture so sensitive that if the spark is advanced to the normal position the explosion will get well under way before detonation is reached, and the local pressure set up by the beginning, causing instantaneous pre-ignition, will travel its wave form through the rest of the mixture and cause it to detonate. This explains the phenomenon of a pinking being diminished by retarding the spark.

Hot points of carbon in the combustion space produce the same effect. With a sensitive mixture they cause genuine pre-ignition, and detonation ensues. The ordinary user has the means

of compression ratio, by adjusting the carburettor for rich to effect. The actual compression ratio, however, is subject to alteration by accumulation of cylinder deposit, and the user is under the necessity of preventing the ratio from rising too high by blowing away this deposit at intervals, in the hot-point stage of his season.

CARBON DEPOSIT.

Alternative measures open to the motorist are only in the nature of palliatives, such as scrubbing the mixture to lessen sensitiveness to detonation—a highly wasteful procedure; whilst changing gear instead of running up to full speed, is another satisfactory remedy.

With regard to cylinder deposits, the main thing is to avoid the habit of retarding at which last stands the tendency to establish a layer of deposit above that which comes from the cylinder, with traces of road dust and a large proportion of carbon from the lubricating oil in the combustion space, which binds the other conditions together and prevents their being ejected through the exhaust (Cape Times).

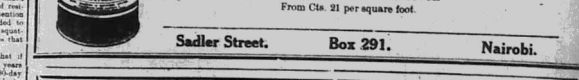

Poultry Notes.

A FEW HINTS ON EGG PRODUCTION.

Last week I drew the attention of my readers to the necessity of having a monitor level from a good laying strain as a kind of the best for the breeding of producing flocks.

In addition to the laying pedigree the parent stock must have vigor and a crisp health alert.

HATCHING.

The farmer who is going to do egg production must study his method. For instance, at the present time new laid eggs are fetching a high price.

The farmer should hatch out good stock in July, so that the pullets are ready to lay when the season season arrives.

FEEDING.

To meet chicks late, strong, heavily well grown birds, it is necessary to have fresh material ground each season. Never hatch out more chicks than you can provide with plenty of range and accommodation as they grow.

Over-crowding is the source of much disease and lack of growth.

FEEDING.

Laying flocks require plenty of good nourishing food. It is essential to the laying flock. Green feed is very necessary, and a fair amount of meal is very beneficial.

HOUSING.

To get the laying hens to do their best it is necessary to have them well-housed. The houses must be dry, clean, and well-ventilated. The usual allowance of space is two square feet of floor space for each bird.

CLEANLINESS.

To keep the egg output up to the average, it will be necessary to cut down on new chickens and replace with pullets starting to lay. Hens which have been laying for eighteen months, (that is, at about two years of age), should be discarded when they stop laying, as if they lay for that long, their output will have passed, and they will be carrying eggs which could be filled by more productive birds.
