Britain Threatening U.S.A. Export Trade.

AN OFFICIAL VIEW.

Mr. William L. Irvine, formerly American Trade Commissioner, Department of Commerce, U.S.A., was recently selected to investigate the marketing conditions overseas for the motor industry, on behalf of the United States. Government has entrusted a striking article to the *Evening Times* on the question of the British motor trade.

He says:

American's supremacy in the automobile export field, four years ago, was recently expressed by the United States Congress, which will not pass if the production of the British Society of Motor-Car Manufacturers and Traders, Ltd., is known to be by the introduction in America within a short time of a new type of motor-car embodying the outstanding qualities of European and American light automobiles.

I quite agree, with Mr. William L. Irvine, that this new car is needed by only for an overseas market but in America as well. More and more the factors of economy and safety are becoming important. Higher gear-sets and the continued increase of traffic pressure on our highways make it imperative that our motor cars resemble the best made.

For a long time America has been believed in the idea that, to have safety and comfort a big car was required. And as we carried hundreds of excess pounds of metal around with us. As long as gasoline was cheap and the road and streets not crowded, we did not mind the changed conditions in the past few years have made imperative a change in the conventional direction.

Anyone who has studied the development of motor cars will have noted that the tendency in construction has been towards lighter cars, with smaller, more efficient

engines. Our manufacturers are beginning to meet the problem, but a great deal to learn as well as to do. The average American also desires better quality, trade efficiency, most of the things he buys. In the matter of cars, the development of the export market has a very beneficial effect on the development of the car for his car. If we have a big car, it means that we are producing more cars, and increasing production means lower unit cost.

Within the past three years our export market has been increased from 15 per cent of our total production to 11 per cent, during the 1924 year we should stand firm on this market.

THE EUROPEAN MARKET.

The James Knapp, Director of the Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce, perhaps the best informed man in America on our export situation, at a hearing before the Appropriations Committee, of Congress a few weeks ago, called attention to the fact that European manufacturers were making a determined effort to invade America's stronghold in automobile export. He pointed out that it was our duty to hold the position we have won, it is necessary, therefore, to adapt our products to meet the special requirements of our overseas customers.

It might appear that in the face of our early success in overseas sales that his warnings are groundless, but that has been increased because we have made cars better suited to the market and because the purchasing power in foreign countries has increased.

But the European manufacturer is not standing still. He fully recognizes the situation. We must be sure that we are ready to build cars that will be superior to the foreign product but also quality the present market is also offering the same. This also means that European manufacturers are increasing production, and that means that the chief strength of American export will be lost. In England, France and Italy there already several manufacturers who are producing cars on a quantity basis.

So we are facing a real issue on our export market, despite the optimistic attitude of our production

How are our manufacturers going to meet it? I believe by providing a car that will meet the European requirements of high engine efficiency, great economy and speed, without sacrificing those qualities which have made American automobiles superior in many respects to European cars.

PETROL ECONOMY.

In my study of the marketing conditions overseas, especially in the Far East, I found an inclination to believe American cars were better than those of other people over there. These liked their power, their comfort, their durability and the general ease of handling, they were not so pleased over their high fuel consumption. At this is a very important thing when you consider that the bulk of their fuel is imported from overseas in tankers at a tremendous cost.

This fuel factor caused a large foreign company to take to turn from America to French cars, because it could not afford to lose the difference between 17 and 20 miles to the gallon. In fact, this difference was a few miles, for the European car sells for less than the American car and the difference (tires were made at low prices).

If European authorities are right about what American manufacturers have in the wind, then we are exceedingly fortunate against the European manufacturers who are beginning to invade the markets where we have been supreme for the past ten years.

The marketing conditions outside the United States do not buy on price alone, which has been our chief advantage. They care about speed, and economy of maintenance and operation. If we can give them these, together with our standard of body comfort, power and ease of operation, we can meet the demand for a better body, we can give them a better body of the business.

A few more miles to a gallon of gas and a car that will last longer, will be a great benefit to America as well as overseas customers. From my contact with manufacturers in this country I believe that this new era in automobile will be met for distant

Pillon Riding. DECLARED ILLEGAL IN NATAL.

The Natal Provincial Council, by a vote of 12, has passed a resolution to be inserted in the Natal Ordinances prohibiting pillon riding to be carried out where a sidewalk is attached to a road.

This decision has caused the Natal Motorists to protest against the measure, and friendly, who are taking steps to protect against the measure, which interviews have been obtained of the Natal Motorists' Association, leading motor cyclists and officials of the N.M.C.C. and it is pointed out that no case has been made out condemning the belief upon which this decision is based, viz., that pillon riding is more dangerous than solo riding.

"NOT DANGEROUS." It is emphasized by one experienced rider that pillon riding is not dangerous, and that to deprive the poorer class of motorist of the rightful pleasure because of a few machines is a very unwise move. He has been involved in accidents in his own riding, but he would not admit to a single reason being a fault, even have not their thoughts.

There are no statistics available to show how many accidents have occurred with pillon passenger machines with pillon passenger, but to the number, riders who, used the fact that pillon machines have been found to be unsafe, not because of a few machines, but simply because pillon riding has been adopted as a common custom, and will be followed by the very large majority of motor cyclists.

IN DURBAN.

The ban on pillon riding proposed by the Natal Provincial Council has not been received with whole-hearted approval in Durban. The Natal Motor Cyclists Club has wired to the Administrator as follows: "Motor cyclists here protest strongly against proposed prohibition of pillon riding. The prohibition of accidents due to pillon riding is actually caused by those who are not using their own safety. Request you to insist on the fact that pillon riding is the only means of economical transport, and prohibition will penalize the poor in ordinary, and will cause accidents."

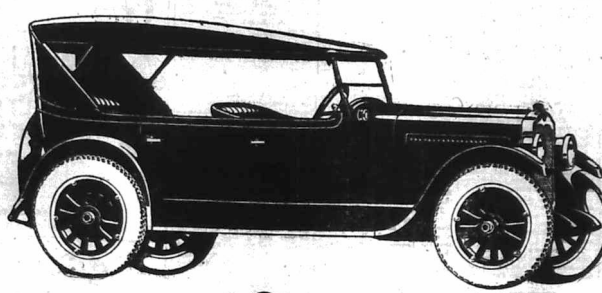

ROTATION SYSTEM OF AGRICULTURE.

Observations on Soil Conditions.

PLANT BREEDING.

The Problem of Root in Wheat.

In the section of the annual report of the Department of Agriculture dealing with Agriculture, the Director states that the Director General was almost dipping his greater part of the year leaving his staff at one unit and a laboratory assistant.

In connection with the survey of 2,500 miles of extra deep manure, levelling was performed, in course of which four farmers meetings were witnessed. The total attendance at these addresses was about 200.

In the laboratory 654 samples were examined in the course of routine and investigational work. Of these samples 416 were samples of dips do not indicate any general improvement in the maintenance of dip strength. There was a slight increase of samples designated "incorrect" from a condition of "improving". The Director has taken an active part in the many bug campaigns. A spray was proved, and it has proved efficacious. In collaboration with the Entomological Division an ant repellent has been prepared.

IMPORTANCE OF MANURING.

Manuring is a subject which is becoming more and more important in the agricultural practice of Kenya. Experiments on coffee and on maize have been started. In addition, experiments to determine the value of the various types of fertilizer available have been commenced at the Botanical Laboratories. Several major experiments have been planned for seasons from which valuable data may accrue. It is considered that a rotation system of agriculture in which green manure plays a part will, in the near future, become essential. In order to accumulate data regarding the value of various legumes as green manure data experiments have been started at the

Botanical Laboratories and subsidiary trials have been arranged in various parts of the Colony. During tours in the farming districts the Director has made important observations and collected material with regard to soil conditions, which shows promise in the investigation contemplated to be soon in progress.

The Chemical Laboratory has been much handicapped in its work owing to the absence of gas insulation.

ENTOMOLOGY.

4,500 miles were travelled by the entomologist on duty, comprising inspection of plantations, field experimental work, meetings and investigations into outbreaks of pests.

Journal Work. The increased notes in last year's report have been maintained. The strict examination of papers has led to several pests being stopped. The importance of plants and seed is now known, and any complaint for which no permit has been seen is possible to stop or modify any maize seed over-land. Insect Foli of the Year. The work done in connection with the control of the coffee mealy bug which was reported last year, as having spread to an alarming extent. Investigations and experiments carried out show the value of "new" officers of the Department.

A great variety of sprays and repellents were tried with more or less success, but were considered to be inadequate. A special study of natural enemies of the mealy bug was made by Mr. Kirkpatrick and the com-

MYCOLOGY.

The Mycology was absent from Nairobi on duty for 62 days, during which some 4,000 miles travelling was done and about 120 visits to farms were made.


The most important results of the year were the discovery of the presence of maize disease of sugar cane and "black smut" of maize in Kenya. The former was a new and extensive field in which the disease was first introduced the introduction of quarantine measures.

Further research work was carried out in connection with the coffee berry disease and experiments, on additional lines of control were inaugurated. Work was continued on a disease affecting coffee and other seedlings and on a disease of native cotton. In co-operation with the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, experiments in the cultivation of various plants to which the conditions were carried out. Field observations were also made in connection with a blackening of soil leaves after cutting and on the occurrence of a destructive parasite weed affecting maize.

Experiments dealing with regarding plant diseases covered a range of 20 different hosts. Several diseases not mentioned above, were recorded for the first time in Kenya. Two bulletins on maize and coffee diseases, respectively, and three Press articles were published during the year.

A considerable number of authentically named specimens including many new ones, were added to the herbarial collection.

Kenya's Health.
The present epidemic of cholera, which seems to be affecting all parts of the Colony and which, in the opinion of medical men, was the worst in the history of British settlement of this part of Africa, calls for the earnest attention of all considering people in Kenya. Whilst it would be easy to exaggerate the seriousness of what, after all, is a passing phase, on the other hand no good purpose can be served by ignoring or minimizing the present condition of things. Because always at this season of the year cholera is common, it is no reason for the adoption of a fatal attitude with regard to it: rather there is the more reason to inquire why this should be with a view to possible prevention in future years. It is only as a number of people affected by illness disappearing that one can have inkling of those who call for greater consideration in the fact that in many cases the cholera is malignant, and those who have lived in this or some other tropical country have been and have likewise boasted their immunity from fever have been and some still are assuming that this more serious kind of well-known cholera in all climates, the community are affected and a noticeable feature is the big portion of natives resident in places where the epidemic is spreading. Malaria is not to be considered lightly at any time, and the extent of its ravages now is only too apparent, not only in the Capital, but in up-country places.

cholera definitely revealed as few from any danger of epidemics. From nearly all districts there are tales of cholera. In Nairobi business and domestic arrangements are more or less seriously disrupted, on many wharves a big proportion of the sailing staff, etc. The explanation given to a Standard representative, of the probable cause of the unusual severity of the cholera, seems to be a very feasible one—that following a long drought the rains were not sufficiently strong to wash the mosquito larvae from the stagnant breeding places. Whilst that is a contingency which cannot be guarded against by any organized public action up-country, it is not one which should be a very big problem in the town of Nairobi. We had occasion in a former article to draw attention to the growing seriousness of the mosquito menace on the Capital and will endeavour to do so on the occasion of our next issue. For some weeks now the mosquito breeding grounds in the municipal area have been systematically sprayed, but the trouble seems to have been that these areas were not taken earlier. At least, such measures can now be taken as a preventive. Until in Nairobi there is a proper system of down drainage incorporating a proper drainage system, there can never be that state of commensurate cleanliness which is the birthright of all civilized communities. To put Nairobi into anything like a proper sanitary condition will cost a great deal of money, but surely proper regard on safeguarding the health of the community should be a first aim in public funds.

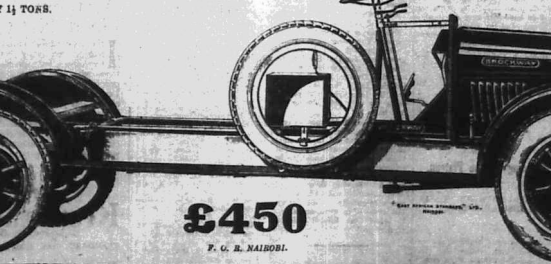

MOTORING TOPICS

THE IMPROBABLE.

The New Eight Cylinder Model.

NOW IN KENYA

The Hypocrite Eight, as its name implies, has an engine with eight cylinders, which are cast in one and in a line. American cars are not noted for cleanliness of design, yet the motorist can expect the Hypocrite in an exception and its trimly planned thoroughness.

The lean and stroke of the engine are 3 1/2 and 4 1/2, or 75mm and 120.5 mm, which give a capacity of a little over four litres. Both crankshaft and connecting-rod are not for cleanliness of design, yet the motorist can expect the Hypocrite in an exception and its trimly planned thoroughness.

An unusual refinement for an American car is the separate ignition block, the spark-plugs having two aluminium "wax" tips. The cylinder head is easily detached, and after the removal of a cover plate the rocker-type tappets of the side-valve valves can be adjusted. Tuning is in detail, which can be effected extremely easily.

Oil is forced directly to the crankshaft, connecting-rod, main shaft, and valve lifter shaft bearings. The oil filter is better than on any American chassis, but it would be larger and should have a gauge, especially as the filter as in the case, and to draw it, and the pump, out a bottom plate, held by two nuts, must be drawn up. Oil should be drained by a tap in the side of a tank. The cover of the valve tappets is cast, with the valves in it, and air for the car-

The carburetor is handy and is fed by a vacuum tank on the dash board. It draws through a mesh and by special passage to the intake side is thus warmed. There is a neat petrol gauge on the instrument board with a taper marked in eighths, and the float is a reverse-action float valve. The carburetor pipe is smoothly curved down and back from the front of the engine, with the inlet and outlet at the top to provide a hot-dog.

The cooling is well designed. A large honeycomb radiator, covered in a shell which, in turn, is held in the cross-member, has a thermostatically controlled shut-off in front of it, and there is a second thermostat just above the cylinder-head to govern the circulation. The fan belt can be tightened quickly, and there are three driving taps, one for the radiator, one for the oil casing, and one for the pump. The pump is driven in tandem with the generator by a shaft which is connected at each end by a Hertz joint. The gland on the pump must be dismantled, which is not a difficult task.

Just in front of the pump and readily accessible, are the vertical distributor and its drive, and the oil is mounted on a real plate, which is not the dash and above the cylinder head.

Cam and lever steering is becoming common on American cars and is used in the Hypocrite. Many British chassis would still follow the practice.

GEARS AND TRANSMISSION

Engine, clutch, and gearbox are assembled together, a method followed by the Hipp Motor Car Corporation since 1911. The clutch is a dry-plate type, and wear can be taken up on the external springs which can be replaced when the inspection cover is removed from the housing face. The pedal also can be adjusted for wear. The flywheel above the shaft. These are usually heavy, and are cast in one piece, and to segregate an already used lead plate there were one or two "struts" to the back board. The gear boxes have the two shaft bearings and the clutch separately from the gear-box.

The usual three speeds are provided, and are controlled by a central lever which works to the main shaft with a stop for reverse. The gear change is made by a sliding gate without a stop for reverse. A reverse-drive pinion is level plate. It is a proper fit for the gear change, which is of good size and has an automatic lock along the outside of the gearbox and its shaft.

Behind the box is an external transmission, brake worked by the clutch. The adjusting nut is on top of the brake, and is a screw. When the bolts have been fitted, the open propeller shaft is coupled by bell driving shaft, and a spiral level gear transmits the power to the drive shafts. The spring, fore and aft, are half-dippled and are set flat, which is the best plan. Shafts are fitted and torque is taken by the forward section of the back spring.

FOUR-WHEEL BRAKES

The four-wheel brakes are the Lockheed hydraulic external type, and although I prefer internal brakes, the principle employed is simple and effective. The brake pedal is connected to a piston which works in a master cylinder, and from here leads to "flex" lines to each of the four brake drums. Oil is forced into a space in the brake drums between two small pistons, which in turn are coupled to the linkages which contract the brake linings. Depression of the brake pedal expands the oil in the drum-piston, and by contracting the links produces decelerative force.

As the source of power is constant, the action of the four-brake system is compressed automatically. There is no parts requiring lubrication by hand, no pin joints, universal, and so forth. The brake can be adjusted individually, without leather being on the road linings, when the drum and wheels must first be removed. Ordinary adjustment is made by a master of turnover, handle under the bonnet which moves down a piston in a small oil reservoir and delivers new fluid to the master cylinder, thereby expelling the brake ether. The ends of the front axle are mounted.

A Battery Disease.

SULPHATION, ITS CAUSE AND CURE.

Without being technical in the lead, it is possible to describe the condition known as Sulphation in a storage battery, and to outline some of the remedial measures which a battery doctor has at his command for the improvement of such a condition.

Upon discharging, the sulphuric acid in the solution sets upon the lead plates and changes them to the battery-plates of lead sulphate. When a battery has been permitted to remain discharged for a long time, the lead sulphate has become so solid that it cannot be dissolved by the addition of water.

The longer the sulphate is permitted to remain on the plates, the more difficult it is to restore the battery to its normal state. In a healthy battery this is being actively done, and discharged slowly in use on the car, sulphate does not collect and hardens to the point where it cannot be dissolved and easily removed.

The addition of more acid to the solution than that prescribed by the manufacturer may bring about the same result, and a very strong solution combined with the composition of the solution, will maintain there in the form of a solid plate.

Perhaps the most common cause of sulphation over portions of the plates is lead, in solution, to which the plates are filled with distilled water. It is known that the solution decreases in volume because of the evaporation of water, which is not replaced when the battery is being charged. This loss must be made good regularly or the solution will drop below the level of the plates.

That portion of the plates above the solution becomes sulphated and extremely hard, and the cure is that if any more acid is returned to its normal function is to permit a battery man to recharge the battery with extreme care.

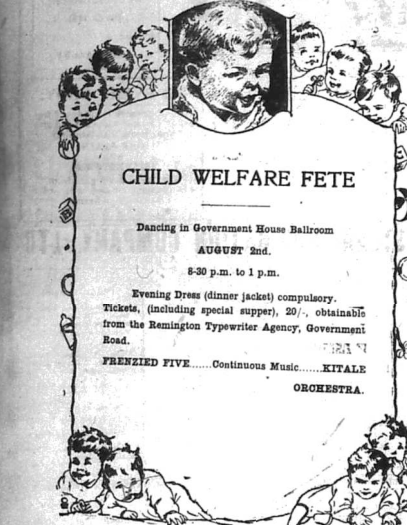

one or two people had been asking him about it that what he had seen in West Africa had in no way altered his opinion which was expressed in the report of the East African Conference, above his signature. He was a believer in the dual policy in East Africa, and held the highest view of all the East African dependencies, and he has a feeling that the past had been a progressing and successful one and that the increase in a far-going market in the East African Dependencies was most satisfactory. He hoped the Conference would prove of great value to the several Dependencies and that the establishment of the East African Dependencies would help further development. Another point which he desired to add was that he thought the results of Dr. de la Riviere's investigation into pasture questions in Kenya, which were now under consideration might be of the very greatest assistance in the future to farmer and native alike.

The following report is culled from the African World. The company numbered between three and four hundred, a record figure for this yearly event. The arrangements were excellent, and as in former years, enthusiasm was the keynote of the proceeding. Messrs. which had been addressed to the chairman Sir Sydney Henry, K.B., M.P. delivered the intense interval which was being taken in the House by the East African members.

Mr. Amery, it was explained, was really apologising for Mr. Drumby-Clegg who unfortunately was confined to bed with an attack of fever.

Another disability which it was hoped would be present was Mr. J. H. Thomas, but the Labour leader had to fill an important role engaged. The absence of these bright particular stars of the political firmament, however, did not mar the success of the function which, as already mentioned, was complete in all respects.

The Treasurer opened an announcement in announcing the chairman by referring to him as a member of His Majesty's Government. Sir Sydney Henry denied the sole impairment but he declined to state his ambitions in that direction. He added, smilingly, that in a few moments they would have the pleasure of listening to a plucky member of H.M. Government. 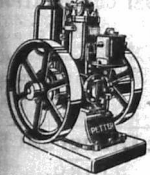

AUCTION BRIDGE MADE EASY.

No. 9.

PLAYING THE HAND.

[By Fern.]

So far the attempt has been, as simply and briefly as possible, to explain the main principles of the auction, or bidding together, with the tactics when playing, with a real live "moss" partner against the other manipulating the dummy hand. We come now, in the language of Shakespeare, to the "last step of all," the actual business of playing the dummy hand.

Weak hands involve frequently pronounced rubber cut. We all know the shy gentleman, with most modest talents and the very lady, with the hip-stock and the tightly secured, whose inevitable, but unadmitted attitude is: "I would much rather you played the hand, partner!"

Now the plain blunt fact is that playing the dummy hand is about the easiest job of all. The player in that happy position is the only one who knows definitely and positively what his partner, and his opponents, have in their hands. He is the only one who knows strategy and his partner. His advantage, over the wicked wiles of a meekness in "Humble" goes and palpable, deep root as an fool competitor. Comparing at a glance your two hands, your own and the dummy's, assess your cards, and then your potential tricks. Thus you will see at once whether the making of your own suit is straightforward play, or to what extent you must rely for a trick or two on your judgment in finessing or in forcing a lead from the right direction.

Never touch a card in your own or dummy's hand until you have your own suit firmly and irrevocably made up your mind to play it. Nothing is more irritating than a player who fumbles about with the cards, hesitating and hovering and wasting time.

And never forget which of your two hands took the last trick, and therefore must be led from. The bad habit of leading from the wrong hand has brought too many a promising rubber cut. It is also in the hands of unscrupulous players whose opponents are nervous, gained many precarious points. In that case it almost serves the defrauded players right. It is most essential to keep awake at cards. Auction bridge is a game of concentration and observation. One excellent rule for the player of the dummy hand is that made famous by the L.G.O.C. "Safety First." Do not throw away your

well, a thing fairly easy as it comes, especially if a trick as a driver to score over-tricks. But on the other hand, respect your partner's feelings as a silent spectator, limited to the one aspect of type but little variety elsewhere. If your possible bid for ask, over

And here we come right up against the golden rule. It applies always and to everybody, but most of all to the player of the dummy hand. Always count the cards. Only so can you be sure when you have drawn all the trumps in your opponent's hands, and can safely proceed to make your outside leads. But you really must count, not only trumps, but the other suits too. How many million cards, in the monstrous aggregate, have been thrown away? Failure to observe that very simple, obvious and very precaution, I should not like to prove.

COUNTING THE CARDS

Counting the cards of all suits, so that you know how many are still "out" at any moment of the game, soon becomes a mechanical habit once it has been acquired. It will enable you, when you have mastered it—and the effect requires less intellectual stress than learning your A.B.C.—to know how the cards in a suit, whether yours or the enemy's, will divide. Thousands of losses may be avoided, if the best players make a habit of remembering all the cards of every suit. But never must you be careless about the number and importance of the trumps played and still to play. Unless you memorize trumps absolutely and infallibly your partner will have every right and reason to suggest that cross-word puzzles are your true métier.

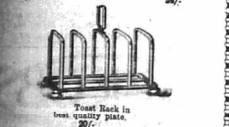
And please annihilate the commonest fact once and for all. Many players have been thrown away by failure to lead trumps when playing the dummy hand, thus by all the other sins of omission and commission in the Auction Bridge calendar. I have already quoted the thunders of celestial wrath being occupied by people who neglected to lead trumps. It is a heinous transgression. And avoid that equally abhorred error: "Partner, I hadn't enough trumps to lead them out!"

He without immoderately among partners. It is a mathematical calculation includes twice-one-in-two. The fewer trumps you have—lead accidentally, if you have very few trumps, limited to the one aspect of them—the more important it is for you to follow suit, by making them these trumps separately. If your opponent's trumps are just equal, count twice instead of once each pair.

Moreover, if you have been engaged the very few trumps, but permit of rubber-saving, and been given a little beyond standard, perhaps by a too optimistic partner, do not let any discommodities refrain from leading trumps merely because dummy's trumps are so few. If you and dummy have, as surely you can, good outside cards to make, the need for leading out your own trumps, and thereby drawing two for one, is the most common. Never mind if you have not got the ace or king. Quit with them, leaving from dummy through your own hand if possible.

And here let me utter another word of timely caution. I have written the obituary of many a good player, who ordinarily would never dream of failing by these trumps as soon as possible, merely because he attempted to score a trick from the dummy hand first, with the intention of securing a queen or jack in his own hand. The strategy must be practiced with due observance and discretion. Never, merely in order to secure a lead of trumps from dummy up to your own concealed hand, run the risk of being ruffed by your opponents. Sometimes even the best players must get caught this way, but very rarely, though, for they will observe carefully their own dummy's hand, as well as the calling of the trumps.

Never risk an attempt to get in through your own hand, by playing up to a top-shower cut in dummy, that has been strongly called by either of your opponents or that you or dummy hold in unusual length. It is a very obvious blunder, likely to be short, or even minor, in that suit. And in any case the risk you run in securing a dummy lead, or in finessing a card, must always be based on your accuracy. If the devil drives, needs must; but try to keep his attacks limited to a such run. Don't burn expensive candles to him.

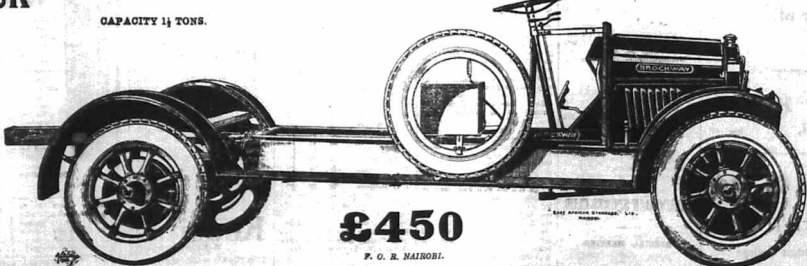

THE MAN-EATING MENACE IN UGANDA.

Thrilling Report by the Game Warden.

Lions Which Prefer Human Victims.

It is not often that official reports make such thrilling reading as that prepared by the Game Warden of Uganda dealing with the activities of his Department in regard to measures adopted against lions.

Into a straightforward narrative of events he introduces an atmosphere as thrilling as that of any adventure story and provides the nucleus of a book which could possibly be quite as enterprising as the well-known "Men Eaters of Travo".

The Game Warden is to be congratulated on the compilation of a fascinating record.

The report is as follows:—
For the moment matters appear to have quietened down in Ankole, in so far as man-killing by lions is concerned, though these animals are still plentiful enough and well distributed, therefore I consider it advisable to continue the scheme of granting rewards for any adult lions killed by the local inhabitants.

I doubt whether the quantity of game can be taken as a serious determining factor in the man-killing habits of the Sanga Lions. I am inclined to the theory that in this particular area, the man-killing taint is present in the lion's blood and that on the least pretext a reproduction of attacks on human beings may take place at any moment, so that the more lions that can be killed, the less the chance of such occurrence. The reign of terror which existed in recent years on the Mbarara-Manaka Range (in the Mbarara) was not caused by a single lion, but by many, and the resultant death-roll was appalling.

The Italian Game Ranger, Juventus Makhasa Nkya, informs me that one lion alone was responsible for 18 deaths, and that another had more than 40 human kills to its credit before it was destroyed. When lions, collectively, take to man-killing the taint in their blood is naturally passed on to their offspring, though the new generation may not necessarily

display man-killing tendencies from birth. The taint however is lying dormant, only awaiting an opportunity to display itself.

The Sanga Lions present a very different problem to that of the usual type of man-eater, which is an old beast with diseased teeth or an animal suffering from some deformity or disability, which prevents it from catching and butchering game with ease. Such animals live apart from others of their tribe, and soon hunger drives them to the habitations of man where fowls, dogs, goats and cattle are easy to obtain. Sooner or later a human being is involved when trying to defend his property, and once a lion has tasted human blood the desire for more is insatiable.

GREAT CUNNING.

A solitary animal of this type frequently displays the greatest cunning and often hides in well-high inaccessible places, but luckily it is rarely a breeding animal, and once the offender has been brought to book, the menace ceases.

Fortunately, lions rank amongst the most foolish of animals, and by reason of their love of carion and their habit of returning to a kill time and again after being driven away, are comparatively easy to poison, and poison therefore is the most efficient weapon to use against destructive lions.

Man-eaters are often not easy to destroy by this method, as they scarcely ever leave enough of a human kill to induce them to return, rarely remain long in one locality, and are frequently cunning enough to make a practice of never returning once they have left a kill, and also consistently avoid the poisoned-baits prepared by man.

The Sanga man-eating lions were fierce, ferocious animals, in whose habitat a sudden reduction of game took place due to drought from interpest. The game was then still further reduced by fatal extinction by anti-rinderpest measures which led in the destruction of immense quantities of antelopes and war-buff.

The straggling lions were driven to raid the flocks and herds of the local inhabitants, and some lions came into conflict with man either accidentally or intentionally.

A BIG PROBLEM.

It is quite probable that many lions driven through hunger to hunting in troops, shared the first few human victims.

So evidently the damage was done, and the Sanga area became infested with a race of man-eaters which led to type, a fact which, vastly increased the problem of dealing with the menace. As soon as one or two well-known man-eaters were destroyed, others appeared to take their place. Even now I consider that the majority of the lions in the Sanga area are potential man-eaters, otherwise, in a locality well-stocked with game, why should lions be continually prowling around the palisaded labour camp there.

A lioness was trapped outside this camp at 7 p.m. on 20th November, and secured by the orders of the local Chief at 7 a.m. next morning. The natives quite naturally had reason to be afraid that other lions might be close at hand.

From the information I have accumulated I am not inclined to agree that the Sanga man-eaters were confined to the older animals, though it is quite probable that it was the older animals which were the culprits in the first instance, and I regard these lions as akin to the lion's head of man-eaters which are taken from birth, the whole race having the man-killing taint present in the blood. (N.B. The Tapes of the Sunshades at the mouth of the Hugh in Ingeri are all hereditary man-eaters).
