# MOTORING TOPICS

## TRAFFIC CONTROL.

### Some Suggestions for Improvement.

#### PEDESTRIANS' DUTIES.

The following suggestions are not claimed to be complete, but are for all the difficulties which present themselves in trying to find a remedy for our traffic troubles. They deal mainly with the regulation of traffic in urban districts, as opposed to rural districts. The flow of traffic in the open road and in the narrow streets of the old towns is a different matter, and should be dealt with in a separate article.

#### "SAFETY FRUIT"

As regards pedestrian traffic, a pedestrian has certain rights, but only equal rights with other road users, and the obligation upon him to exercise them is as great as that upon the driver of a motor car. He must not obstruct the traffic, and he must not be a nuisance to other road users.

#### (1) Through the Press.

#### (2) By poster advertisements.

#### (3) By pictorial and other educational notices on children.

#### (4) By cinematograph films in picture theatres.

#### (5) By a few simple notices embodying the rules of the road and the proper method of never creating the impression that the traffic has been observed will do much to lessen the amount of traffic accidents.

#### (6) By the co-operation of the Education Authorities these rules might easily be made to form part of the regular curriculum in every elementary school.

#### "Safety Fruit" movement should also include among its objects.

#### (1) Courses of instruction for traffic and transport employees.

## INCREASING ROAD CAPACITY.

All regulations for the control of road traffic should be based upon the principle of facilitating the maximum practicable speed consistent with public safety and general convenience, for each different kind of vehicle.

Fast traffic should always be treated as a precedence from the least, so as to minimize the risk to pedestrians who may step from the footpath on to the carriageway.

#### One-way traffic in the case of narrow roadways would probably be found to be advantageous.

## Head Lights.

(Continued from yesterday.)

Why then should a motorist deliberately "dazzle" the red and yellow light, which is known to have his headlights beams? To show that he is not a motorist, but a pedestrian, and that the use of blue lights is not good practice, we quote from a bulletin which was recently sent to approved headlights adjusting stations in the State of Massachusetts by Mr. A. W. Travers, of the Motor Vehicle Department.

"Blue Lights. There may be a little used if they give 21 candle-power and a white light. The average motorist who uses them does so for some reason which he believes to be true, but may not be based on fact.

If carefully constructed so that the glare is not too thick and the blue colour is not too intense, these lights give a light which is approximately white. They only prove annoying if they obscure any more nearly natural appearance. Their disadvantages are obvious: A brighter filament is necessary to compensate for the light obscured by the blue glass; in fact a 25 candle-power filament is ordinarily used in order that 21 candle-power may come through the glass. This results in a 50 per cent greater drain on the battery and the wiring as well as much loss of light through the clear glass cover. Automobiles are ordinarily wired this means that the same may give much less than 21 candle-power. Furthermore, the blue light gives a light which will not penetrate fog well, and consequently some through the glass. This means that there will be occasions resulting on account of a reduction in candle-power, which results from a varying thickness of the glass."

THE GRAVE DIGGERS OF NAIROBI.

How Malarial Conditions Are Fostered.

ARRESTING STATISTICS.

Temporary Measures Which Create False Sense of Security.

In the latter part of his paper, 'The Malaria Problem in Kenya' read by Mr. C. R. Brown, one of the members of the Kenya branch of the British Medical Association, the problem which afflicts the towns is dealt with.

From the beginning of March to about the third week in April only 2 per cent. of the domestic mosquitoes of Nairobi—as shown in the attached diagram—were Anopheles. During the last ten days of April the percentage of Anopheles went up to 41, and at the end of May reached 76.

A step is becoming very necessary, as an anti-malarial measure is doubly urgent. Many permanent sources of standing water are situated in the city, and these, if not removed, will be a constant source of water, and it is certain that no amount of drainage will be of any use.

SWAMP DRAINAGE.

Other very prolific sources of trouble are the drains and irrigation ditches, constructed for the benefit of the city.

The apparent increase of malaria in Nairobi is due to climatic only so far as seasonal conditions have at last shown up the crude efforts of man.

NECESSARY MEASURES.

Under such circumstances nothing but a direct attack on all breeding grounds will suffice, and the obvious first step is to locate the places in which the mosquitoes breed.

BRIDGING GROUND. In January and February of this year, the species found in greatest abundance were cistae in every form, shape, and colour.

It is well to emphasize the importance for the grantee when the money is made available for the grantee to use it in the most judicious manner. Nothing should be done in haste, but the grantee should be prepared to receive the money as soon as it is available.

SCHEMES DISCUSSED. It must be assumed that the money has been discussed, or is being discussed, by the grantee.

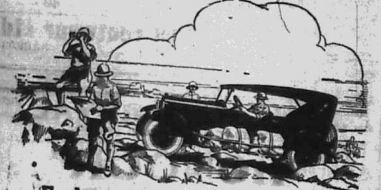

Renascence of a Big Engineering Works.

The renascence of great business enterprise is a matter of several weeks, and not the least interesting was that of the former Engineering Firm of Tanganyika.

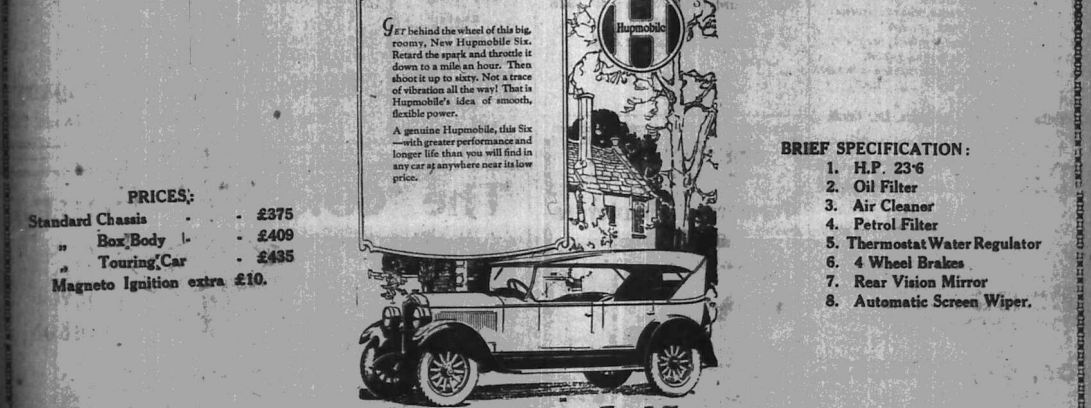

## MYSTERIES OF BYGONE AGES.

### Misfortunes of Those Who Dig up the Past.

#### IS THERE A CURSE?

(By C. L. McLEOD, BOSTON.)

Did the engraving of old Egypt excite the late Lord Carnarvon's superstitious fears? The question, which was the operation of the spell at the time, is raised freely by the news that another husband, seeking to uncover the mysteries of a past age in Sicily, has died in mysterious circumstances.

A few years back millions of people all over the world were speculating as to whether the death of Lord Carnarvon, who, with Howard Carter, discovered the tomb of Tutankhamen, was due to something more than mere coincidence.

The famous Egyptologist was upon the job during the progress of the excavations, which led to the opening of the shrine, and died shortly afterwards. A few months later he was followed to the grave by a distinguished French archaeologist engaged in the same work.

Without expressing an opinion one way or the other as regards these particular incidents, it is permissible to point out that misfortune, however, and sometimes death, have come to all five fugitives in the time that have been mentioned, not only in Egypt, but elsewhere.

The latest victim of Mr. Ogden T. Mather, the American publisher, who was responsible for the expedition to Yonkers, and who has just died of a cerebral thrombosis.

These fatalities in succession, therefore, interrupted this modern-day necromancy, and have, in fact, so far, not only found Pharaoh in its correct spirit, but have also caused the death of its devotees.

Many other people have had similar misfortunes in the investigation of the past, and it is reasonable to suppose that the misadventure of the late Lord Carnarvon is not an isolated case.

One typical case of the kind is that of Mr. Arthur Waudal, formerly British Consul in Hanoi, who, under the Egyptian Government, Mr. and Mrs. Waudal, together with Mrs. Louisa Smith, a friend of theirs, and Mr. P. J. Ogden, a painter of Anglo-Egyptian fame, found the site of preserving a mummy in the life of the Pharaoh Akhenaten, who died over 3,000 years ago.

From 1875 to 1898 B.C., and another mummy was found, and the people to be present.

On the 17th of November, however, never took place. For at the last of the excavations, the mummy of the late Lord Carnarvon was struck with an unknown ailment, which was accompanied by a severe pain in the stomach.

He then died, and his death was attributed to a mummy disease, which was supposed to be a new form of typhoid fever.

It is not supposed that the chapter of incidents is susceptible of a scientific natural explanation, as indeed it is. But even so, of Egyptian and native medicine men in Cairo, were quite sure that the afflicted people were suffering from the evil spirit.

Another somewhat similar case occurred in the Nile valley, in the district of the Nile delta, where a man named Mr. J. H. Mather, was found to have died in mysterious circumstances.

#### INTERESTING EXPERIMENTS.

It has recently been asserted that some people occasionally possess the power of having thoughts transmitted over vast distances without the aid of a receiver, and this has, since being brought to the fore the question of thought transmission and its supposed similarity to wireless.

# MOTURING TOPICS

## THE DETROIT OF AFRICA.

### Port Elizabeth and Motor Production.

#### FORD AND GENERAL MOTORS.

There was a line-up long time ago in the Detroit of the United States, known as the Liverpool of South Africa. Then with the War came the establishment and great expansion of the local industry, and before long the order of life was displaced by a newer one, the Northampton of South Africa.

Today the scene on the shores of Africa has been laid to assume the distinction of being the Detroit of South Africa, for the two great motor manufacturing concerns in the world—the Ford Motor Company and the General Motors Corporation—have selected it as the centre of their activities in the African continent.

#### WHY F.E. WAS SELECTED.

This is a double factor in the case of Port Elizabeth, and the reason of its selection is obvious. It is a place to build a city. To the west, 500 miles away, lies Cape Town; to the east, the same distance off, lies Durban, and almost 600 miles to the north lies Johannesburg.

Thus Port Elizabeth is about equidistant from the three great centres of the Union and is a support the inland routes of the country. To make even more attractive the seat of its manufacturing and commercial position, Port Elizabeth has been selected as a base for a manufacturing town, and so it is not to be wondered at that its claims could not be passed by when Ford and General Motors surveyed the land.

The Ford Company, it now appears, is half-way through the third year of its African venture. Since January 1, 1919, it has carried out operations in a huge building previously occupied as a wholesale storehouse at the North End, and here every Ford that goes into service throughout the Union and Rhodesia first sees the light of day.

#### PLANS FOR MODERN FACTORY.

How long the company will remain content with the present pro-

duction, is a matter for the future, but the extent of building a large area of ground in the vicinity, and plans have been prepared for a factory modelled on the lines of the most up-to-date plants and buildings in various quarters of the world.

The North End plant is a large affair. The extent of building covers a region of that in vogue in the American States. The General Motors of the company, and which is to be built in the same location, is to be built on the same methods of construction as the Ford plant. #### ONE MAN, ONE JOB.

Each man has his own job and so on. One letter is part to position, another that is snugly, a chief lightness up the nuts on the bolts. There is an oversteering of engine, but under the efficient maintenance the car grows prodigious.

In a separate department of the plant the bodies are built up entirely from individual parts, the parts being taken shape as a component vehicle, or temporarily mounted on a chassis. This operation is done in the factory, where in the light chambers, high pressure spraying nozzles operated by machines supply the desired colour of finish. It is a very short period of time. After driving, the cars are left in the assembly tank, until they have reached their final destination.

#### GENERAL MOTORS CONCERN.

UP TO THE PRESENT THE GENERAL MOTORS CONCERN HAS NOT GOTTEN

There were 5,160 Chevrolet and Oldsmobile cars sold in South Africa, but the General Motors Corporation estimate that in the first year of their production they will just pass between 4,000 and 5,000 cars of both makes on the road.

Attention naturally turns to the question of the use of South African raw materials in the building of all these thousands of cars. When the Ford Company first established themselves in Port Elizabeth they felt it to be known that while they were importing every detail entering into the manufacture of their cars, they were quite prepared, and indeed anxious to incorporate any material that could be produced in this country. This, and here was the important point, it had to pay them to do so. In other words, they could not be expected to use any item which would cost more than the imported article. That is the standard in the horse-trade, and the offer stands.

It has been the endeavour for some time of the Service Co., Ltd., the East Africa agents for the Ford production, to obtain their support of cars, and spare parts from the Port Elizabeth factory, and saving considerable time and expenditure. So far, however, the cost freight charges have been against the project. It
