 AN ALL-STEEL MODEL OF IMPROVED APPEARANCE...
 Although cars with all-steel coachwork at a moderate price the Essex has made a reputation which is likely to be maintained by the latest model. Apart from its construction, the all-steel chassis remains unaltered and it is in the coachwork that new and very considerable improvements are to be seen which greatly enhance the appearance.

The new coach is an all-steel production; it differs, however, from other bodies of this type, that the various panels are not assembled by spot welding but by a special system of riveting. Furthermore, the running gear is so designed that they may be riveted together without the use of pins, thus saving a certain amount of weight.

The axle, spindle, and spring are equally distinctive while the completed body is extremely stiff, and imparts considerable rigidity to the chassis. As a consequence better road-holding qualities are obtained for the new model, although the chassis itself is treated in combination.

Complete finish is employed, and the rubber struts have which have distinguished the Essex in the past have given place to special covers that result in a much more elegant vehicle. Owing to the construction of the steel body on a steel chassis in place of the wooden all-steel body, the overall height of the car has been reduced by two inches, although the overall amount of load room is given. This fact has a bearing on the general appearance of the car.

Improvement is to be seen in much of the detail work; for example, the springs have been fitted in the manner in which the largest complete concern may be demonstrated. In fact there is no doubt that the all-steel Essex represents a wonderful value for money in the covered car class, and will give many new adherents.—The Auto

Due to the large number of one-light reported by the Traffic Squad to be defective on the part of Nairobi Motorists, resulting in the non-illumination of rear number plates, and causing a further increase in auto motoring, paragraph 7 of the instructions published on the "East African Standard" of May 10th, 1920, is hereby cancelled.

2. Motorists driving cars between 4.15 p.m. and 5.45 a.m. with defective rear lights will from date **BE PROSECUTED.** The offence is cognizable to the Police.

3. Observe the instructions which are hereunder repeated for the information of the public held good. The Nairobi Police Traffic Squad, have been instructed as follows—

1. To enforce the existing laws under the Police Ordinance, The Township Ordinance, and the Motor Traffic Ordinance, and to pay particular attention to the following points—
2. To allow no parking of cars in the vicinity of the High Court, e.g. Victoria Street sector backing the High Court, or in the two roads each side of the High Court.
3. To allow no parking in 6th Avenue (Main Road) from the Railway Crossing to Government Road Junction.
4. To allow no cars to remain parked in Government Road or Harding Street for a period longer than one hour.
5. To allow no double parking of any vehicles in Government Road.
6. To request all motorists parking in Government Road to draw up flush with the pavement, and facing the correct traffic stream.
7. To warn all motorists who have license holder incorrectly placed as a restriction of this office will mean prosecution.

The instructions as issued above will remain in force for the space referred to, unless cancellation occurs or complaints are received, when due notice will be given in the papers before prosecutions are entered.
