The Essex Coach

AN ALL-STEEL MODEL OF IMPROVED APPEARANCE

Although cast with all-steel coachwork at a moderate price the Essex has made a reputation which is likely to be maintained by the latest model. Apart from its mechanical modifications, the six-cylinder chassis remains unchanged and it is in the coachwork that they see a considerable improvement over its predecessor.

The new coach is an all-steel production; it differs, however, from other bodies of this type, that the chassis panels are not assembled by spot welding but by a special system of riveting. Furthermore, the running gear is so designed that they may be riveted together without the use of pins, thus saving a certain amount of weight.

The axle, spindle, and spring are equally distinctive while the completed body is extremely stiff, and imparts considerable rigidity to the chassis. As a consequence better road-holding qualities are obtained for the new model, although the chassis itself is unchanged in construction.

Complete coach is employed, and the rubber struts have which have distinguished the Essex in the past have given place to special cast-iron that result in a much more compact vehicle. Owing to the construction of the steel body on a steel chassis in place of the wooden all-steel body, the overall height of the coach is reduced by two inches, although the overall amount of load room is given. Due to the large number of one-light reported by the Traffic Squad to be defective on the part of Nairobi Motorists, resulting in the non-illumination of rear number plates, and causing a further increase in auto motoring, paragraph 7 of the instructions published on the "East African Standard" of May 10th, 1920, is hereby cancelled.

2. Motorists driving cars between 4.15 p.m. and 5.45 a.m. with defective rear lights will from date **BE PROSECUTED.** The offence is cognizable to the Police.

3. Observe the instructions which are hereunder repeated for the information of the public held good. The Nairobi Police Traffic Squad, have been instructed as follows—

1. To enforce the existing laws under the Police Ordinance, The Township Ordinance, and the Motor Traffic Ordinance, and to pay particular attention to the following points—
2. To allow no parking of cars in the vicinity of the High Court, e.g. Victoria Street sector backing the High Court, or in the two roads each side of the High Court.
3. To allow no parking in 6th Avenue (Main Road) from the Railway Crossing to Government Road Junctions.
4. To allow no cars to remain parked in Government Road or Harding Street for a period longer than one hour.
5. To allow no double parking of any vehicles in Government Road.
6. To request all motorists parking in Government Road to draw up flush with the pavement, and facing the correct traffic stream.
7. To warn all motorists who have license holder incorrectly placed—a notification of this offence will mean prosecution.





EAST AFRICAN STANDARD Monday, Dec 12 1926

The Legislative Council. The Budget session of the Kenya Legislative Council will be opened by His Excellency the Governor in the Municipal Hall at 10 o'clock this morning. In accordance with precedent, it is anticipated that the Address to the Governor will be the only important business before the first sitting and that an early adjournment will be made. In view of the accelerated interest which has been displayed by the general public in the problems of the Colony we hope that the opening of the session to-day will be well attended by members of the general public whose presence cannot but give encouragement to those who have undertaken this work a year since His Excellency arrived to take over the reins of Government. It has been a year of arduous work. A great deal of social and commercial legislation has been added to the Statute Book, an enquiry has been conducted into Port Control and labour affairs, the East African Government has met in Conference and important meetings of East African experts have been held in the Kenya Capital Town. Planning and other problems of local government are being advanced, the work of developing the native areas of the country has progressed and we have not omitted a period when we have had to further adjust the budget in view of the fact that the budget has been increased by such a large amount as to necessitate the raising of another year's loan which has been accepted by His Excellency's Government to provide the necessary means to the middle which through the aid of the Government to the utmost development of essential services without neglecting the community's financial strength in view of the
