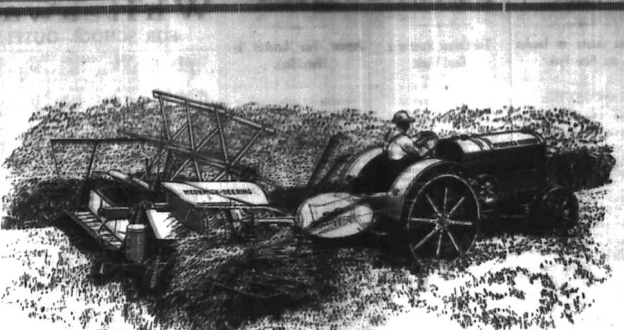

RECENT TRIAL OF A HUP

ON SALCEDO

Covering 38,216 miles in 30 days, without once stopping the engine is the record recently established by a Hupmobile Six Station in England. The running time averaged approximately 20 miles an hour, and the actual average, including stopping the wheels to refill with petrol, oil and water, and to replace one puncture, was 25.5 miles an hour. The ignition was tested when the run was started, and the result was of the car.

The run was planned and conducted to duplicate, as nearly as possible, the conditions which would be met in actual road conditions. A 450-mile route was covered on "city" and constant check of the mileage was kept by the car of the Western Union Telegraph Co. in each of the larger cities.

Though the run was conducted under a severe handling of muddy, rutted roads during more than half of the 30-day period, the car which completely satisfied a driver and his driver, actually averaged 22 miles per gallon of petrol. Oil was changed each 100 miles and covered two laps of its route, or each 400 miles. Grease was changed each 400 miles, giving the car driving the preceding lap about 16 hours to rest.

The run attracted widespread interest, because it was the most severe tests of endurance ever given a strictly stock automobile. Continuous trials which last both day and night during the greater part of the test made it a dangerous undertaking for more than a week. Even on the good roads, there is an average of one breakdown a week. The highest speed recorded was 45 miles an hour.

On completion of the test the inspection of its parts made by Capt. Hutton, H.M.C., a graduate mechanical engineer from the Royal Institute of Technology, and his report, submitted as a signed statement, indicates that the car was remarkably free from wear.

It reads:—"No appreciable wear in any piston or cylinder. Cylinders very tight. All connecting rod bearings exactly the right clearance. All main bearings perfect—oil film on bearings surface well maintained and no wear shown. No wear. Valve lifters and guides perfect. Camshaft bed bearing perfect. Piston and timing and governor chain very little wear three-quarter take-up adjustment still left. Oil pump and gear perfect. Distributor shaft perfect. Fan and water pump satisfactory perfect. The clutch and mechanism was like that of a car and found in perfect condition."

Seeking the Facts.

The Convention has dealt in its lengthy debates very fully with the challenging doctrine of His Excellency the Governor on the subject of labour. There has been spent up an entirely new avenue of thought for exploration and there are now signs that out of the welter of discussion there is emerging the great general principle. The Convention has very wisely we believe although only by the narrow margin of the Chairman's vote, again avoided regarding its opinion in favour of the imposition of alien labour as a policy of desperation and has agreed to suggest to Government the advisability of setting up a new Commission of Enquiry, or Committee of Investigation, to ascertain facts relating to demand and future demands upon native labour. ... would restrict unskilled or semi-skilled labour to the development of the wealth of the Colony but we do believe that only through recognition of the need for safety and the soundness of the foundations of our progress with the minimum of ill. At the same time, if the Government redoubles their efforts to create a breathing space of time outside the reserve it is surely also the duty of Government to insist that the Government should not be allowed to proceed with the cultivation of crops which do not call for much labour, particularly to avoid the methods of cultivation as not wasteful of manpower. Government has now proposed to establish a body for which we have long strove the need— a body to provide a first link between the general conditions in the country and the exigencies of the general interest in Britain. Now the Convention has suggested a further Committee to deal with labour and production and at the same time Government is proposing to collect certain statistics. We do not dispute that all these proposals should be made in one organization—a permanent organization—whose staff, as a Development Institute, should be able to obtain, direct the development programme of the country. It is not our duty to do this until we have a clear idea of the nature and extent of the resources and coordinate all the forces which matter to success and progress. We do not want too many bodies, we need only one organization which will function properly now and in the future. Without such a directing body, no serious development work is possible. We must always go forward in the dark.

FEAST AND LABOUR.
 A few years ago, said Mr. Lynde, the Department maintained a few road graders driven by animals. There were very few military, because of the difficulty of keeping the ones straight. This year the Government maintained the purchase of a certain amount of modern motor road plant, some of which had been used, while the remainder still existed. The use of motor graders in this country was restricted by weather conditions. Often the roads were either too wet or too hot and dry for them to be employed properly. It was certain that conditions were suitable. He hoped the use of more motor road plant was very desirable and he was glad to see that the Government had approved a loan of £2500 for the purchase of motor road plant. The Department was waiting now for the fulfilment of the road plant which had considerable experience in Australia.

With regard to labour on roads, the position of the P.W.D. was very difficult. On a road, say 60 miles long there were employed several crews of labourers with one European supervisor. It was responsible for him to be at all parts of the road at once and so soon as he left one gang work at that place more or less stopped. He hoped the labour difficulty would be lessened by the extended use of motor road plant.

With regard to permanent roads, he was afraid that owing to their cost, the Colony would have to be content with earth roads for some considerable time to come. He thought it was not well to build the transport of heavy traffic on certain roads.

Colonial Durban said he spent three shillings a mile to do a road with a tractor grader.
 Captain Kaufman asked if the P.W.D. had ever considered getting the right type of road formation from Home?
 Mr. Lynde said the matter was receiving consideration. Again the speaker was the trouble. He hoped it would be desirable to have a proper establishment of road formation on the staff. In reply to a further question he said Europeans were employed usually at road formation. They were paid from £15 to £25 per month inclusive.
 Mr. Harper having replied to the question the motion was put and carried unanimously.

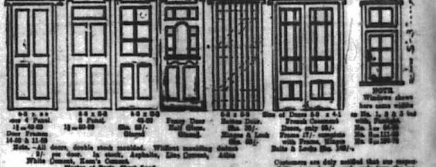

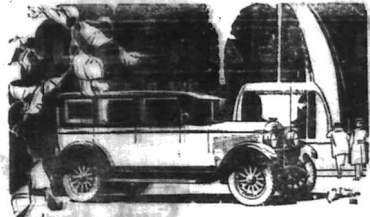
