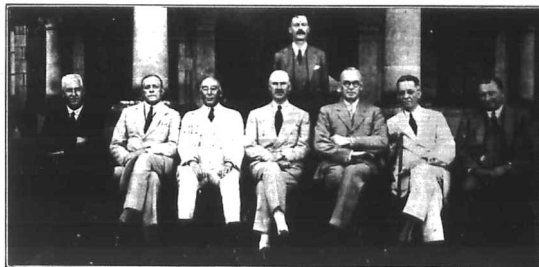

THE REAL MUSEUM FOR KENYA.

Extension of the Present Scheme.

(By Dr. Van Steenacke)

A Kenyan and popular Dictionary defines a Museum as "a building of National, Scientific and Literary Character," and with this definition the general conception appears to agree. The present Kenyan museum is a large and extensive building containing many and various objects of natural history and especially natural products.

(1) The establishing of some scientific collections in every aspect of Natural History and of Natural Products.

(2) The opening of the Public Rooms of the building.

No Museum can justify its existence unless it can show that it is established to promote teaching and education. In order to teach, the subject must be thoroughly understood, and it is here that the value of Science works comes in, without artificial investigation becomes devoid of meaning unless self covered in the knowledge of the actual facts of life.
