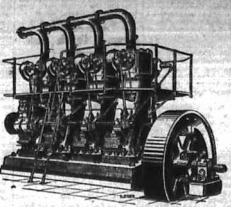

In the event of a claim? Where an insurer does not reveal the whole of the truth, the nature of the omission has to be considered. If immaterial, the contract still stands; if material, and the insured has been guilty of a breach of disclosure, the contract is void.

If the insurer is evading the claim, it is not upon inquiry, and the nature of the policy without taking into account what should be the correct answer might be held to be a waiver of further information at the point in question.

Where a question has been adequately put, immaterial with reference to material, the amounts which would probably result from the contract.

It is difficult to speak in general, but as a matter of fact, the insured must be kept in mind in that the insured must in every case be liable for all material facts which must be disclosed before the contract can be upheld.

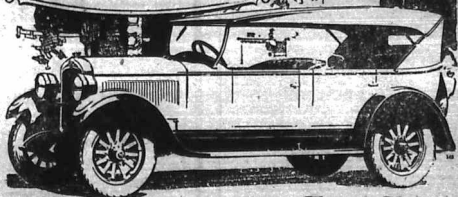
