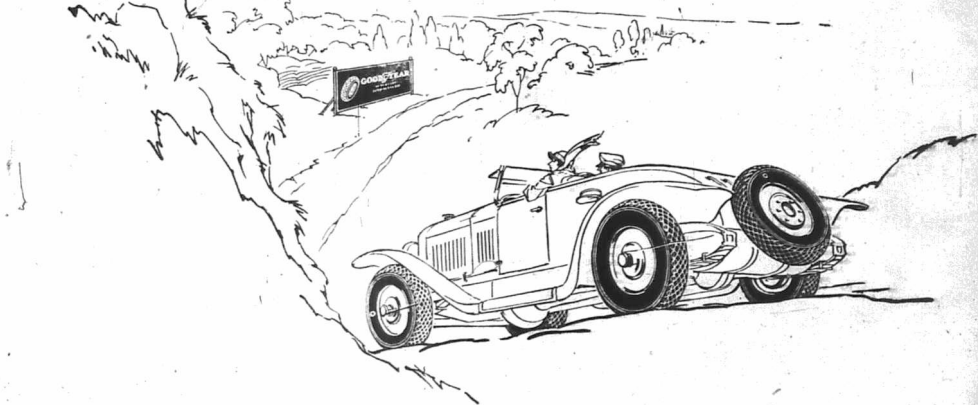

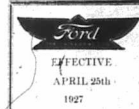

The devastation of marshland in Louisiana over a stretch of approximately 100 miles through the banks of the Mississippi River between New Orleans and Natchez, a new way of drainage, started to march, thus increasing the number of homeless to 20,000. Rice, cotton, sugar and all kinds are flooded along almost continuously to the staggering total of loss.

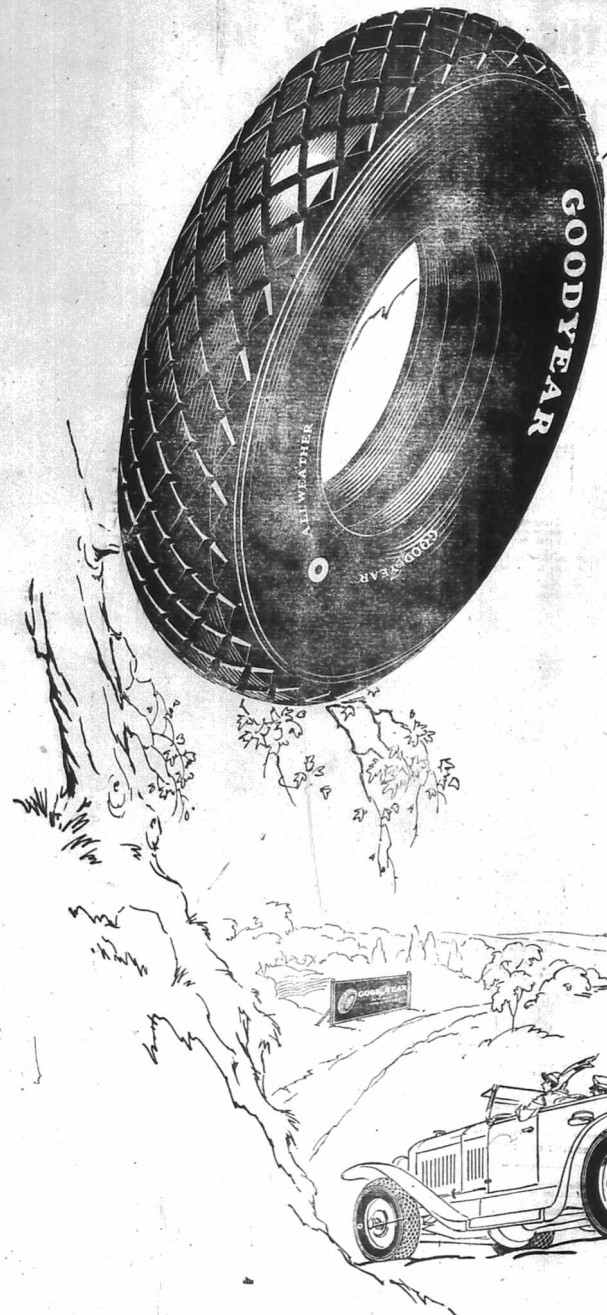

Reward for Bravery.

HOUSE OF COMMONS AMUSED BY BLANKETS GIFT.

M. P. laughed at question in the House of Commons recently when Mr. Oswald Gore (Ulster) asked what action had been taken by the Kenya Government in recognition of an act of exceptional bravery by a native, who had handed, in a letter, a number of blankets to a soldier who was wounded in the war.

Mr. Oswald Gore: The name of the native has been considered in connection with the list of recommendations to be submitted to the King. The native has already been publicly thanked by the Government of Kenya and has received a special gift of blankets (laughter). Mr. Oswald Gore: I have only one blanket. (Laughter.) Mr. Oswald Gore: All that I know is that he was asked what he would like and he asked for blankets.

The deed and particularly its reward received a great deal of attention in the House of Commons and some of the headings were distinctly national in tone. Typical examples were: "One lion, one blanket," "A Kenya Native and his Blanket," "Blankets for heroes," "Wanted: Reward for 'Warm' Tribute."

The *Scotsman* writes thus commented on the matter:

"A GESTURE."
Noble spirits accept a gesture of goodwill, the equivalent of the highest award, when meritorious deeds merit the tribute of a native and honor their ineffable. Questioned and answered in the House of Commons yesterday (Friday) and the subject of the Kenya soldier's reward was dealt with by Mr. Oswald Gore, who presented a Bill for that purpose. The name of the recipient of the reward was not made public and the native was not there to say whether he was personally satisfied or not. Official information that he was asked what reward he would like and he chose blankets. Mr. Oswald Gore stated that the gift was made by the Kenya Government and that the name of the recipient was not made public. A number of these blankets probably represented all the wealth of the Indian to that area of Africa; it may be doubted whether he would have preferred a Bull-Boy. If a generous Government wishes to supply the need of a sick boy and a European model will probably make him the product man in the country.

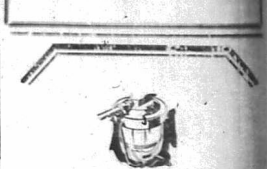

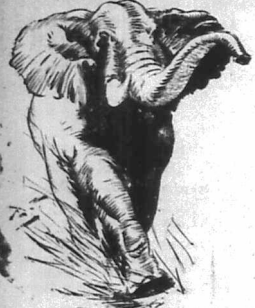

WAR DEBTS CONTROVERSY. British Protest Against American Inaccuracies. HOME TAXPAYER'S BURDEN. United States Refuses to Enter into Any Discussion.

Great Britain has addressed to the United States Government a lengthy Note in dignified and restrained terms protesting against the inaccurate statements of the United States Treasury Secretary including the assertion that after this year Britain would receive from her debtors substantially more than she would pay.

In the course of the Note it is emphasized that Britain intends to make nothing whatever out of her war debts or repayments, while on the other hand the United States is not only taking her full share of reparations from Germany but is also being paid the whole amount of Britain's debt plus interest.

The American reply is surprisingly curt. It reads: "The United States regard the correspondence of Mr. Mellon, Secretary of the Treasury and the president of the Princeton University on war debts as a purely domestic discussion and they do not desire to engage in any formal diplomatic exchange on the matter."

America's War Gains. (By Wire.) In a Note to the United States Government on Monday...

It is a Note to the United States Government on Monday and referred to publication in the various papers. The British Government point out that the published letter on the subject of war debt addressed by Mr. Mellon, Secretary of the United States Treasury to the British Government...

Further details with these statements. The Note declares that America's debtors are not merely receiving from Germany what she owes to the United States, but that British war debt payments to America impose no burden on the British taxpayer.

Recent Britain's receipts during the last financial year from Germany on account of reparations represent approximately one-quarter of the payments made by the British Government to the United States Government and Britain's proper reparations receive provided for this financial year, assuming they are transferred in full to the United States.

It is the receipt from Germany on account of American Government reparations which are included in the total British receipts from Germany in other of the years which are not covered by the American payments to the United States Government.

It is also pointed out that the American Government is not only receiving from Germany what she owes to the United States, but that British war debt payments to America impose no burden on the British taxpayer.

INCACCURACIES. The Note declares that it is inaccurate both as regards the past and the future. Mr. Mellon's statement regarding Britain's receipts from Germany in 1926 is shown to be false by figures published in the American Treasury Department's report of 1926 which shows that Britain has paid \$25 million during the year.

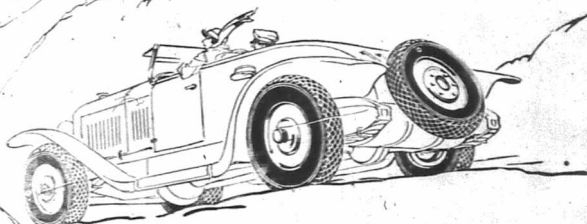

STATE OF INDUSTRY IN BRITAIN.

Coal Trade Regaining Old Position.

PROMISING OUTLOOK.

[FROM THE ECONOMIC COMMISSIONERS.]
London, April 14.
Signs of a continued recovery in overseas trade are apparent in the latest official statistics. Last month's exports of British merchandise were the highest recorded this year, though showing a contraction as compared with those of March, 1926. The decrease is mainly due to reduced shipments of cotton goods, the value of which has been affected by cheaper raw materials.

If allowance is made for special circumstances, the general result is by no means unimpressive. The country is just recovering, from, perhaps, the severest industrial crisis in its history, and the manner in which it is regaining lost ground is, to say the least, very promising. Coal exports last month showed the figures for March, 1926, while for the first quarter of the year they are over 8 per cent. ahead of those of the corresponding three months. The coal trade has thus regained its old position in a comparatively short time. It remains to see whether the effects of disputes and stoppages, having regained its old pre-eminence, there is good ground for hoping that other trades will now be able to make steady progress and re-establish themselves on a sound foundation. The consequences of the coal stoppage are still apparent, especially in the steel, steel and engineering industries, but it should not be long before they are in a position to record the results of the post-war period of 1926.

In shipbuilding, too, it is reasonable to expect a marked and rapid revival. The reconstruction figures, amounting to the work this year, being 1,070,000, but they will amount more than a year ago.
