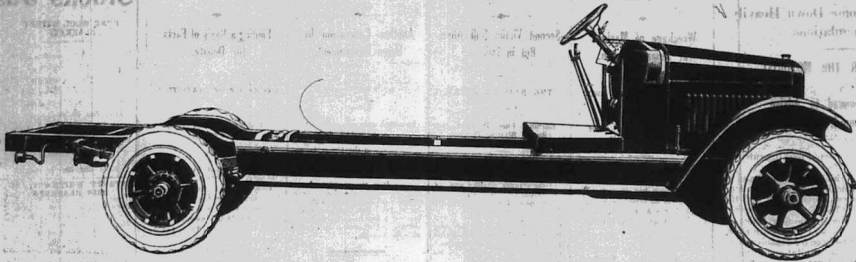

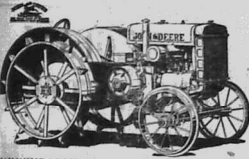

Hint Given of Local Government Report.

TOWN PLANNING PROBLEMS.

The Greater Nairobi Town Planning Authority evidently thinks that it is the complete laying out of the foundation of a sound "Town Planning Scheme," and that the "darker work" of carrying it out must be abandoned by some other body of public spirited persons.

Mr. A. G. Baker, the Chairman has prepared a memorandum on the subject which runs as follows: "As I have had considerable experience of the working of the Town Planning Commission in Mombasa it may be of interest to members of the Authority if I state the position of the Nairobi Scheme as far as it goes. The scheme as submitted to Government is a very valuable recommendation on broad lines, but not a Town Planning Scheme within the meaning of the Ordinance, which contains on a rigid schedule and set out with great exactness and with detailed outlines. A scheme of this nature, if approved by Government, cannot be altered in any way without the sanction of Government, and if any local objection was made, to Legislative Council."

NO STAFF.

Such a scheme cannot be prepared without engineering and survey staff to do the necessary work. It is obvious, therefore, as no staff is at present available, it must be a long time before the major part of the scheme prepared by the Authority can be brought within the scope of the Ordinance. It is, of course, advisable that the present staff should select, for instance, the site for the new station on the Nile Street and the Swamp area for which some preliminary work has been done, and design prepared.

THE AUTHORITY.

The position of the Authority, which is to carry out the scheme requires serious consideration. There appears to be no one to do the necessary work.

(1) The Nairobi Area Town Planning Authority is granted, in the memorandum to extend all the members of the present Authority to develop the scheme which will have to be given to the planning out of the town. Details of the scheme such as siting of the main roads, etc., will have to be given to the planning out of the town. A Person of Wavering Character.
EMOTION.
Historical revelations of the many-sided character of Napoleon Bonaparte are made by the publication of two volumes of the memoirs of Hortense, later Queen of Holland. She was the daughter of the Emperor Josephine by Count Alexandre de Beauharnais, her first husband.
Hortense, who was her mother's constant companion during her life with Napoleon, recalled every day when she was a young artillery officer, in 1800, to Josephine. She depicts the great man as a person of wavering character, versatile in mood, temperamental and dominating, feared, but at the same time kind, and capable of very good humor, writes the Paris Express Paris correspondent.
Hortense, who married Louis Napoleon—the King of Holland—his father-in-law, Napoleon III, she relates in two volumes that Napoleon's manner towards himself at times engendered positive hatred, and for example when he pulled her at her party at her first Communion, or when, in 1807, he forbade her to weep for the death of her son.

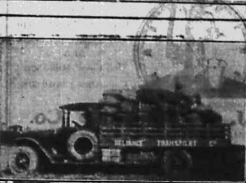
