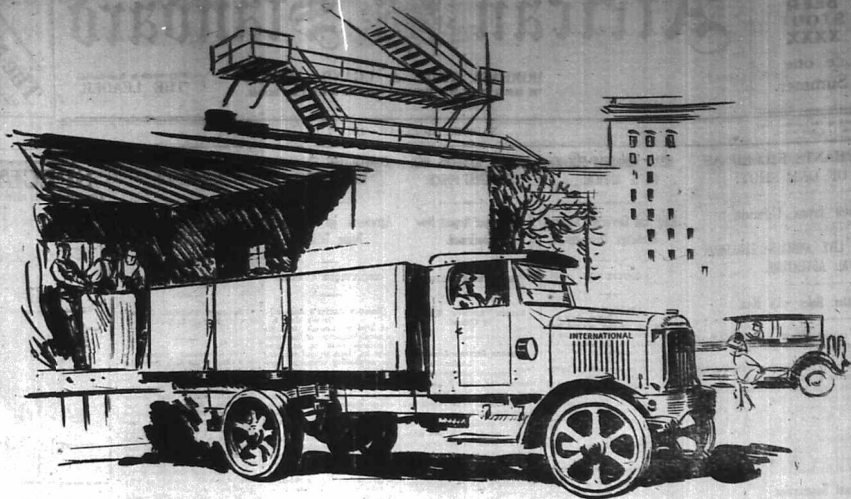

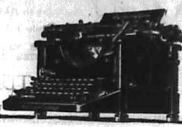

AGRICULTURE

THE BASIS OF PROSPERITY.

A Plain Statement of Fact.

THE POSITION OF AGRICULTURE.

The following statement was issued by the International Commission of Agricultural Economists at the conclusion of the International Conference on the condition of agriculture in relation to the world's economic complex in 1934 and 1935, which was held in London and in which the following countries were represented:

With the International Commission of Agricultural Economists in view, the International Commission of Agricultural Economists, which acts as interpreter for the general economic conditions of individuals which it groups together, are convinced that it is to be expected that the position of agriculture in the world's economic complex will be brought to a point of view which will be a basis for the welfare of all peoples.

It is an indisputable fact that the value of production in the domestic market of the agricultural products is generally sufficient to cover the cost of production. To this circumstance must be added the considerable increase in the expenses of agriculture, through labour, duties and taxes of all kinds. Therefore, it is necessary to resort to agricultural technique and in the organization of agriculture in the different countries of the world, the attention of agriculture is almost everywhere being directed towards the development of agriculture in the form of the War. Agriculture is being obliged to increase its purchases of manufactured products and services, and to improve its housing and building, as well as for the purpose of equipping machinery and other means of production.

RE-MATIONS.

This restriction acts in turn upon agriculture and trade, which in turn lack of labour and unemployment. These have led to a serious situation in the application of agriculture

and that of industry. The prosperity of agriculture gives the possibility of agriculture to produce more goods for the general industry to enable the producer more easily to pay the remuneration to the labourer, and to enable the consumer of agricultural products to pay the remuneration to the labourer in their time, when they see improvement in their position, are able to buy a larger quantity of agricultural products at a lower price. It is the same with industrial production, which enables the producer of agricultural products such as the textile, leather and wood industries, which have to respond to more numerous demands and to pay a larger price of raw materials.

In the same way, if some state policy should be the bringing about of a decrease in the cost of production, a grave error would be committed by encouraging it to obtain this, and by the artificial reduction of the price received by the producer of agricultural products. The only result would be an accumulation of the stocks and an increase in unemployment. The fall in the price of farm products cannot usually contribute to the welfare of the agricultural community in the measure that it is made possible by technical improvements and by a decrease in the cost of production.

A wise and healthy policy must always tend to give to agriculture a rational and profitable form. It will usually require an increase in the cost of production.

With regard to some particularly delicate problems, it is undeniable that each State has a right to try to place its agriculture in conditions of production equal to those which obtain in other States and have also recourse to Customs duties to that effect. However, it is indispensable for the general interest of the world to see that agricultural products, receive their share in the international exchange of goods.

CONCLUSIONS

These principles once laid down, we believe we are able to submit to the Economic Conference the following conclusions, which we consider essential to the prosperity of agriculture and the maintenance of the farm population, upon which the welfare of a nation is based.

(1) It is necessary first of all to see whether the price of agricultural products remunerates the numbers of the family most able to obtain late seasonal products of a value equal to that of the late one save.

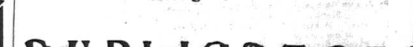

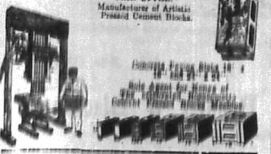

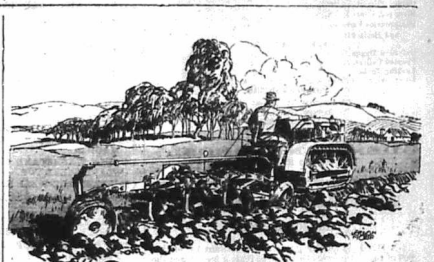

The Beethoven Centenary.

EMOTION REAL AND FALSE.

There is Music

(By "R. F. W.")

One who was to be all original appearances, but a short musical feast, ugly, post-romantic, rounded headed, outside little man has just had the whole world pay the most respectful tribute to his memory. This tribute, it must be for a moment be doubted, but even a genuine gesture of gratitude for one who has touched our imaginations and roused our emotions, with all that is finest in the great art of music. Beethoven was himself. For the sterner of man not to be conscious of his gifts—"I know that I am great"—is just the personal sting which he succeeded in infusing into his music, that helps to make it what it is. One other great gift he had, the gift of taking pains. He succeeded, he wrote, altered and improved on his works continually, spending months over what might seem trifles to us and then when the proofs came back from his publishers had to go all over the proofs again. "It is not the whole to flourish, a matter of indifference whether you play the whole between the first and second notes or between the second and third note. I have spent no less than the whole morning and the whole of yesterday afternoon over this."

consideration of the two pieces, and one quite as good with structure and covering. The most beautiful to a pianist given by his domain. He was pitifully modest of his health. The only hope for the future of the centenary however, has been that the world would be poorer.

The greatest failure of the centenary celebration has been that the public has had the advantage of meeting many of the master's less familiar works. Mendelssohn is being able to hear the whole new symphonies every year, but in the performance, and largely absent, conductors seem to divide themselves into two classes, old versus new, and even number one while all the world over continue to hear the "Moonlight" and the "Pastorale" and sometimes the "Hammer-chord" and the "Patetique". However, as this report has been reprinted this year, I trust that in future we will be treated to many fine works that have just been rediscovered on the shelves of production libraries. The Columbia Graphophone Company made a special feature of this year, offering the whole of the Beethoven's String Quartets, and much other music, so that it is possible for all owners of a gramophone to have a great deal of Beethoven's music played by great artists and for the most part splendidly reproduced.

I cannot help feeling, that if an attempt were made, by people who ever say that they do not understand "classics" music, to do a complete real edition from the files in the nation of some three or four hundred or more the best—even at the sphere of "Pops"—I think had a rather little young man described to me as "the kind of man who has been taken gold fish and read the very thing that he expressed the very

sentiment of false sentiment, and what a vast amount of music is simply reading aloud to hear good music. Mendelssohn had said, such as "On the rocks" and other works, which are permanently compared to that piece, a moment's more of the piece called "Always", and finally being in something about little and sweet children, and music upon music, have all the same of taste in music.

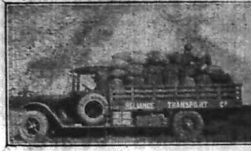
Great masters themselves have not been without blame to be such a large and varied collection of music, and great interpretations must be found equally guilty, before the tribunal of art, for forming them. I show the music in my "The Music of America" and so perfect was the performance of the "Pastetique" I was almost convinced that it was great music which sensationally is a masterpiece. Mendelssohn stands so outside anything emotionally false in music that it is via the medium of his works I should try to have the "Slightly" mentioned into an appreciation of all that is best in the set.

First, we "Pops" writing in the Mendelssohn's works of having a highly disciplined concert in hand after just attending, rather show performance of amateur players. To one who is open expression, it was "behold over." 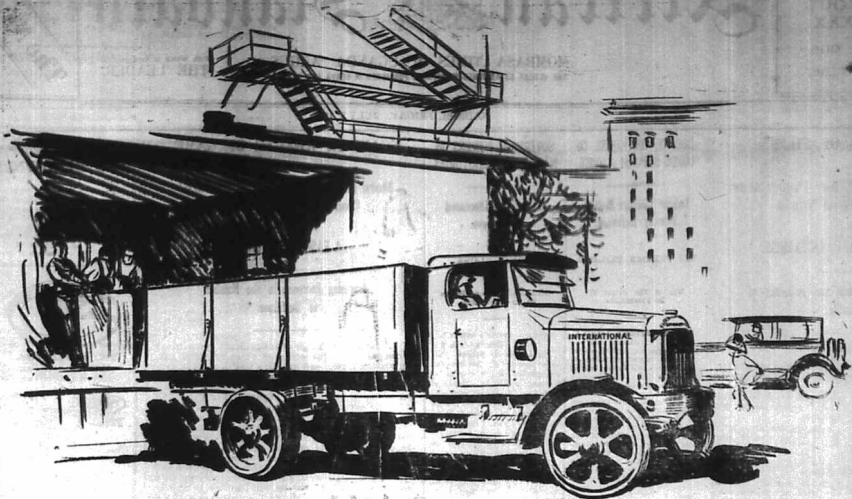

DECLINE IN THE TRADE OF ZANZIBAR.

**Clove Exports Below
the Average.**

1926 REPORT.

**Heavy Crop Expected
This Season.**

The 1926 Report of the trade of Zanzibar shows a decline in the value of the following exports as taken from the following:

The total value of exports from Zanzibar in 1925 was valued at Rs. 2,73,95,000 and of exports Rs. 2,04,41,000.

There is therefore a decrease of 30.30 per cent. in value of exports as against 25.00 per cent. in exports.

The total export and import trade last year was Rs. 4,22,91,300 and in 1925, Rs. 3,77,85,000, a total decrease of 10.40 per cent.

REVENUE.

The tax Customs Revenue collected during the year amounted to Rs. 21,50,000 being a decrease of 10 per cent. for the previous year. This decrease is a reflection of receipts which is normally subject to wide fluctuations reflecting the variation of annual production. It is to be mentioned, however, that the yield of this tax alone has increased from the abnormal losses of the 1925-1927 clove harvest and from the unusually low price ruling during the latter months of the year.

Although the total imports of clove from Zanzibar in 1925 showed a decline in value of Rs. 16,65,010 as against Rs. 18,00,000 in the previous year, there was an actual increase in the quantity imported to the extent of 1.50 per cent.

Compared with the previous year, imports under this heading show a decrease in value of Rs. 1,00,610 which is accounted for by a decreased importation of Rice. Exports during the year amounted to Rs. 68,85,000, the average price per unit of 100 lbs being Rs. 15.00. The corresponding figure for the previous year were 49,35,000 valued at Rs. 42,29,200, the price per unit having averaged Rs. 15.02.

Exports of Rice during the year amounted to 47,290 cwt.

valued at Rs. 48,250 as compared with 47,290 cwt. valued at Rs. 48,250 in 1925.

THE CLOVE TRADE.

The total export of Cloves during the year amounted to 57,85,000 Indian or 528,000 cwt., valued at Rs. 68,85,000. The export of Cloves during 1925 amounted to 52,85,000 Indian or 478,000 cwt., valued at Rs. 42,29,200. The corresponding figure for exports during the following statement:

Although the quantity of clove exports during the year is not as high as in the previous year, the average output, as indicated by the report which is submitted by the manufacturer in view of the exceptionally low price which has prevailed since the latter months of 1925, and which has been the normal season's harvest to which reference has already been made, that the year's export transactions do not in fact add any indication that the world's consumption of clove products has not been fully maintained.

The most noticeable feature in the distribution of the year's exports is the falling off in value in the shipments to the United Kingdom, due partly to a reduction of consumption in that country, and partly to the increase of direct shipments to other distant ports. The reduced shipments to a considerable portion made from London. Exports to the United States of America, although rather less than in the previous year, are in the average figure for the corresponding period and represent no less than 20 per cent. of the total quantity shipped during the year. The reduced shipments to India are to a considerable extent due to the loss of income incurred by the Bombay market on account of direct shipments to the Netherlands East Indies and the Colonies, U.S.A.

The fall in the price of clove products was particularly emphasized during the latter months of the year. How far recovery may be expected in the immediate future is dependent on circumstances which cannot well be forecast, but it is satisfactory to record that no restriction of business has been occasioned by the reduced prices now being realized, and that there is every reason to anticipate that both output and export transactions in 1927 will be materially larger than during the year under review.

COPEA

The total exports of Copea during the year amounted to 747,000 cwt., valued at Rs. 90,28,700 and imports of Copea to 81,277 cwt., valued at Rs. 14,12,000. Imported Copea is used largely for baking with eggs, of local production for subsequent re-export. It is to be noted from the following comparison statement that the export value of domestic Copea, as repre-

sented by the difference between total exports and imports, continues to show a steady development.

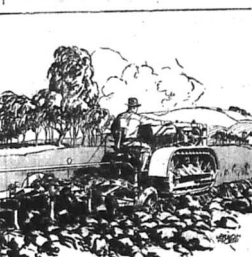

100 yds. - James J. E. Linton secured the 100 yards in 17 1/2 secs., and winning it back in time to win the high jump; and E. L. Howland (Glen Hill) became the weight-putting title with a push of 125 lbs. and a pull of 125 lbs. in throwing weight with a throw of 115 feet.

In addition to Harland, four holders were again successful. W. W. Dwyer (Queen's Park) secured a very nice win in the two-mile race in 24 mins. 41 secs.; D. A. Love running splendidly in the half-mile in 17 1/2 secs.; J. E. Kelly (St. H.) giving another grand exhibition to win the 120 yards hurdles, in 14 1/2 secs.; and A. G. O'Connell (St. H.) again proving the lead in the long jump with a jump of 22 feet 10 ins.

New holders, who scored in the winner of the previous winners, were: M. V. O'Connell (St. H.) in the 100 yards in 17 1/2 secs.; J. E. Kelly (St. H.) who did not defend the mile championship last year in the four miles in good style; R. Leigh-Wood (Ashfield), who secured a good win in the quarter-mile; Edgerton Pollock, who won the tug of war; and H. R. Seddall (Ashfield) the mile, but time being 4 mins. 51 1/2 secs.

Seddall secured the second half-mile with one hot race, as he beat a race in a very early in the final lap, his feet being lacerated and slightly pulled by the children, but he suffered no serious damage from the hot race, and was successful in his second half-mile. Only one holder who lost, C. W. Call (St. H.) losing his two grand titles. London was too strong for

the 100 yards, and in the tug of war, J. E. Kelly (Ashfield) the A.A.A. quarter-mile champion had a narrow victory in 21 1/2 secs.

EXERCISE MEETINGS.

All the exercises meeting of which only three of the holders attended of retaining their titles but in no instance but one a winner very absent. Capt. Griffith had so difficulty in winning the half-mile, that he was given a good race by H. L. Ewin, the old holder, who was given the half-mile for Cambridge (St. H.) and the 100 yards for Griffith's time was 2 mins. 2 1/2 secs. and his was the A.A.A. champion's title consecutive victory.

The other title holder, he was G. W. Allen (Dunstable) and C.C.I. in the mile cycling event in 2 mins. 47 1/2 secs., and T. F. Huddy (London A.C.) in the hurdles, the distance in the better race, which has hitherto been 200 yards, being reduced to the more usual size of 120 yards. The time was 16 1/2 secs.

The mile was an extraordinary race. H. W. Payne and G. D. Dordall, who dominated last year, both being injured during the contest, and in the end there was a terrific struggle between G. J. W. Hill and B. G. Box, both winners of the 1000 A.C. the former getting home on the goal at the end of 4 1/2 mins. Other new title-holders were: S. A. Gutter (Horse A.C.) in the half-mile (108 sec.); H. G. Higgins (Horse A.C.) in the 200 yards (108 sec.); A. H. G. Pipe (Woodford Green A.C.) in the two miles walk (14 48 1/2); A. L. Scumancer (St. Botolph, Tower Bridge) in the long jump (20 ft. 9 1/2 in.);

S. V. Parnell (Woodford Green) in the quarter-mile (20 2 1/2 sec.) and P. L. F. Thompson (Woodford Green) in the 100 yards (17 1/2 sec.). The three miles was won by H. A. Robinson (Horse Hill Harriers) in 20 1/2 mins. G. C. Connable (Horse A.C.) was not so good as his one and three miles. Parnell and Thompson were second by about eighty yards.

RENT.

The Kent meeting at Chatham was marred chiefly by the reluctance of the young Polytechnic Harriers, H. H. Hooper, and G. H. Hospital athlete, W. Horwood. The former was the 200 yards and 100 yards, and Horwood only retained the title in the long jump and throwing the discus, but also took the high jump and standing high in the weight-putting event. Last year Hodgson the 100 yards in 10 1/2 secs. the fastest time ever recorded in the event, but in this year's championship he did even better and scored double in even time after taking part in a comparatively close-fought race in which he had not been present to win. H. D. Bell (Blackheath) again won the mile; P. Finlay (St. H.) twice secured another win in the weight-putting, and Lunceford G. O. Walsh (St. H.) retained his title in the three miles, in which he beat S. G. E. Albert the Northern constituency champion. L. J. Juddah won the hurdles, J. N. Prosser (Horse Hill) was first in the two miles, A. W. Driver (Woodford Green) won the mile, and H. F. H. Jones (Horse Hill) was the pole jump.

WICKHAMHAM.

Some interesting if not first-class performance were accomplished in the District championship at Wickhamham, for C. B. Roberts (Ashbury) won the five miles and four miles, and another year and made the challenge cup his own property. E. Matthews (Wickhamham) secured his sixth consecutive win in the high jump, and the Vale of Ashbury A.C. won the relay beating Woodford A.C. who had held the title for the past three years.

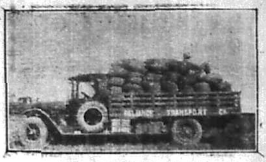

Reeves again won the quarter-mile; Swindon Athletic Club took the relay, and the tug-of-war was won by the Swindon Division of the Wiltshire Constabulary.
