### DEATH OF AN EMPIRE BUILDER.

(Continued from page 1.)

The British sphere south of Tanganyika was transferred to Germany and the Cape Colony north of it to a new German Empire.

Johnson returned to British Cape and Colonial Office in 1891, and remained there until 1895, when he was made a K.C.B. His health having suffered from a long absence from his native country, he was transferred to Tunis as Consul-General in 1897.

Work in Uganda.

In the autumn of 1890 Sir Harry Johnston was dispatched to Uganda on special commission to recognize the administration of the country, and to report on the wishes and feelings of the British settlers and the King's men with the natives.

His two years' work in Uganda and a year in the Congo were rewarded at the close of 1901 with a C.M.G. In the spring of the following year he retired from the consular service.

After 1904 he interested himself greatly in the affairs of the Liberian Republic, and negotiated various agreements with that country, by which order was brought into its finances, the frontier with France was delimited, and the delivery of most of the Liberian territory to C.M.G. In the spring of 1905 he was defeated in a Liberal candidate for Parliament at a by-election at Rochester. He met with an better success at West Marlborough at the General Election of 1906.

His aptitude, industry, and energy were always remarkable, and were especially exhibited at the South African War, in which he was the author of numerous books on Africa, including "British Central Africa" (1897), "The Colonization of Africa" (1902), "The United Provinces" (1902), "Liberia" (1906), "George Grenville and the Congo" (1906).

During his travels in the north-western part of the Congo Free State in 1890 he was instrumental in discovering and naming the lake, a natural gateway allied to the great Nile. His name has been associated with many other discoveries in the African scene and elsewhere.

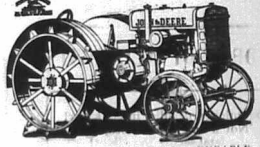

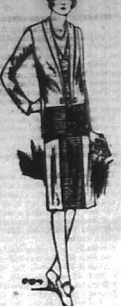

### CUSTOMS AGREEMENT IN EAST AFRICA.

#### Associated Chambers Seek More Complete Union.

#### INTER-COLONIAL ANOMALIES.

At the meeting of the Associated Chambers of Commerce of East Africa, Mr. Freeman-Panell moved: That whilst representing the views of the Inter-Colonial Customs Agreement, this Association and, complete Customs Union and complete Customs Union, this Association is of the opinion that a full and complete Customs Union is desirable as early as possible, and that it be an instruction to the Executive to press for the achievement of this object. Capt. Anderson thought the resolution was too sweeping. By pressing for a full and complete Customs Union they were approaching Federation too rapidly, and would lose the best points of each territory. He was entirely in favour of a Customs Union, but was wondering if they were travelling faster than they might want to go, as a Customs Union was now taking place, and a Customs Union was to follow.

#### The Commercial View.

Mr. Freeman-Panell said that apart from the political aspect of Federation, the commercial community had always endeavoured to attain this end, and he hoped that a commercial union was a similar resolution was passed in 1921 and it was conceivable that even if they did get a full Customs Union, there would be difficulties in fiscal matters. But that was a matter for inter-territorial conferences, and could be dealt with when it arose. He did not think that because duties might have to be altered on a fiscal policy, that this should deter them from philosophically studying the end they had always had in view. Mr. Campbell supported the last speaker. There was one point that was rather curious in the uniform interpretation of the Tariff, that that was that in Tanganyika Kenya which gave rise to misunderstanding. Mr. Wood said he could not put into words what Anderson's point of view. The resolution seemed to be a magnificent thing, and he was in agreement with Tanganyika that stated was: "We will, if possible, to cover the point raised by the Members representing them without the necessity of laying it down that there should be a full and complete Customs Union." Would it not be better

to confer the matter by a united incorporation of customs law. It was not possible to produce what would be better than that had resolution to lead the results of a change of the nature of the Customs Union. The fact that the Association had formerly formed for a Customs Union he felt it his duty to vote in favour of the resolution, but he felt that the full weight would be given to Capt. Anderson's arguments.

Capt. Anderson explained that he was in favour of Federation, and the two were bound up together but when a Commission was appointed to consider the question of unification one particular body should not give away what might be another bargaining point. If the resolution could imply the desirability of a Customs Union, that would be the best. It might mean the end of the "wage" matter for the "wage" instead of "free". Freeman-Panell said he would be glad to amend the resolution to meet the views of the Association. Although the Association had never taken up an attitude regarding the political aspect, it had always pressed for the unification of such services as affecting the commercial community, and the idea of the Association had always been to attain Federation by preliminaries in this respect. He would have thought that the views of the commercial community would have been the nature of "preliminaries" to the Commission rather than a hindrance. It was eventually agreed to alter the word "press" to the resolution to "continue to seek" and the motion was passed unanimously by this form.

#### Uganda Fatalities.

#### INTERIEN SENTENCES FOR NEGLIGENCE DRIVERS.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT). Kampala, Aug. 2. "We have had an epidemic of fatal road accidents in this month mainly due to motor cars running over pedestrians. Last week a driver was accused of five years' imprisonment for side-cutting an Indian woman and running down a motor cycle and killing an Indian woman. A motor cycle was run over and killed a woman in the road who was driving in the same month, but having been released pending the trial. There are several other cases of the same nature awaiting trial and it is hoped that our roads will be made safer for the common people. The breaking of the dangerous bond on the Jingo Road is going to help considerably to lessen the safety of motor cars on this section, but what about the innumerable holes on all our motor roads?"

### BEARING THE COST OF RESEARCH.

#### Nairobi Policy Supported by Associated Chambers.

#### PAYMENT FOR SERVICE.

The Association of E. A. Chambers of Commerce has supported the Nairobi Chamber's view that the Government should pay for research organisations, but that it should be charged for the services arising therefrom.

The first Nairobi resolution on the subject of the annual session of the Association of Chambers of Commerce of Eastern Africa on Thursday afternoon dealt with the question of the provision by Government of services for safeguarding crops and stock.

It was moved by Mr. A. C. Tansill as follows—

That this Association approve the resolutions passed at the Cape Conference in general principle with particular reference to the law which reads: "That in view of the great importance of the Office of Veterinary to the whole community Government should provide sufficient and essential services for the protection of the industry out of general revenue." Provided that it is understood that whilst the cost of research should be paid out of the general revenue of the Colony the cost of the salaries of such individuals who, when taken advantage of, are a charge on the individual and that the principle herein outlined shall be the basis of the Association be applied equally to all industries.

Further that, as and when it may be proved that any industry has come to a healthy and economic basis, the organisation maintained by Government for the special benefit of such industry should be only such as is sufficient to undertake the necessary post-mortem investigations.

#### The Coffee Example.

Mr. Tansill said the great Office Conference which was a most representative gathering had passed a large number of resolutions regarding the safeguarding of the industry generally. The resolution which would involve a cost to the Government of 100,000 per annum plus a capital expenditure of about £100,000. It was agreed that since

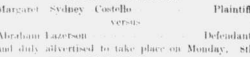
