CONCRETE ON THE FIRM.

No. 4.

Troughs.

Of all the materials which may be used for the construction of troughs, whether feeding troughs or watering troughs, concrete is undoubtedly the most suitable. The following are a few of the reasons why:

Concrete troughs are easily constructed, require no painting, and the instructions can make a

concrete trough without difficulty. They will not shrink or warp when dry, as wooden ones are liable to do. They need no preservative or require no oil coating for upkeep. They do not crack with change of temperature. They are sanitary and easily kept clean. They will not rust or sag so as to practically rot away. The materials for the troughs are, as a rule, easily obtained.

The first essential for a trough intended to hold liquid is that it shall be watertight. This will be secured by using a rich mixture and a clean, well-greased

and suitable aggregate, and by care in placing the material in position.

Aggregate.

Any ordinary aggregate such as gravel and sand which is dug at

well-purged is suitable for this purpose. It must be reasonably clean, that is free from clay, sand, or other foreign matter otherwise the cement will not properly adhere to it. A simple

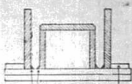


Fig. 5. Transverse section through mould of small trough showing method of providing chamfered edges.

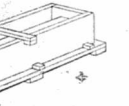


Fig. 4. Mould for construction.

In order for finishing around the core should be slightly tapered and a wire. It provides a shoulder for the edge of the second rod to be attached to the bottom of outer and inner "forms" as shown in the section. Fig. 5. The bridge of the core will be the same as the 1/4 inch trough.

Reinforcement! A rough surface like that illustrated in Fig. 5 would need no reinforcement but the other consideration is in order that the walls may be kept as thin as possible, a heavy reinforcement is necessary. This

If the sides of the trough are more than 18 inches high an additional rod may be placed in the wall midway between those shown in the diagram.

The ends of the reinforcing rods should overlap at least a foot and should be firmly wedged to prevent against the core slipping through the concrete. The reinforcement may be bent at right angles in the form of a hook. If an angle is bent it should be made in such a way as to enclose the trough completely.

The walls of a trough constructed by this method will, as a rule, be 2 1/2 inch thick unless the sides are given a batter or slope, in which case the thickness at the upper edge may be 1 1/2 in. The bottom should be from 2 in. to 3 in. thick according to the capacity of the trough.

Method of Proceeding. Place the "form" in position on the level-board or floor and use that they are secured so that they will not move during concreting.
