CHANGES OF FOUR YEARS.

A "Political Dual Policy" Now Needed in Eastern Africa.

The full text of the White Paper dealing with the Federation Commission Enquiries is given below, except that portion, already published, which deals with the terms of reference.

The document outlines the changes which have taken place in four years since the White Paper of 1918 was published, discussing examination of the possibilities of closer union of the territories.

One of the main objects of the Commission will be to devise a "Political Dual Policy," i.e. (1) to make policy with the necessary majority to occupy in the future, whether it is possible in view of that development to associate the territories more closely in the responsibility of Government; and (2) if federation in any form is feasible, to find out what changes in the powers and composition of the various Legislative Councils.

In any territories, however, it will be essential to maintain the principle that the administration of the territories is based on the exercise by the Government of a trust on behalf of the African population. While they may be prepared to associate with themselves in that trust the members of resident immigrant communities, it is emphasized that the obligation to ensure that the principles of the trusteeship are observed rests upon the Home Government.

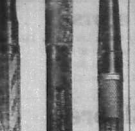

CONCRETE ON THE FARM.

No. 5.

Floors.

The old saying, "A penny saved is a penny gained" is as true today as ever it was. The opposite is equally true. Money spent is money lost. It is a good idea to spend money to save money. No farm is a great money saver and therefore, a great money maker. Profit is largely upon the avoidance of waste and upon the health of the stock, while the latter in its turn depends upon proper feeding, and care in the provision of suitable and sanitary arrangements for the animals.

Every reader of this Journal has probably at some time or other felt the need of a floor that is not difficult to lay, that will not absorb moisture that will not "dead up" that will stand up under whatever traffic it is called upon to bear and that will last at least a life-time. Such a floor is concrete.

When a farmer puts up a building with wooden floors laid either on the ground or post above it, he is, practically, inviting vermin and providing an ideal home for them. For the space under a floor is a favourite breeding place for rats, which not only eat a great deal of food, but are notable vermin-killers. Why, therefore, lay and finish wooden floors when the simple expedient of concrete concrete floor will go far to ward keeping them out also?

Then, saving money, probably made no more abundant. When moisture lies upon the ground, it loses much of its fertilising power since a considerable quantity of the liquid portion is absorbed to the south. Where a concrete floor is adopted for the cow house, the simple expedient of the concrete floor will go far to ward keeping them out also.

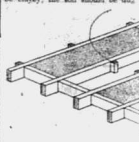
Another advantage to be rapidly discovered is the value of concrete for floors over wooden floors. In other words, concrete is a more durable material than wood. It will last longer, it will stand up under any amount of traffic, it will not rot, it will not be eaten by insects, it will not be damaged by fire, it will not be damaged by water, it will not be damaged by acid, it will not be damaged by alkali, it will not be damaged by any of the common chemicals or oils and

Construction.

It has already been implied that concrete floors are easy to lay. It is simply that money is more wisely spent in any concrete work before has successfully laid a concrete floor by following the instructions carefully and doing his work thoroughly. There is no secret of success.

FOUNDATION: Previous to laying the floor the nature of the soil must be considered. If the ground is dry and firm the only preparation required for the reception of the concrete will be leveling if necessary, ramming, and the removal of all traces of vegetable matter. Should the foundation, however, be sloping, the soil should be dug

not sufficiently deep to allow for a 2 or 3 inch layer of concrete or similar material being rammed on. This will provide drainage under the floor, and upon it the concrete will be laid.

FORMS: Before the concrete can be laid, forms or moulds in position must be provided if necessary. The walls may form the mould or alternatively if necessary it will require a board and four to six inches wide, according to the thickness of the concrete. For ordinary purposes four inches is usually sufficient, but where heavy loads or considerable traffic is expected the thickness should be six inches. The bottom will be laid on edge, and will form a frame to hold the

if the floor is a small one, the whole can be laid in one operation; otherwise, the concrete must be laid in sections. To lay a floor of the small size.

MIXING: All the materials to be used must be laid in the Portland cement and clean sand and crushed stone from 1/2 inch to 3/4 inch. The mixture must be correct. It is a good idea to use a concrete mixer or something that will mix the concrete thoroughly. If a board can be knocked together, a board of this size is available. In this case the proportion should be 1 part by volume cement, 2 parts sand, and 3 parts crushed stone. The sand and cement are first thoroughly mixed, and the whole mixed again. After this

When a hard-working surface is required, the floor may be laid in two courses, the lower course of 4 or 5 inches, and the upper course of 4 or 5 inches, with a wire mesh or a wire fabric between the two. It is important that the wire mesh should be laid immediately after the lower course, and before the upper has set. Where the walls of the building are to serve as the mould, it will be better to lay the floor in alternate strips with spaces between, the latter being used to keep the wet material in place. When the alternate strips are set, the balance can be removed, and the alternate spaces filled with concrete, thus completing the floor. This method is explained by the illustration.

When forms are used, they may be removed after four or five days with the use of ordinary cement, but with rapid-hardening concrete, such as "Fluorec", a period of 24 hours only is required.

CURING

After the removal of the forms, the surface of the floor should be kept damp for about a week. This is often done by covering with sand or earth which is kept constantly wet.

When the water is added gradually, although it may be preferable to mix all the time. More concrete should be laid in one time than can be laid within an hour because, after that time the cement begins to set and cannot be used.

FINISHING: After the foundation has been thoroughly prepared, the mixture should be spread over the floor beginning at one side and working gradually to the other. The upper surface should come just above the level of the forms. As soon as one portion is laid it should be finished. A second concrete is then laid on edge, which, resting on the side forms, should be drawn backwards and made over the surface of the first. This is done over it, which is done with a wooden float. It will bring the lower material to the surface, thus giving a good finish.
