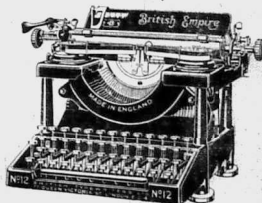

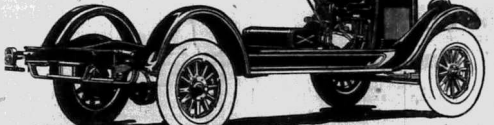

**STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.**

London, Oct. 15.—There was an interesting statement made a few days ago by Mr. W. Ormsby-Gore, M.P., Under-Secretary of State for the Colonies speaking at a luncheon in Surrey which he pointed out that the total East African dependencies were a typical illustration. In 1922 those dependencies brought from twenty-four million pounds' worth of raw materials. Ten years ago those figures were ten and a half millions and five and a half millions respectively, and ten years before that the figures were only three millions and four and a half millions. I asked Mr. Gore how those figures were made up, and I received the following letter from his Secretary:—

# MOTORS TOPICS

## GEARWHEELS IN THE MAKING

**Special Machinery and Careful Design.**

### A DELICATE PROCESS

The production of gearwheels is one of the most important branches of modern engineering. In the careful selection and treatment of the materials and in the accuracy of machining, the standards which govern the work are of a very high order. This will be realized that the production of gear teeth for the special conditions of design, metallurgy, and manufacture.

In addition to the need for being designed to run correctly and to give the desired velocity ratio, gearwheels must also be sufficiently strong to transmit easily the maximum load to which they are likely to be subjected. The friction of the teeth is so designed that when gears are revolving in mesh, only rubbing contact takes place between the teeth.

In theory this need for making rubbing contact as at any time. If a definite area of contact is set up between teeth, sliding takes place and the gears are not then running at their maximum efficiency.

Great care must be exercised in the selection and treatment of the material from which gearwheels are to be made. The two essential properties are strength and wear-resistance. Unfortunately, these qualities are to a certain extent and compromise must be made.

Thus, an alloy steel which will give maximum strength and toughness has not quite ideal wear-resistance and conversely an alloy treated to give the best wear-resistance is rather more liable to breakage.

**Accuracy Machining.**  
The efficiency and smooth running of gear teeth in mesh are entirely dependent upon the accuracy of their machining. The tooth formation must be very

## THE PREPARATION OF STEEL

The preparation of steel is usually indicated by their heat treatment, which must be carried out before delivery. These can be divided into two main groups.

The first group has been treated by manufacturing with a special heat with a bright and finished case. This heat case remains more and denser which the tough wear gear steels.

The second group has been treated by making by special temperature and quenching in oil. This quenching may be carried out in different temperatures, usually to give a desired effect. This is done by tempering the steel in this process. Accordingly, it is satisfactory to make oil-hardening gears as hard on the surface as the case-hardened variety, otherwise they would be too brittle, not having a tough core to strength them.

Oil-hardening gears a compromise has to be reached which will give as hard a surface as possible consistent with the necessary strength.

The manufacture of gears can be divided into five stages. First, the steel to be used is forged roughly to the shape required, a preliminary machining in a lathe, finally, the teeth are cut out of the gear tooth forming machine.

Fourthly, the partially machined gear receives its required heat-treatment, after case-hardening or oil-hardening. Finally, the gear is finished by precision grinding.

The process of forging produces a lump of steel with just the right amount of extra metal for removal by machining. If the gear wheel is to be a plain spur without housing the material can be obtained by sawing pieces of a steel bar of the correct diameter.

## Machining the Blanks.

The forging of blanks is then set up in a lathe, machined all over and a hole bored through the centre. This operation removes all the rough outside skin, but the process of forging will have set up a series of strains in the structure of the metal. These strains are removed by subjecting the metal to a method of heat-treatment called normalizing.

## Gear Shaping.

Gear shaping is carried out upon specially cast iron lathes with provision that the job is replaced by a pinion-shaped cutter which has the same pitch as the teeth. The diameter of the blank is a division particular to the size. Both the gear blank and the pinion are being run.

The next stage in the manufacture of a gearwheel is the finishing of the gear teeth.

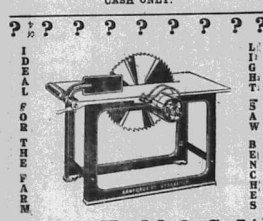
