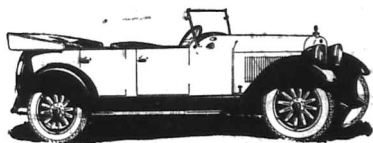

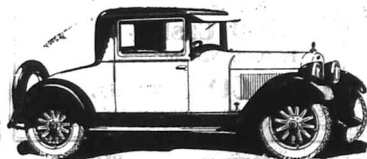

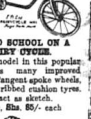

BUTCHERS ALLEGATIONS OF SLAUGHTER HOUSE CONDITIONS.

Animals Killed in the Blood of the Others.

WATCHING THEIR COMPANIONS DIE.

Walking Death in a Pen of Squalor and Filth.

The Nairobi European Butchers who were prosecuted last week in connection with the state of the clothing worn by their employees at the slaughter house have made grave allegations against conditions prevailing there. They say that animals are killed in the blood of the others, that butchers are slaughtered in the sight of each other and that the conditions on the whole are disgusting. 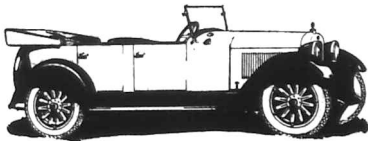

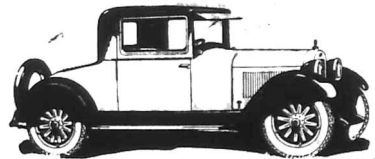

CONSUMPTION OF FUEL IN AMERICAN CARS.

Consumption among the cheapest which have been made in America, according to statistics during the past year is the decrease in average piston displacement.

The average piston displacement of all American-built cars in 1927 is three cubic inches smaller than in 1925. This is not a surfeit of fuel, and yet it indicates the direction in which motor-car designers seem to be moving.

An interesting phase of this reduction in cylinder dimensions is the fact that motor power—that is, the actual developed power at the point of maximum efficiency—has not decreased, but instead has shown an upward tendency.

Automobiles are of the opinion that this indicates an effort and an increase toward fuel economy and general motor efficiency which will result in more generally satisfactory operating costs.

Leading factors in developing increased power from decreased dimensions lie in higher compression and greater speed of piston travel.

With modern force feed lubrication, modern bearing construction, and the modern method of suspending the crankshaft in the motor with extra large bearing surfaces, the increased piston travel becomes a feature of motor efficiency so far as operating economy and efficiency are concerned.

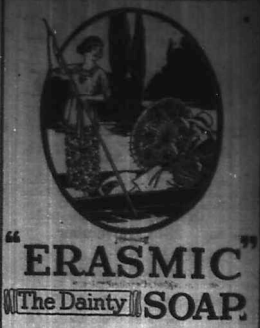

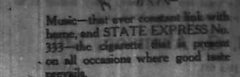
