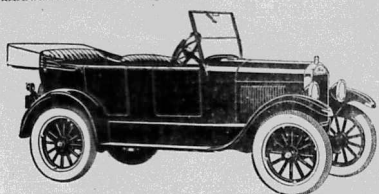

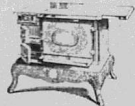

The British Outlook.

Mr. B. H. Llewellyn Jones, Secretary of the Chamber of Commerce, has written in the Outlook for the British Empire, a most interesting and comprehensive survey of the present position of the British Empire, and the future of the Empire, as seen from the British point of view.

He begins by pointing out that the British Empire is not a static entity, but a living organism, which is constantly growing and changing. He then discusses the various factors which are influencing the development of the Empire, such as the growth of industry, the expansion of trade, and the increasing importance of the Empire in world affairs.

He concludes by expressing his confidence that the British Empire will continue to grow and prosper, and that it will play an increasingly important role in the world of the future.

DEFENCE FORCE FOR CHINA

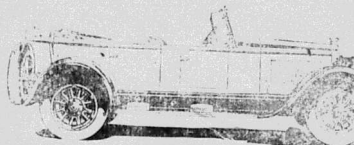

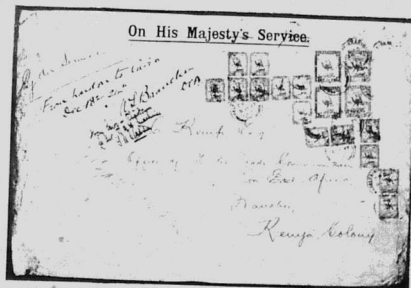

Sefton Branker, Director of Civil Aviation to England and handed to Capt. T. A. Gledhill, who accompanied Sir Sefton Branker on the first flight of the new London-Khartoum Passenger Service as far as Cairo. It was Capt. Gledhill's intention to pass the letter on to his friend, Mr. Kemp, in East Africa. From Cairo Capt. Gledhill proceeded to Khartoum by an R.A.F. machine, but there was a slight accident in the Nile. From Khartoum the letter was posted and sent by rail to Port Sudan and picked up there by the S.S. Osbourne for delivery in East Africa.
