To the Editor, "E. A. Standard." Sir—The day I, as a Christian, and served throughout the whole period of the last War in France and Flanders, and who last for my Services (though proud of them) would not be in the inferior position that I am in today, he permitted through the columns of your paper to air my views on this proposed Defence Force parties, lady in view of the discussion thrown to which I listened at Friday evening's meeting held at the instance of the Town Mayor (Mr. Bidde); and Mr. T. J. O'Shea.

Taking Mr. Bidde's defence against conscription or compulsory service, and to those who advocate a Defence Force on a voluntary basis I would say that many folk who volunteered for active service during the last War did their bit willingly, and sacrificed quite a lot, so doing while the shakers stayed at home—some for numerous reasons—and were in their positions etc. and themselves conscripted—those who were considered eligible for service—although conscription did not apply to Ireland for reasons which I know too well and who would have no hesitation in doing their bit again in defence of their homes and families if the necessity arose. But, if now compelled to join in any conscription or compulsory unit they would rightly be prejudiced and consider it an insult in view of their past service and sacrifice, and would therefore naturally prefer Defence Force raised on a voluntary basis if it was at all possible, provided—

It could be self-sufficient, and that all were conscientious volunteers to see "the thing through," and not "case of any person" when he thought he had had or had enough "having his rifle," and refusing to do any more knowing he was only a volunteer and could not be conscripted to do so unless he wished.

It was at all likely or if there was any reason to believe that all would rally to the call when the call did actually come. Everyone knows there were many conscripts and conscripts during the last War, and there were many of them known to us in our midst, and they even in this Colony, who I have no hesitation in saying would do in a manner of excuse for dropping out at the moment of any such although members of a volunteer force and who may stand as necessary in the right up to the time when duty demanded "action."

An assurance is impossible even though the object is somewhat different to the object of service in the last War.

Not wishing it to be understood that I hold any brief for the Government or for Mr. O'Shea, I would be glad to see any conscription or compulsory service, or any other form of service, if it seems to me to be a better form of defence in a colony whether voluntary or compulsory, in spite of the fact that the subject is a worth twenty pained men.

If such a defence is at all necessary, and any force must have some sort of discipline under its control, it should therefore be compulsory, as unless it is compulsory no soldier in a colony is a very doubtful asset.

That as a means of getting the regular conscripts, "compulsives" and shakers kept to a sense of their duty—if such a compulsory conscription method of service is the only way to do it, and alienationist volunteers should be content to allow the loss and recovery of prejudice against conscription or compulsory service towards that, for otherwise, may a force was raised composed of volunteers—these might be forced to be done by that force and actually lose before any conscript act could be brought into force bringing the shakers in and they would again reap the benefit of the services of the usual volunteers—and preserve a whole skin.

...and it seems to me that, in spite of the very confident conclusions that Lord Ker has arrived at as to the safety of the Tanganyika Territory for the British Empire, some can fairly reasonably doubt the end of the article.

This is, to my mind, as it should be. Neither Mr. Arnold nor Mr. Donald Cameron or any body else can answer for me what the next Government in power may do, and you are at least as well aware as I am of the value to be put on the present state of my opinion.

In the letter part of your article you say: "There is no doubt that the good administration of the Territory and in the developing and opening up of Tanganyika will be legitimate enterprise."

There I have certainly not your own leader, the sentence that I have quoted. I have not your own opinion. The Crown is put in the good position by itself, the League Nations, the African Powers, and that its tenure of control in Tanganyika Territory does not to the administration that Territory by the satisfaction of its superior authority.

It is to this that I believe the capital debt of Tanganyika Territory today, in its present state of development, is incomparably more than Kenya. It is not only advantage that Kenya has over Tanganyika, but that there is in the adjoining Territory.

Even that advantage might be discovered by Mr. Mansfield, who is miles north of Dar-es-Salaam, to the south of the Indian Ocean.

One is aware that the Highlands of Kenya are a charming place to live. But even so, compared with that, in what was formerly called the "New Lands" of Tanganyika north of Lake Nyanza, there is an area suitable for European residence as well as that of Kenya, with the further from the Equator.

The fact is that the definite conclusion is arrived at with regard to the future of the great Territory, which is possibly the most valuable asset obtained by Great Britain as a result of the War.

If the country is to be British, why not say so and name it? Why not say so and name it? The fact is clearly published. All that remains to be done is to name it as a British Territory, and individuals as are getting established there.
