He was the negotiator of the Entente Cordiale with France and Italy in 1904. He was also the Foreign Secretary during the critical period of the British Empire in 1914.

We understand that this station has recently been heard in Victoria. This is claimed as a record, since being for short-wave broadcasting. The station was also clearly heard in the Dutch East Indies, Dutch West Indies, and South Africa.

A regular broadcasting station is now being transmitted on Mondays from 1900 to 2300, Tuesdays from 2000 to 2400, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 1900 to 2300, and on Fridays from 1900 to 2300 G.M.T.

Again from 8.55 a.m.—4.40 on the morning I listened—in to a programme broadcast from K.D.K.A. Pittsburgh; P.A. I have listened on four previous occasions on Mr. Abdul Basheed's car to this station, and have heard a concert so loud and clear.

It is worth it, that it was found preferable to receive the strength to one-third of the total capacity of the set.

The concert comprised a very modern programme, many arrangements, a vocal solo, an Irish jig, a cornet solo, a minute, an instrumental solo, a modern number entitled "The Hunting Field," a happy solo, a Banquet Lullaby Song, and "Door 40" due to the telephone and accompaniment. The concert was followed by the weather reports, after which baseball results were announced. A description of a match in which Buffalo defeated New Orleans, and other interesting players' names, etc. was given early in the evening. At 11.02 p.m. today (Thursday) the announcer stated that it was 5.00 p.m. (Darkest) Saving Time (Windspeed), and had everyone "Goodnight."

Though Mr. Abdul Basheed has been performing American Radio tests for well over two years, I interested in his set, K.D.K.A. in March, 1926, but such was the first occasion on which he has been in the Kenyan Station.
