SURVEY OF EMPIRES MINERAL WEALTH.

Field Trials by a New Method.

(BY WIRELESS.)
Rugby August 12
The announcement that the Australian Government and the Empire Marketing Board have agreed jointly to inaugurate a series of field trials of new geophysical methods for surveying mineral resources throughout the Empire is welcomed by the news public.

In connection with the proposed survey attention is called to the project which Sir Thomas H. Innes will lay before the House of Representatives in the House of Representatives, which opens its second triennial meeting in Canada towards the end of this month.

It is proposed that the Commission which is to be set up among its constituent bodies institutions representing Australia, New Zealand, South Africa and India shall appoint committees of specialists for the purpose of making a review of mineral resources and the smelting and refining capacity of the Dominions and larger colonies.

The Empire's essential data necessary for the formation of a world map for the purpose of an industry should be available as an authority. The map is to be drawn by the British Government and the Empire Marketing Board. It is to be a practical experience confirms their ability to provide valuable adjustments to the work of the British Official Wireless Service.

Daylight Saving.

The favourable reports of the Select Committee appointed in March last to consider the question of Daylight Saving is a triumph of persistence and faith and a striking example of the value of accumulating facts. The Committee has proposed an alteration in Kenya time of half an hour so as same date to be fixed and has come to the conclusion, after examining a variety of evidence, that the manifold advantages of their proposal outweigh the substantial disadvantages. The Report has, of course, to be considered by the Legislative Council and before that there will be an opportunity, if such is now required, to restate any objections to the proposed measure. It is necessary to recall that the principal opposition to the suggestion is consistently advanced by the members for Nairobi South has been the theoretical difficulty which would be placed in the path of the Government by an arbitrary interference with the hours of labour. 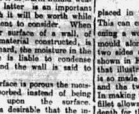

COURT DEFINES CATTLE CONFISCATION

Preventative Not a Punitive Power.

Chief Magistrate, a native, left the Magistrate's office to look for work. He drove before him his cattle, which constituted all his worldly possessions. He passed through three farms and was then arrested for moving cattle without a permit. Under the Diseases of Animals Ordinance.

As a result, he was fined by the Magistrate. He was then ordered to sell the cattle. The value of which was some £240. Mr. H. E. Schwartz appeared before the Supreme Court yesterday to appeal against the order of confiscation. Mr. Justice (The Acting Chief Magistrate) followed this up by the order of selling the cattle. The value of which was some £240.

A Tribunal Offense.
 Mr. Schwartz said the Government was appealing against the conviction against the cattle without a permit, although the natives could have got one easily enough if they had been free from disease, and he was intending to drive them through a 'clean' area. But he had been arrested at the Court, which he said was a violation of the law.

Outcasting Wealth.
 The offense was, at the most, merely technical and he had been fined, but to have his cattle, which constituted the whole of his means, taken away from him was unfair in the extreme. The Government was to be held on Wednesday and he asked for a reversal of the Magistrate's order.

Power Reduced.
 The Court set aside the forfeiture order. Mr. Justice Dickson said that the Government was not to be held responsible for the cattle. The power to confiscate livestock should not be used for punitive purposes only. It should be used only to prevent the spread of disease, no fear of which was present in this case. It is a power entirely distinct from a punitive power. The appeal was allowed, and the Government was ordered to pay the costs of the cattle.

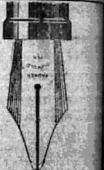
