To The Editor - E. A. Standard.

Mombasa, Tuesday. The session of the Kenya Legislative Council was resumed this morning in the formal and austere main court room in the Members' High Court Building. His Excellency the Governor, Sir Edward Oginga, presided over a somewhat crowded assembly, and in the course of the morning the Member for the Taita sought occasion to voice the regrets expressed by Lord Delamater that unresolvable compromise prevented the Leader of the Elected Members from attending. A few ladies from Mombasa and the wives of British officials who had dutifully accompanied their husbands to the Court sat in a brightly coloured row at the back; a few Indian, Arab, and African groups pressed in the doorway, and the Official and Elected Members faced each other across a narrow table lengthwise of the room which must have given them an impression of uncomfortable narrowness—especially in the case of those lengthy port tables at public banquets. The clock pointed and a suggestion of sah trays and bread and butter followed.

CONTINUANCE OF COOL CONDITIONS.

(STANDARD) CORRESPONDENT.

A West Coast Bombshell.

Incidents of slave conditions anywhere within the Empire has for so long been accepted as a characteristic of British Imperial policy that it is not surprising to learn that recent events in a colony on the West Coast of Africa have discreetly surprised the British Government. We refer, of course, to the extraordinary judgment of the Supreme Court of Sierra Leone the effect of which was to return two run-away slaves to their owners. The matter was first ventilated in Britain by a strong letter which Sir John Simon, a former Home Secretary, wrote to The Times in which he reviewed the facts leading up to the decision adversely referred to. It is well understood at the outset the position of slavery on the West Coast as far as it concerns British Administration. Whilst there is no slavery in the colony of Sierra Leone, it is recognised in the Sierra Leone protectorate where, however, it is subject to control. Recently two slaves escaped from their owners and were recaptured within the protectorate. It either had succeeded in reaching the Colony, the matter would have been without remedy. The slaves appeared for the first time in a public hearing against their owners but the Supreme Court of the Colony by a majority of two to one, reversed the decision on the ground that the owners acted within their rights in regarding possession of their property "by the employment of reasonable force". The dissenting judge, however, took the line that "slavery is repugnant to natural justice, equity and good conscience, and the courts could not support it in any shape or form whether the Legislature expressly forbids it or not".

The course of his letter Sir John Simon declared "It will be lamentable if the chiefs in West Africa are led to believe that they have behind them the support of the highest British authorities for maintaining the system of slave owning". Whatever the deficiencies of the law as applied in West Africa, they can be thought on to view the British Government takes of the matter and that there is to be a very necessary amendment of legislation in Sierra Leone is apparent from the declaration made by Sir Edward Hilson Young when the question was raised in a committee of the League of Nations. West Coast native policy has so long been held up as a pattern to Governments in other parts of Africa and so frequently in recent years has been contrasted with the displacement of the latter that it is curious to say the least of it, that a West Coast Colony with many years of experience in the government of the bay has been in the position of the bay by the family.
