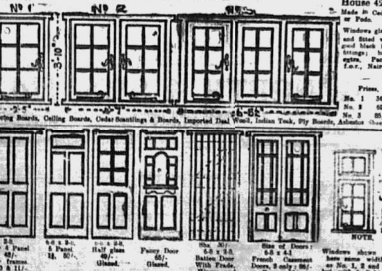

His Excellency the Governor has agreed to receive the deputation appointed by the Nanyuki Farmers' Association to place before him a statement of the advantages attending the extension of the Nyeri branch line to Nanyuki. Besides the fact that Nanyuki is the centre of the extensive wheat lands lying west and north of Mount Kenya, there are other substantial considerations in favour of carrying the line along to the Township.

Mr. Kenya Timber.

The slopes of Mt. Kenya present an abundant supply of valuable timber—cedar, mahogany, podu, mero, olive, etc. A certain amount of this timber has never been sent to Nairobi, but the valuable samples of wood from the Mero Mero Mountains are known—except as samples—out with their immediate districts. SEYCHELLES 1926 TRADE REPORT.

Suggestions for Developing Trade with Kenya.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.
Mr. J. P. Watson, Collector of Customs, says in the Seychelles Trade Report for 1926, that the trade for the year was not so good as in the previous year. The value of the net exports at the end of the year, according to U. K. documents by £1,100,000, and from foreign countries increasing by a 127,000 (in round numbers).
Copra is the principal export, 25 per cent, going to the United Kingdom, 25 per cent. to France, and the remainder to Denmark (Canton Masses, Lower Java), and to other countries. Of the customs on export, 15 per cent. goes to France and the rest to U. K. New Zealand is the next customer of Seychelles for copra taking 4,200 tons (Kenya took 220 tons only).

Arrangements have been made with the Crown Agents in London for the collection of bills sent to them by banks in London on mercantile trading in the Colony.

Imports from British ports were valued at £1,345,000 in value. India topping the list, with £400,000, followed by U. K. £307,000. Kenya runs a bad second with £114,000. From East Africa it is an "also ran," and has to be valued only at £ 228 to be included.

Imports from foreign countries were valued at £487,000. This is an easy feat with its 174,000. It is valued at £1,345,000 (mostly sugar) with £90,000. Another big item is copra valued at £140,000. French produce is valued at £114,000. U. S. A. £10,000, while Germany has £11,000 in its credit, exactly 2 1/2 times that of Kenya.

One of the benefits of Kenya's export covers it may be mentioned that the trade with Kenya from Aden appears to be increasing and satisfactory. EUROPEAN YOUTH ADMITS MISAPPROPRIATING FUNDS

Judge on Imprisonment as a Deterrent.

Justice Justice Sharfstein in the Supreme Court on Monday Alexander Christian (28), lately a clerk, employed in the District Commissioner's Office Nakuru, was charged with criminal breach of trust in that between April 2 and July 1 whilst acting in the capacity of a public servant he misappropriated public funds to the amount of Sh. 244.

Mr. T. Macfarlane appeared for the Crown and the accused, who pleaded "guilty" and who seemed to feel his position amply represented by Mr. Schwartzen.

Comment for the defence pleaded for the Court to exercise discretion and be merciful to the accused. Christian came to the country three years ago and for two years was employed by Messrs. M. B. Elliot and Co. He then joined Government service as a clerk in the District Commissioner's office. He was assailed by temptation on a few occasions and he very luckily succumbed. Comment said he was seized by his client that the latter had no previous convictions; his first indictment was simply committed on the spot of the moment and was followed by two other similar acts. Mr. Marshall, also of the D.C.'s office, found out that something was amiss and asked Christian if he had been taking the books. He did not return. Christian did not hold a letter to Mr. Marshall which was impromptu, as a charging immediate conviction. In the course of the trial Christian spoke of his misdeeds and said the experience would be a lesson to him.

He said that what in their opinion was his only satisfaction, it was also to say that if, taking into consideration that this was his first offence, the Court took a lenient view and did not sentence him to imprisonment, the Salvation Army would undertake to pay his passage home by the first available boat and to be responsible for his upkeep and behaviour until that time.

Judge Christian said that would be a difficult thing to do having regard to the gravity of the offence and the duty which a Judge owed to the public.

Prison Principles

Comment said he realized that the matter was one of considerable difficulty for the Judge but he reminded His Honour that he knew some few months ago in the case of a police officer who pleaded that case the Judge after a very careful consideration exercised his discretion and did not sentence the accused to imprisonment. The result had fully justified the action taken; the officer had been released in the Police Force and had proved completely satisfactory.

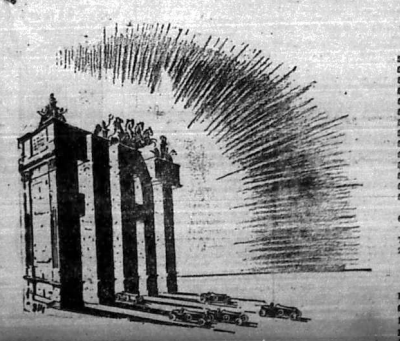

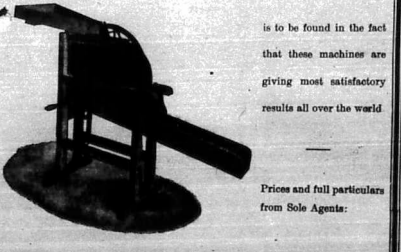
