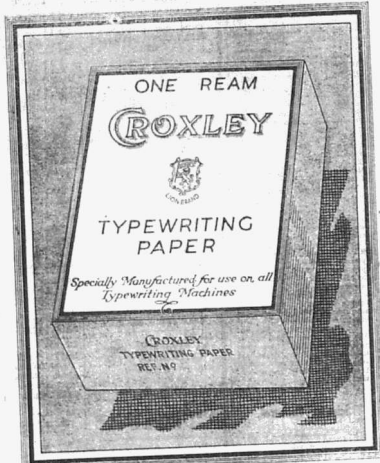

**THE RESULTS OF "ROOM 60."**

How Britain Lined up in German Fleet.

**"AGUACANTO" KEYS.**

Probably the best-kept secret of the War has just been disclosed by the Allied Forces in a lecture at Edinburgh describing the work of the "Room 60" in order to avoid a description of the work and its results. The "Room 60" was a staff of 20 expert cryptanalysts, whose activities were practically unknown, even in official circles of the fleet.

They established numerous "listening stations" to pick up the German Fleet signals, which, with other coded documents, were duly transmitted for decoding to "Room 60" thanks to whose skill the Admiralty knew the German movements before the Digger took and returned and here track of warships, submarines and also the Zeppelins, which were "remarkably impregnable."

Room 60 deciphered the wireless Zimmerman message to Mexico, which finally brought America into the War. The Germans in 1918 changed key to the principal naval signal code at midnight every night, but the Allied Flingers saw that the cryptanalysts were then so expert that the changes did not cause them serious embarrassment. They were reading messages with a new key two to three hours later.

**MUSCOLINI'S BAR ON A TOUR OF THE ATLAS**

Signor Mussolini has serious designs on the map of Europe. As at London identified it does not mean his approval, says the London Daily Chronicle. Recently the Touring Club of Italy, after ten years of waiting, has completed a grand New Atlas. The highest geographical authorities in the country expressed their complete approval of the project.

The Touring Club, therefore, sent a delegation to Rome to present a copy to the King and the President of the Council, the Premier Mussolini.

His Majesty expressed his great pleasure at receiving the gift, but Signor Mussolini would not even receive the delegation.

**The Duce Displeased.**

Signor Mussolini cannot do the game to be informed that the Atlas must be withdrawn from circulation and considerably altered.

After a lot of trouble the delegation was received by one of 11 Duce's Under-Secretaries.

"Your Atlas," said this functionary, speaking for his chief, "is a dangerous piece of French propaganda in the mouths of Jews and Poles," in N.W. Italy. That is incorrect.

"In the Trentino," he went on, "we represented an Italian district for some time at Salorno. That is not true."

"You place Slavs at the gates of Trento. That is false."

"The latter place are in the region 'redeemed' from Austria-Hungary and called so the day Italy after the war."

"We did these things on the authority of the last official census."

"That census," said the official, "was made by a Liberal Government. But that is not all."

"There are too many Slav names in Italy."

"And in the map of the Balkans you have forgotten the Montenegrins."

"But the Montenegrins no longer exist as such."

"They do exist—because 11 Duce says so," was the final remark.

So the Atlas will be withdrawn and frontiers, maps and ethnic groups will have to meet the views of Signor Mussolini.

placed on Government, may tend to encourage the Civil Servant to give to the interest of those communities a weight of consideration which is definitely unhelpful in the free development of balanced thought. Yet that responsibility is forced upon them by the ability of the settler to follow his own course untrammelled. These are considerations which both the Servant and the settler community must take into account when they examine their relationships and seek to improve them. Actually both the Servant and the settler practice the same responsibility in the development of the Colony and past time. The only difference is that his position and character, by his work, is to give to the Civil Servant an undue share of that responsibility, a share which we hope to be equalled by appreciation by the settler of the significance of past history and the possible character of future change. In one way we may look for assistance. The importance of the scheme which is to provide for the settlement on the land of retired Civil Servants has often been stated to be generous to those who have given long service in his interests. And it is in view of this that the Civil Servant will thereby provide for those who over many years have accumulated a vast and varied store of practical knowledge and the quality of self-discipline and self-restraint which they are competent to find in the public work of the country. To the settler in the land and abroad outlook on the Civil Servant there are many well qualified to contribute their responsibility. In doing so they will benefit the settler and the public alike.

The Civil Service. The Civil Service of Kenya emerges usually from its isolation and complete isolation when the Association of the European members holds its annual meeting. On such occasions the Executive Director of the Colony and the Association and the Association in turn return to their private life. The old and social antagonism between the official and the settler is rapidly disappearing and would be further dispensed of that is not in itself a sufficient reason for antagonism. The settler pursues a plain course led often by the instincts of his self-interest. Occasionally, and with greater frequency in late years, he turns aside and realizes that his course crosses those followed by his competitors. But until that responsibility is placed upon the settler he is likely to continue to choose his own path to his objective. The objective may be a right and laudable one, although the approach is dubious and badly guided. The Civil Servant, on the other hand, suffers from the absence of complete freedom. His service is guided by considerations and decisions which are outside his own control. He has a certain protection for the settler which is not afforded to the settler and within the safety of this protection his self-interest and self-assertion are less necessary qualities. But the system has its disadvantages. Discipline in the mass and repression of individualism, the repression of the personal factor and the fixed grading of responsibility do not impel the Civil Servant to enter into the public work of the country. The "settler" is in the opposite direction. There is in fact a definite gap between the two. The Civil Servant has only one word and remains on the public work itself. ## MOTOR TOPICS

THE INNER TUBE. Anglo-Perian Oil. A War Veteran.

Description of its Manufacture.

### ITS VARIOUS STAGES

Although it does not work humbly and unobtrusively, the motor-tube tyre is the important and indispensable ally of the motor-car. It is not destined to have any partner; it is to receive abuse, yet without it never gets any praise; it is the first to receive abuse, yet without it the motor-car would be completely useless.

### VALUE OF GOVERNMENT'S HOLDING

In the House of Commons recently Sir F. Nelson asked the Chancellor of the Exchequer the amount of royalties paid by the Anglo-Perian Oil Company to the Persian Government for 1919, and whether there was any likelihood of a revision of the agreement between the Company and the Persian Government.

In answer, Mr. Churchill said the royalties paid in 1920 amounted to £1,000,000. As to the second part of the question he understood no question of a revision of the agreement.

Further replies to Sir F. Nelson, Mr. Churchill said that the original cost of the building of the Anglo-Perian Oil Company was £1,000,000 and the value today of the Government was pledged not to interfere in the commercial management of the Company.

The "soldier" was one of about 4,000 members of the A.E.F. that sailed on in France after the war ended, finding work there that they were finally fitted to do and so successfully serve as in the war.

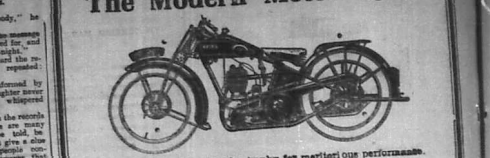
