Famine in Uganda.

5,000 CATTLE DIED IN A WEEK IN UGANDA.

A deplorable situation involving an immense food and water famine and widespread disease amongst cattle is reported by the Uganda News to have occurred in the two districts over 8,000 cattle, it is stated, have died in one week, and the death rate is increasing, wherever they are in contact with the disease.

The Veterinary Department, in conjunction with the assistance of the police patrol, are endeavoring to prevent the movement of cattle from the infected areas. To do so the Government has already received a number of reports from the districts.

The Government are fully alive to the seriousness of the position, and no stone is being left unturned which would in any way help towards alleviation of the suffering.

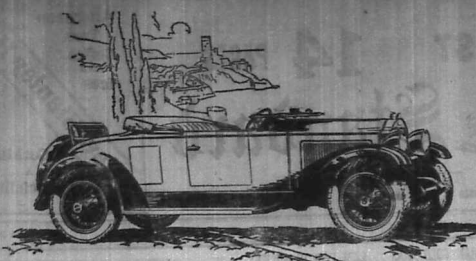

### NEW KIND OF MARRIAGE SYSTEM

Heavy Cannon by Lack of Knowledge.

#### PARAN SYSTEM

"Attention for marriage" was the subject of an address by Captain P. H. Rivers to the Regent's Society at the recent annual conference of matrimonial agencies, held at "Queens" College, London.

"A woman," he said, "is naturally late in the supposedly scientific age, this regulation of marriage is essentially being undertaken or advanced by persons who agree on an ideal specimen of the most satisfactory type, the biological and psychological conditions have laboriously accumulated."

"I take it that there are few among those who think at all who would dare to suggest that there is not something disturbing and unhealthy in our present regulation of the marriage slide. Inauguration of the New Secondary School.

A NOTABLE SIGN

His Excellency's Speech at the Laying of the Foundation Stone.

An important step in the direction of improving facilities for the higher education of the many Indian children in Kenya was taken yesterday when His Excellency the Governor laid the foundation stone of the new secondary school.

Within recent times the Indian community and the people of Indian blood have placed in increasing importance upon the advantages and necessity of education.

In the course of his remarks His Excellency said the inauguration of this school is a notable sign of the progress of the Indian community in Kenya.

NEEDS OF THE FUTURE.

The initial ceremony in connection with the building of the new Government Indian school, Ngera Road, Nairobi, took place yesterday, when Sir Edward Greig, in the presence of a large gathering of members of the European and Indian communities, and the members of the Education Commission, presided.

Appreciating the importance of the school as a milestone in the advancement of their educational facilities, the members of the school were all present. It was noted that when the pupils returned to India they were able to take high places in the playing fields, the English language, they could read the books of the great writers in their mother tongue.

His Excellency was accompanied by Lord Kenilworth, the Hon. Director of Education, Mr. J. R. Orr, the Hon. Director of Public Works, the Hon. Director of Education, who opened the proceedings referred to His Excellency's presence in the enlightenment and progress of the Indian community and the interest which the Government displayed in education in Kenya.

They all had an excellent opportunity of the fact that no building had ever been better constructed and deemed that this new building was deserved by the Indian community.

A Pioneer.

On reviewing the history of Indian education in Kenya, the Hon. Director said that from the first came to the Colony in 1811, he was told by His Excellency the Governor, Mr. P. C. Glenard, that two masters had been provided for Indian children in Nairobi, but that these were not sufficient to meet the needs of the Indian community. He stated that he had been very active in the subject. He visited the school and found that there were only seven pupils. "I advised the Governor to treat the Indian children in Nairobi to one who should be a pioneer for his own people."

"Nothing has given us more pleasure during our 17 years' experience in Kenya than to see the progress of the Indian community," remarked Mr. Orr. "I am glad to see that the school would provide 400 pupils. This is a great step forward. A spacious assembly hall, a large hall for dancing and sports, and a well-ventilated building, these are the things that we have to look for in the future."

But the best day funds were not so available for education as they have been recently and at the school year as rapidly.

## Easy Starting THE RIGHT WAY TO OBTAIN IT.

A lot of drivers are continually vexed, with starting trouble. They blame this inability to start on the engine, whereas it is none other than the driver himself.

Here is the right way to do it. First remember that petrol taken from the evaporator into a cold engine will not vaporize as readily as normally. Pull it out to its starting bottle. Also depress the clutch pedal, so that the starter will spread the labour of turning over the transmission gears through the soft grass. Put the clutch lever in the midway position, the best control lever if any.

Do not use the engine without the clutch being in about half way. Leave the choke as nearly as possible without starting the engine, and then push it completely in as soon as the engine will start without stuttering.

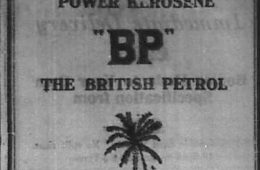

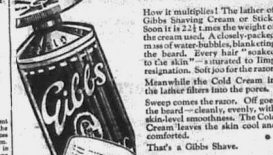

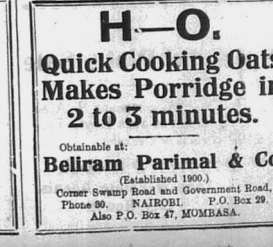
