ITALIAN MINISTER IN VIENNA RECALLED TO ROME.

Alleged Oppression of Austrians in South Tyrol.

SEQUEL TO CHANCELLOR'S APPEAL.

Mussolini Takes Steps to Obtain First Hand Knowledge.

The Italian Minister in Vienna, the Austrian Capital, has been recalled to Rome.

It is believed that Signor Mussolini has done so in order that his Minister may present a report regarding conditions in the South Tyrol district where the Austrian Government alleges that the Italians are oppressing the Austrian minority.

After the war, Italy gained certain areas of the former Austria-Hungary, including part of the South Tyrol and the Trentino and in those ceded areas a number of conquered Austrians still reside.

It is not anticipated in Austria that the incident means a breach of relations between Italy and Austria.

NO BREACH EXPECTED.

The German High Commissioner in Vienna, February 24, in a special edition gives currency to the report that Signor Mussolini has decided to recall the Italian Minister to Vienna.

The action is a sequel to a report from the Austrian Chamber of Deputies, which alleged oppression of the Austrian minority in the South Tyrol.

The Chancellor, Dr. Seipel, is, it is reported, expected to return to the world in this connection.

Tokio, Feb. 24.
With a deafening roar and a terrific explosion, the famous volcano broke into eruption yesterday afternoon for the first time for eight years.

Large boulders were hurled down from the crater. The property in the surrounding villages has been severely damaged and the inhabitants are terrified.

Up to the present no casualties are recorded.

The greatest eruption of Aniakchak in 1783 when a large lava flow destroyed an entire town and overwhelmed several villages. The present one is the largest portion of two consecutive eruptions.

MOTOR TOPICS

THE WORLD'S MOTOR SPEED RECORD.

Description of the Car.

MAYER-CAMPBELL RACER.

It will go with our totally different in appearance from anything previously produced that Capt. Malcolm Campbell will soon attempt to establish himself as the holder of the world's speed against a formidable gathering of American racers, says the Motor.

When we first saw the car at a small private test, we were impressed by its revolutionary appearance. Fully streamlined, it has an almost horizontal front end and tapering off to a pointed tail accompanied by a huge semi-circular tailfin. The cockpit in which the driver sits resembles that of a racing aeroplane and is reached by means of two sliding panels.

To anyone who admits opportunity in design the Mayer-Campbell racer is a very stimulating prospect. Thoroughly independent, Capt. Campbell has thrown aside conventional methods, with the result that his latest production not only looks absolutely new, but is very obviously the type of motor which the speed-ster, if he is to be avoided. Indeed, when one looks at the whole job, designed from start to finish as a real motorcar, one hesitates whether to ascribe most credit to the originality and newness with which the machine was carried out, or over the ingenuity and no less original layout of the chassis.

Actually comes below the centre line of the chassis. The number of which are made out of solid magnesium machined throughout, are used, while the engine is supported on a sub-frame made of magnesium principles to the chassis and suspended at three points by means of spherical joints.

The chassis frame was made at Messrs. Vickers' River Don. Works from their special material. Designed by Mr. C. Archibald Vickers and made under the supervision of Mr. J. Main, the frame is built up beneath the rear axle to provide a very low centre of gravity, which

is borne upon the four main suspension springs, an enormous increase in power has been obtained by various modifications in design which must, for the time being remain a secret of the Air Ministry. Let it suffice that the engine is similar in almost every respect to that fitted to the machine with which Flight-Lieut. Webster won the Schneider Trophy at Venice at a speed of 295.000 m.p.h. Special permission has had to be obtained from the Air Ministry for the use of this engine by Capt. Malcolm Campbell. When the time comes for the power developed and the low weight of the unit to be developed, the general public will realize what amazing strides in aero engine construction have been made by Messrs. D. Napier and Son, Ltd.

In its essential features the Napier engine is a very compact 12 cylinder unit, the cylinders being arranged in three blocks of four. The centre block is vertical, the other two being disposed at an angle of 60 degrees. The bore and stroke are 4 1/2 in. by 5 1/2 in. (110 mm. by 130 mm.), so that the capacity is 22.200 cc. The Transaxle rating is 144 h.p., but the actual brake power developed is in fact more than 100 h.p. at 2,500 r.p.m. It is similar unit in 1925 developed 70 h.p. while those that a very considerable increase in power has been obtained.

Overhead valves operated by means of camshafts are employed, whilst the crankshaft is of the four-stroke type, each crankpin being operated by three connecting rods. We are informed that the new engine develops nearly twice the horsepower of that fitted to the original Schneider Trophy. The power output of this new 400 h.p. engine is 300 h.p. at 2,500 r.p.m. The average horsepower of 1925 is in the neighbourhood of 100 h.p. The four-cylinder engine is fitted with the forward end of the engine, two bearings being disposed at the rear. Naturally a very special transmission system has had to be devised to transmit the enormous power of the engine. Consequently a kind of dry multiple type is used, having 10 gears, comprising a fixed with Knappe, while the other three have a range diameter of 11 1/2 in. The whole of the clutch with the double joint is mounted on the crankshaft and is normally uncoupled, whilst the driving member is formed by the centre of the clutch on which an arrangement of metal teeth point on the inner diameter is mounted. When the main cross-shaft of the chassis frame is uncoupled a splined shaft is shifted along axially, thus to the shaft. The intermediate shaft is mounted direct on the front of the primary shaft of the gearbox.

American Tourists.

A band of hundred per cent Englishmen today on an all too brief stay. For the first time in the centre of white settlement in Eastern Africa, and the field of many of the most important social experiments in the British Empire, is thus included in an organized sight-seeing. It is not to be anticipated that the American tourists will have much opportunity for even distant acquaintance with any of the problems of the East Africa and all they may be expected to carry away will be a permanent impression of the vitality of a country in the making and of diversified charms and attractions from the wild life of the great plains, the industry and promise of organized agriculture both European and African, and the business bustle of the small traders in the streets of the towns of Nairobi. They may be so much to indicate some of them to return back or to find a new field of labor for younger ones. Kenya does not regard tourists as a source of revenue and personal expenditure but rather as an opportunity afforded to become acquainted, con-

dent, that from that acquaintance arise a finer friendship. The visitors will find that American business has a stake in the country that American business and American manufacturers play a not unimportant part in the life of the Colony and that the fruitful soil of East Africa provides something essential to American prosperity. We note the occasion because it is a new point of contact. Thoughtful Americans sometimes deplore the fact that the tourist is accepted faintly as the indicator of the life of the country from which they come and that may be true to a degree although it is not a light easily won. American tourists who have them accept a native liaison as the symbol of the African. It seems to us to be a gratifying fact that this form of contact is being replaced by something more permanent, more useful and more progressive which should be brought before the notice of the casual tourist unless there is to be created a false impression of the work of the Empire in Africa. We would ask those Americans during their brief stay to use their acute sense of proportion. If they do so they will leave Kenya with impressions far removed from those suggested by the crude barbarism of African days—familiarly obsolete.

The Agricultural

As a few days ago we discussed attention to the extraordinary position created by the absence of

the two respectable chief officers in the Agricultural Department of the Kenya Government. The situation is apparently even more remarkable. Mr. Harrison, the Deputy Director left on a hurried visit to Rhodesia to study the Land Bank system and he is intended, if possible, to get into touch with Mr. Herold the head of the South African Land Bank organization. It now remains the Director of Agriculture. Mr. Alex Holm, was expected to leave England on the return to Kenya at the beginning of this month for South Africa. Furthermore, while in South Africa it is the intention, on behalf of Government to invest in the purchase of Land Bank and if possible to meet Mr. Herold. Not only is the Department deprived of its responsible officers but if the information is correct—and there is no reason to doubt it—both are engaged on the same job. There is something behind the position. We believe there is an intention on the part of Government of raising a post of Land Bank organization for the present Deputy Director of Agriculture and that is the main reason of his Rhodesian tour. But the whole situation demands explanation and it is to be expected that an early opportunity will be sought to advise Government the chance to explain. We should imagine that a simple answer to a simple question may not be so easy as it looks.

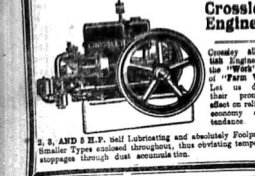

WAGES OF THE COAST DOMESTIC SERVANTS.

A Higher Average Than the Highlands.

A KEPT RECORD.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.)
 In connection with the Standard estimates of what native domestic employees such as Nairobi, it is interesting to compare this with the Coast rates.

The Coast here is, in fact, more highly paid than the Nairobi centers. It might surprise the layman in the Highlands to know that in Mombasa, for example, the housewife cannot get a cook for less than 60/- per month. This might be taken as the average. Perhaps it could put the average at 50/- per month for ordinary house boys, their services are valued at 40/- per month on the Coast. This too, must be taken as being on the lowest scale. Certainly, many people pay their boys 60/- and 50/- per month, and the tendency is to rise for the year.

Why, even the humble attendant of the Coast takes his wages for as his natural share, will show that this evolution is a very rapid one, and it is not long that they are out of the field.

Bank Betting

In Mombasa street of account, there is some reason for the comparatively high wages. In the Mombasa and Indian Isles have no very quiet. The result is that the boys have to stay in lodging.

These lodgings are very expensive. The native's habit of spending his own property, especially his wages, is not a very commendable one. He often spends his wages on the other day, and that he paid 10/- per month for a small house which he shared with another worker. And this, he is not a man of much wealth with a small house and one of the ordinary or superior in ordinary comfort. Small wonder that the domestic servants are not a very high wage. The average rate charged may be taken as about 10/- per month for a share of a miserable room. Those who want a room to themselves to live in over their more comfortable homes have to pay more.

NEW GENERAL GOVERNMENT AT THE EAST AFRICAN.

An East African House that has been known in London and elsewhere, according to the news from the East African House.

THE WORLD'S MOTOR SPEED RECORD.

Description of the Car.

HASTIE-CAMPBELL RACER.

(Continued from yesterday.)

The rear axle is designed that the axles and hubs are independently supported, so as to be unaffected by any deformation of the aluminium rear axle casing. The front drive of the bottom crank type, lost is well noticed that the ratio is now 12 to 1 instead of 1.37 to 1, from which it may be deduced that the new engine develops its maximum power at a considerably higher rate of revolutions per minute. It is made in two pieces joined in the middle by a substantial G-section. Ridge-Whitworth Ltd., by what is called an air streamlining of the standard "wind" was necessary. The wheels were subjected to heavy impacts and great torsion stresses and were found to remain undamaged under loads far in excess of those which it is calculated will be met in actual running.
