Fattened for Marriage: Women Police.

EXTRAORDINARY CUSTOM GUARANTY A WORDY WARFARE IN BIRMINGHAM

In Akaka, Uganda, a bridegroom is fed before marriage for years on milk with the sole object of adding to her weight. The other day an Akaka bride, was quite unable to stand because of her size.

The custom is thus described by a correspondent in the Uganda Herald: "The bride, a girl of fifteen, unable to stand, because of her enormous size, was obliged to be carried in a basket with staffs (not to mention a number of other people's) back to the house in the proceedings, only being raised and supported with considerable difficulty when the bridegroom, a little man for his kind and respected here, is out the wedding night."

The Akaka custom of fattening bridegrooms is much to be deplored.

For years before marriage girls are kept within their parents' huts and breast fed. Milk is practically the sole diet, and their persons upon the beds to be at all hours of the day and night. No exercise is allowed, and no wash.

The only form of admission permitted is rubbing with olive. The water which some young brides obtain a correspondent must reach the foot, 14 to 18 stone.

Much may be said for the practice, but a system which induces the excessive obesity of a bride, and complete debilitation and mental abnormality, and mental distress might well be considered abandoned.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.) London, Feb. 19th. "Wordy warfare is proceeding at Birmingham between the townsmen and the Chief Constable (Mr. Charles Butler) on the question of women police. Speaking at a public meeting, Messrs. Edith Tennant, chairman of the committee on women police of the National Council of Women, and the Chief Constable, replying by letter to one of their speakers, said he did not see why women police should be sworn in on the uniform. One reply to him, she said, "as there are no men who should go back on what the Home Secretary had said, but down—that women should be sworn in as police officers, and that they could be sworn in."

Mr. Tennant contended that preventive and detective work it was essential that women police should wear uniform.

Discussing the matter, the Chairman Butler said: "Our women police are not sworn in. We do not think it is necessary, not advisable. I contended that it is better to have a uniform of effective and convenient work when there is no occasion, and that has not the power of arrest. A woman speaker remarks, 'well, as far as to say that a police woman was just as able as a policeman to arrest a drunken man.' That reply makes one smile. In Birmingham, I prefer the policeman to be looked upon in a sense as the policeman of people who were in need of help or attention. If they were doing something wrong, on suspicion we hear they would not be regarded in their line of the moment. They have very delicate duties to perform, and they are better able to perform these with out the uniform, than those who contact robbery that they are to be feared. If women started arresting men, with I don't know what would be the result."

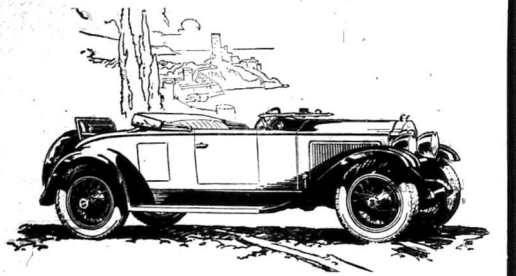

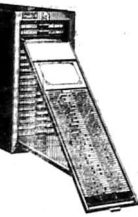

AIR FORCE AND K.A.R. IN CO-OPERATION.

Military Manoeuvres Carried out Yesterday.

EARLY MORNING OPERATIONS.

Kenya Troops Compete for Wing Commander Samson's Cup.

An interesting example of co-operation between air and land forces was provided in Nairobi yesterday, when the 3rd King's African Rifles carried out manoeuvres with two R.A.F. machines.

The "battle" took place, as last year, on the plain below the ridge occupied by the Supply and Transport Depot of the K.A.R. and the "attack" on and defence" of Nairobi was a most interesting spectacle.

FEATURES OF WELL STAGED "BATTLE".

PROTEST MEETING. Permission to Reside on Best Business Plots.

Two-people Site Danger from Asan Baza Conditions.

(FROM A CORRESPONDENT.) The strong feeling existing in connection with the matter was shown at the meeting called at Nakuru last Saturday to protest against the removal of the residential restriction in the first-class business area.

Germany and the Mandate.

THE SPECIAL PROVISION OF THE MANDATE. Following on recent references in Germany to the Great League of Nations, Mr. J. Lippert has written to the Daily Telegraph regarding the provisions of the mandate which give powers to the mandatory Power to legislate.

His letter reads: With reference to your Berlin Communist's telegram, printed in today's Standard, regarding the special provisions in the Mandate under an East African Mandate under his own sovereignty, I have written to the following fact: The Tanganyika Mandate expressly makes provision for the eventual inclusion of Tanganyika in an East African Union or Federation. Article 10 of the Mandate reads: The mandatory shall be authorized to constitute the territory into a Customs, Fiscal and Administrative Union or Federation with the adjacent territories under his own sovereignty or control, provided always that such union or federation is not so organized as to deprive the people of the territory of their rights of citizenship.

It is therefore ridiculous for Herr Schuch to suggest that the people of Tanganyika should be taken into the German Empire. Dr. Stresemann's opinion is that the German Government should do all possible to bring about a union with the adjacent territories. 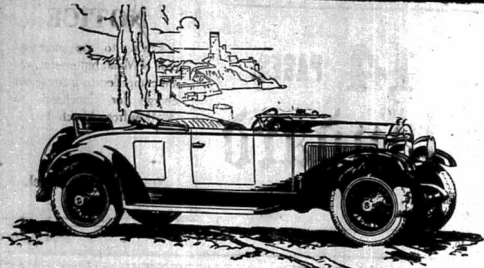

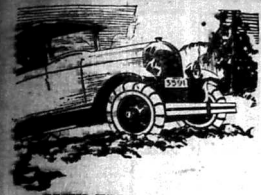

DRIVERS' TESTS.

Obtaining a Licence in America.

A DIFFICULT TASK

You can't get a driving license in the United States except by passing a dollar over a post office counter. That's one traffic red America doesn't take. You've got to know how to drive—don't you see?

The system of motor driving tests as it operates in Pasadena, California—the procedure where so many of the film stars have their initial lessons—knows, to use it may serve as typical of the United States generally.

When, as a raw novice to motoring, you've bought your Ford, your Overland, or your Ford, the first step is to apply for a temporary driving license. This entitles you to drive for a month—always provided you take along in the front seat with you a fully-licensed driver.

Your month of probation over, you'll be asked to bring your car along to police headquarters. The temporary permit is then demanded, shown and the examination proper begun.

The First Test.

Like most examinations, it is partly oral, partly practical. First of all you undergo the motorist's question, the examiner being of numerous questions of this sort—

"How fast should you drive on the open highway? (40-75 miles per hour)"

"How fast in the city limits?" (Twenty miles per hour)

"How far all you may follow a few engines?" (That is a police trap—you mustn't follow a foreigner at all.)

At the same time he'll be "watching like a cat" to see you make the right signals everywhere. He'll draw the picture of the car first at a place where there's a right-of-way sign, and then at a just the most at the curb's.

When he's satisfied that you know the rules of the road as a general way, he'll begin popping questions. "Suppose that car ahead stops suddenly, what would you do?" Suppose it turns to the left—what gives a right-hand signal?" And so on.

Then pulling up smoothly at the place from which you started, you will have the right to enter and pocket a grand automobile. The temporary permit is then demanded, shown and the examination proper begun.
