FAMOUS AIRMAN'S FATAL DIVE INTO SEA.

About to Attempt New Speed Record.

London, March 12. Lieutenant Kinkead, one of the British aviators who won the Schneider Trophy at Venice has been at Calicut in Southamton Water for some time now preparing to attempt to beat the world's air speed record on a Supermarine Napier Seaplane.

When he started the flight to-day his machine dived into the sea and disappeared.

Up to the present no trace of the machine has been found.

Later, from the time of striking the water like a gunshot no trace of Flight-Lieutenant Kinkead's machine has been found.

It has been definitely established that the airman has been killed.

Disturbances, Reply. In the Schneider Trophy held at the Lido last year Flight-Lieutenant Kinkead's Supermarine Napier V. biplane returned from the race.

Flight-Lieutenant R. M. Kinkead, D.S.O., D.S.C., D.F.C., R.A.F., was born in February 1897 and was a South African. He was educated at the High School Johannesburg and at the Market School.

He joined the R.A.F. as a Pilot Officer in September, 1915. During the war he was flying over the Danube for a year and he was shot down during 1917-1918.

He was responsible for the greatest feat in the history of the Royal Air Force in connection with the Schneider Trophy race, which he won in 1924.

He was promoted Flight-Lieutenant in January 1922. The services for which he has been decorated were flying in an Aviator's role.

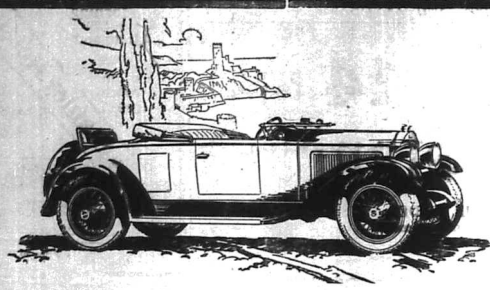

A MAKER OF MODERN INDIA.

What Gokhale Did for His Country.

VALUE OF COMPROMISE.

"Gokhale—the apostle of honourable and legitimate compromise."

There was how Mr. Sastri, Agent for India in South Africa, speaking in Cape Town yesterday of the life and work of one of India's greatest men, who died 18 years ago.

Dr. K. Ghoshal was one of the makers of modern India, declared Mr. Sastri. He lived and died in Poona, a city of the Bombay Presidency, with a population of over 175,000. Among the "states of India," Poona stood pre-eminent in the manifestation of public spirit and self-sacrifice of a practical nature. It was a city of plain living and high thinking, while the Brahmins were renowned for their learning—and poverty.

Poona had fine colleges, staffed entirely by Indians who accepted salaries of about £2 per month with the object of counteracting what was considered in India one of the disadvantages of modern education—the dearth of money. Into Poona's best institutions, therefore, were the idealists of people who were financially poor but eminently fitted by nature to receive the highest possible education. There was also the Widows' Home, whose students were brought up to the standards of Arts, medicine, and the Servants of India Society, founded on the principle of self-sacrifice.

After graduating Gokhale worked for 20 years in one of Poona's colleges, first as professor of mathematics, and later, as professor of English.

Proving His Character.

Gokhale in 1867 went to England to give evidence before a commission of inquiry into public expenditure in India. While there, he published letters, revealing to him from India regarding the alleged harsh methods of British soldiers engaged in pulling down Indian temples, at that time working hard in Poona. Returning to India, Gokhale was asked to substantiate the charges, but his correspondents begged him to abstain from public exposure. Immediately, he published a full and handsome apology, not counting to accord due credit to the efforts of the soldiers. The action

brought him into great esteem with the Indian people, but he would have died this dawn by doing noble work in the Indian arena.

In 1905 Gokhale founded the Servants of India Society to participate in work for the Indian people. Two years later came a great event in his life when one school of thought demanded complete emancipation of India from the British Empire. Although soaring popularity, Gokhale made up his mind to undergo any risks in order to stem the tide of anti-British feeling, for he believed the British occupation was, on the whole, of great benefit to India.

Accordingly, Gokhale pursued his campaign through the United Provinces, emphasizing the enormous value of the protection and peace secured by British occupation. An earlier great service he did for his country was to induce the British to bring the real India to the notice of the public. This led to an invaluable piece of reform in India in the shape of the establishment of the first electoral system, for which Lord Morley was responsible.

In South Africa.

Logic in politics was absorbed by Gokhale, who believed in the principle of "live and let live," and he was looked upon as the apostle of modern Liberalism. Among all his public speeches, none were read louder with such attention by young aspirant politicians as his eight speeches on each succeeding Budget.

In 1912 he was attracted to South Africa by the earnest invitation of Gandhi, then engaged in his "passive resistance" campaign. Gandhi and Mr. Sastri, were the leading spirits of the party and Gokhale, in the course of his visit, was in possession of his complete mastery over his passions. There is no doubt with him felt a kind of spiritual influence coming out of him and inspiring them.

Working together in South Africa Gandhi and Gokhale were severely criticised for the part they took in changing the attitude of Indians. Gandhi claiming that Indians as Britishers, were entitled to full citizenship. On the other hand, Gokhale managed the settlement of the Indian immigration question by compromise which was bitterly resented, and for the rest of his life he had to endure the charge that he had sold the birth-right of India on South African soil.

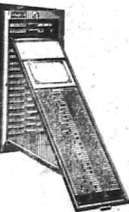

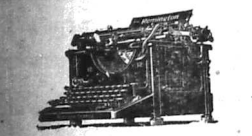

**CAZAR'S DAUGHTERS
ESCAPE FROM MASSACRE.**

IDENTITY MYSTERY.
Is She the Grand Duchess Anastasia?
Said to be Married to a Young Soldier in Rumania.

The son of the physician to the Russian Imperial Family, Mr. Giles Bodkin, is awaiting on behalf of Mrs. William Leeds, who is residing in the West Indies, to witness the mysterious arrival from Germany who claims to be Princess Anastasia, the youngest daughter of the late Czar, and his family who were massacred by Bolsheviks in the basement of the Kaiserberg in 1918.

Bodkin as a child played with Anastasia and says that the latter escaped through the help of a young soldier whom she later married in Rumania, where a son was born. Bodkin believes the visitor's claim to be genuine, and says she will have to contact the wife but as he was broken by the rifle burst of a Bolshevik guard.

A mysterious arrival has been traced to the Bavarian home of the Duke of Leuchtenberg, the Bohemian, by the help of a Polish officer.

The interest in her claim is now intensified by the news that she is proceeding to New York, where she will be the guest of Mrs. Leeds, who is a member of the Imperial Family, being the daughter of the Grand Duchess Marie Georgievna, and who has evidently undertaken the task of trying to identify the invalid. The latter's memory is affected and she speaks imperfect German. She has an intimate knowledge of the Imperial Family and thus forms the link between a low day earlier.

The Grand Duchess Anastasia would now be aged 27.

A Berlin message states that the Grand Duke Andrew Vladimirovich acknowledges the claim of the mysterious arrival.

**WIRELESS ENTERTAINMENT
IN THE WILDS.**

Wonders of a Private Yacht.
AN 8 AFRICAN VISIT.

The motor yacht Crusader, owned by Mr. A. K. Macomber, of California, is being the wireless point of view, one of the most advanced of the wireless yachts abroad. Wireless programmes can be received in the yacht over long distances, and it is probable that in the future this wireless broadcasting there are few parts of the world where the Crusader will ever be without wireless entertainment. Nearly every room has its wireless loud speaker and, on contact with receiving wires from outside sources, Mr. Macomber has arranged to transmit his own wireless programme from the yacht to his camp whenever he is for instance.

For instance, he is shortly to take part in a big game hunting expedition on the East Coast of Africa, and while on shore the hunting party will carry a number of portable receivers which will enable them to pick up telephone conversations or music transmitted by the wireless telephone transmitter installed on the yacht which will be answered off the coast.

More Than Amusement.

Amusement is not the only use which Mr. Macomber makes of wireless. His yacht is also equipped with a complete and up-to-date wireless installation for the transmission and reception of commercial messages, news and weather reports, so that he may keep in touch with the outer world. A 14 W. Marconi valve transmitter was transmitter enables the yacht to keep in communication with commercial wireless stations over long distances, while the ship's wireless receivers are capable of receiving messages from all classes of wireless stations. The yacht is also fitted with a Marconi 1 MW telephone set which is very easily operated and supplies the crew with private telephone service between its headquarters on the yacht and any camp which may be established during the expedition.

**MAN IN LONDON SEEN
IN NEW YORK.**

Success of a Television Demonstration.
ELECTRIC EYE.

There was a further advance in the success of the demonstration when a man and a woman sat before an electric eye in a London laboratory, and a group of people in a darkened basement in New York watched a safe movement. The images were crude and broken, but a safe movement. The demonstration was made by Mr. John L. Baird using a short-wave wireless set for the transmission of "seeing on sound" and a television for turning the sound back into vision. The transformed scenes from London penetrated the air like the drive of a bee and a musical hum of irregular cadence repeated the sound of the lights and shadows of faces.

At The London. From London comes the following message: A pale picture of a face as though printed on a cloth hanging in the breeze was seen on the London side of the television experiment. The "pale image" was merely a dummy transmitted to enable the "lookers in" in New York to tune in with their receiving apparatus, and a few minutes later human heads were substituted in London. First, Mr. John L. Baird placed himself in a room flooded with light when he faced a small square window apparently covered by a thin curtain, which he pulled aside. He turned his head to the left and then to the right. Then he advanced and retreated in obedience to systematic directions ordered by a loud speaker.

Baird's representative was then similarly "transmitted" turning his eyes and that may be for half an hour for the benefit of favourable spectators more than three thousand miles away.

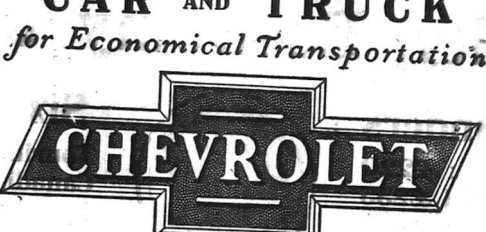

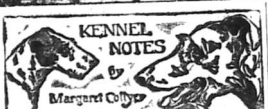

Here is something for the Alsatian enthusiasts to take up and try to do. I have also received the programme of the Annual General Meeting of the 12th held at Lakeside on December 30th. In the last session I have got of the Gazette notice that the farmers in Western Australia are sickening against the price of rather less in the States. I have written to Mr. Wilford Jenkins, who is Secretary of the Alsatian Dog Club, W. A. and from whom I can write you any truth in the world. 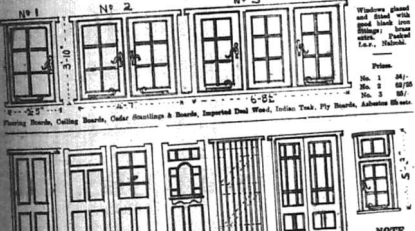

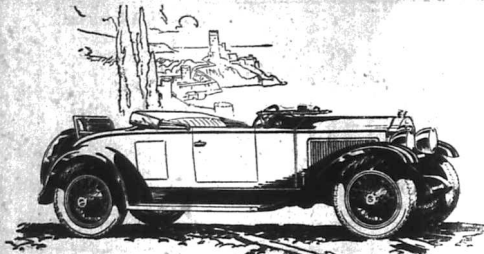

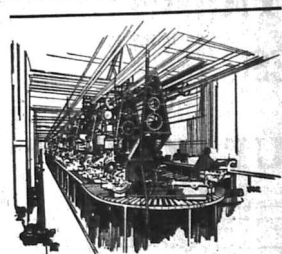

MOTURING TOPICS

THE CLAMP CAR.

Danger of Monocycle Gas Passing.

HOW TO PREVENT IT

Among the perils of a motorist is the danger of carbon monoxide gas passing into the passenger compartment, so that his presence cannot be detected by senses. It is highly poisonous and is fatal if inhaled, whereas in minute quantities, like all poisons, will slip its effects into the people in different ways, and these poisons are much more sensitive to the sense than others.

The most usual of these is in which a very small proportion of the gas is inhaled. It is a leading cause of many deaths, especially in infancy. There is not another prevention which some manufacturers have adopted on their latest models, though its efficacy in preventing carbon monoxide toads does not seem to have been generally noticed. The reason that exhaust gases enter a body is due to the fact that it is drawn or sucked into the engine.

Numbers of cars have ventilators of the motor type in their roof or at the side or top of the window. When the car is in motion, these draw the air out of the body, and the window and window are closed in a downward position. This is "sucking for trouble" from gas passing.

Exhaust Gases.
The most effective of all methods of preventing gas entering the body is to arrange that the pressure of the atmosphere inside is always slightly higher than that outside, so that the gas will not be sucked in. Under such conditions it is impossible for any trace of exhaust gas to enter the body. This is a very simple problem for a vehicle in motion, and is solved by providing the body with a ventilator or ventilators of the motor type—that is, to collect and force air into the body—placed in such a position that they will be sure of being supplied with fresh air.

The only special precaution needed on a closed against the flow of gas is along with the air, the condition of the ventilator is important. Preferably a ventilator of this type should be arranged so that it is impossible to close it completely. The air thus forced into the body will very readily find its way out through the many cracks and crevices around windows and doors, and also through any openings into the floorboards.

A small electrically-driven fan might well form part of the equipment of closed cars, used largely for office work, to maintain the supply of fresh air while the engine of the car is stationary, and thus the ventilator to function directly.

Balloon Tyres.
EFFECT OF WEAR ON THE TYERING

AN IMPROVED FARM WAGON.

Strength Retained But Novel Features Introduced.

UNION EXPERIMENTS

Improvements in wagons are of the most interesting to farmers in Kenya. For this reason there is published below the impressions of a correspondent of the South African Farmer's Weekly on the wagon with which experiments have recently been made in South Africa.

The correspondent writes:—The most modern of the Farm Wagons have from time to time witnessed efforts in this part with a mechanical frame of iron or possessing such had been acquired some of the best of the improved wagon in South Africa, to bring forward a really practical vehicle, designed simply for transport generally, but to obtain as much as possible the advantages of the more expensive old-style horse-drawn trucks that could be used by the farmer in the bush.

Two parallel wheel frames had been temporarily erected thirty feet apart, thus forming a narrow road when the new wagon with its 18,000 lb. load, was drawn. When about half way in the order to turn about was given. The bodies of the two wagons, one of them of twelve wheels were immediately swung towards the other side of the road and the front wheels, swinging almost completely round, ran on the opposite side of the road, permitting this, the wagon was turned within its own length. It was then turned the other way with the same ease and length. After this a similar manoeuvre was made, but on a four-inch level of sand. Then follow-

ed a run of the loaded wagon with one of its four wheels raised, which was accomplished with ease. A standard wheel pattern was laid on a level surface and it then made to take a full turn in the shorter wheel, and the other four a circle of 100 ft. This was done in twenty-three feet circle of the new wagon.

The 'New Advance' as the improved wagon is called, is a four-wheeled wagon, designed and adapted to South African conditions such as native dirt roads, the general shortage of turning space at railway stations and elsewhere, the necessity of doubling length of country roads. This wagon differs somewhat from the 'Old' or 'Cap' pattern, in several respects. The front springs embrace a novel idea. It consists of two solid metal flange tables, forming the bottom and the top turntable. The bottom one is fixed and supported directly on the axle-bar. Attached over it there are two narrow strips, a large and a small, called anti-rotation rings. The former forms an outer rim, the latter an inner circle, in the bottom turn table. The axle-bar, while working in the centre, is fixed to the top table in a groove across the front of the bottom table. The latter is fixed to the axle-bar in a groove across the front of the bottom table. The top or end table, receives that movement, but is unable to transmit any to the lower table.

One difficulty as King told the usual 'kib kib' holding the axle to the axle-bar in the older wagons is here replaced by a more elaborate method called a 'fixed epicycle.' It is a cone-shaped pin, the turned in its upper end, and is of the same strength as any of the main two most important. Being conical, it efficiently compensates for any irregularity of the surface of the ground. For instance, if the axle, on obstruction, or dips into a rut, as on a rut, the case on

form made, the cone-shaped epicycle is automatically applied, giving unnecessary movement of the road by rising up the side of three rollers. The rollers are fixed to the bottom turn table, thus avoiding the risk of the rollers and the axle struts that usually develop, and the rollers are fixed to the axle with springs. It must be pointed out that the rollers and axle struts would merely hold the turntable in position, and would not be of any use in rotation required. Without doubt, the fixed epicycle is an important part of the invention. As stated, has already shown by its performance in directing them to the vehicles in order to turn the springs, and enable them to turn within a shorter space. Further, the axle struts of all times knew the road tables in perfect rotation, and fixed the front of the wagon to pivot easily.

Undertrial Improvements. An archaic long-wagon, half timber and half wood, replaced the familiar straight beam of old. The front wheels, travel under with ease, and without obstruction. The drawbar is likewise of new design and construction, being simpler and easier to put on, and only the bolts need be removed or unremoved to fit or change. The fastenings, to which the drawbar was formerly attached, had been done away with, and two strong but simple pins, made somewhat in the shape of the letter X, have been added as a drawbar support. The following advantages were claimed at the meeting:—The wagon turns, with ease, in any direction, is of simple design, and is of simple construction, suitable for use in any country, built to standard size, which experience of farming in South Africa has proved most suitable for farm use, together with simple construction, which allows any member or component part to be removed by any skilled man for the purpose of repair, without damage to remaining parts (in the same manner as in a lorry).

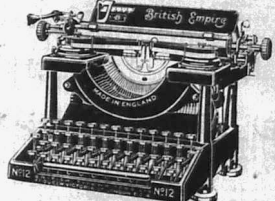
