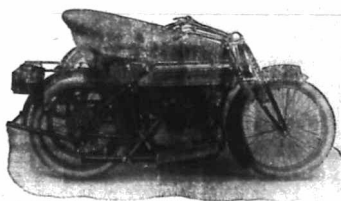

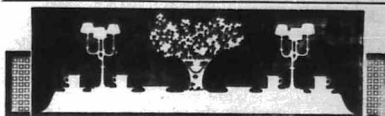

Protectorates' Trade. Chief of Customs Annual Report.

The Chief of Customs has issued his annual report on the working of his department for the year 1911-12. The gross amount of revenue derived from duties was £138,454 of which £13,514 was refunded on account of goods in transit, goods re-exported and other refunds.

CUSTOMS REVENUE.

The revenue from Customs import and export duties exceeded the amount estimated by £25,240 or 40%. It is almost impossible to say the exact amount of Customs revenue in a young country like East Africa...

VALUATION OF IMPORTS.

The total value of imports East Africa includes that of Uganda. The total value of goods for the year 1911-12, including the value of goods for the year 1910-11, is £1,300,348.

UGANDA'S EXPORTS.

Uganda's exports for the year 1911-12 are valued at £277,074 showing an increase of £5,251 or 1.9% on the previous year.

OTHER COUNTRIES.

German East Africa exported through Mombasa to the extent of £290,113 in December 1911 compared with £267,000 in the previous year.

No one of cholera having occurred in any part of the island of Zanzibar since Dec. 23, 1905, and quarantine restrictions on sailing from and to the island have been relaxed.

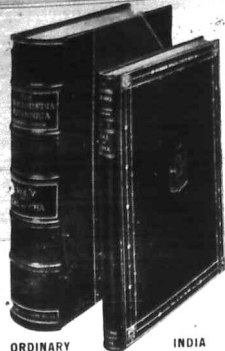

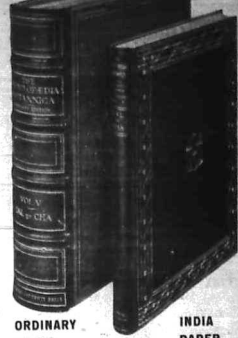

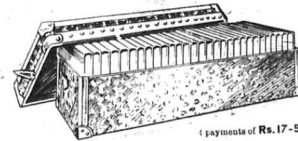

From various correspondents I have since had with people present at the meeting I gather that they were not only very strongly expressed, in that my proposals were supported by some to extend a territory the Eastern County of Tipping, throughout the Province, I therefore beg you to allow me to explain through your columns that my proposals were made.

My proposal to purchase money at 20% for the erection of dipping tanks was certainly not a philanthropic but a business one, in that it is obviously to the advantage of dip manufacturers to encourage the erection of tanks and to encourage the same extension use of dipping tanks. To make dipping of general value it must be so wide spread as to include all swine raised, and swine are well able to pay for their own dipping tanks there must be a considerable number who are not so generous to bear the considerable cost outlay involved, though they are of the advantage, especially from the use of dips. My proposals were made to assist people in this position, and I wish to be sure of Messrs. Wm. Cooper & Mayhew they incur no obligation of any sort to use Cooper's Dip in the tanks which I hope my advice will allow of construction throughout the Province.

In conclusion, may I express my opinion that the systematic extension of dipping tanks to the Province may result in a great increase in the production of swine with such wonderful pastoral capabilities. Yours, etc. W. F. COOPER.

NAKURU QUARANTINE MEETING.

To the Editor of the "E. A. Standard." Sir, Your meeting which has been mentioned in the above report in your papers of January 6 and 7, may like to know that the "New Method" of extending the dipping tanks was proved successful in Kenya, then in Queensland about 20 years ago, and it is being introduced in this country. Mr. Watkins (Bishop's) dip in Queensland with effect, both for cattle and horses, and was made as far as I am remember in the following proportion:--

- White Arsenic 5 lbs. Caustic Soda 4 lbs. Stockholm tar about 2 gallons. Yellow 10 lbs.

To every 400 gallons tank. The mixture was boiled before using. I must point out that there will be danger of arsenical poisoning if hatched swine crosses, as used at the present time in the Government Quarantine House, are not substituted, and proper crates substituted. I do not consider the proposal holds much promise of success unless backed by a strong law.
