This being the case there need be no fear of a Labour Government acquiescing in any policy which would endanger Imperial unity, and the self-governing Dominions, which means that however much sympathy we have with Egyptian Nationalism, for example, we are determined to support the passage of that bill in the House of Commons, until some powerful and tried international policy form provides more satisfactory results.

We believe that the policy successfully applied to the self-governing Dominions can and should be applied to India. We desire India to be a self-governing Dominion within the Empire by her own will just as Canada is today.

With regard to the Crown Colonies, including that present and future area of friction and difficulty, Kenya, we are quite content with the policy which the present Government has adopted.

considered opinion that the interests of the African natives must be paramount, and that if the interests of the African natives and the interests of the unorganised people are to be considered, it is not as if the Labour Party desires to foster and maintain Imperial unity only for the sake of the world peace.

RECORD TRADE YEAR IN RHODESIA.

Revenue and Expenditure Balanced.

GOVERNOR'S REVIEW.

The seventh annual of the Legislative Assembly of Southern Rhodesia opened recently by the Governor.

His Excellency, in his address to the Chamber, referred to the subject in the most fitting and balanced manner, while at the same time pointing out the progress of the country in the various spheres of its development.

At his opening all honours and praises, without distinction, applied to those the least of a single-minded, patient, and vigorous statesman.

The Governor stated that a resolution to mark the recognition of this great success by the colony and the universal peace which has been so far held in Southern Rhodesia would be laid before the House.

The figures of the trade of the Colony in the past year constituted another record, the value of imports and exports, approximately, being £13,000,000. A substantial increase compared with the figures of preceding years. Revenue receipts had shown a satisfactory expansion, and the estimate had again been exceeded. Indeed, the total deficit was anticipated, revenue and expenditure approximately balanced.

He hoped to lay before the House a Budget which would provide for the creation of a national public works.

Well-being of Natives.

He stated with pleasure the advance of the economic well-being of the natives, as shown by their ownership of 1,200,000 whitehead sheep, and 2,000,000 grade cattle, as well as by the numerous farms of cattle and grain. It was hoped during the present year to arrange for the establishment of two native reserves. During the past year a special department of native education had been established and a Bill would be presented dealing with the constitution. A new statistical department was also being inaugurated.

The Territorial Reserve were continued during the year. The response had given the greatest satisfaction. The colony owed a debt of gratitude to the older members who were assisting voluntarily to build up the State.

Three bridges had been completed in the Province. The Victoria and the Limpopo, and a fourth bridge, the Victoria, was under construction. Further work on the foundation of the Victoria and Limpopo bridges would be commenced during the year. The Victoria bridge would be opened in August 1928. In the Victoria, the transport of the Beit Railway Fund had been approved, during the current year, a further vote of £20,000 for the construction of road bridges.

The progress of the mining, however, both as regards the production of gold, and the value of the output, was disappointing.
