A TANGANYIKA EXHIBITION.

Scheme for Big Event
Next Year.

DRAFT PROGRAMME.

Agriculture, Sports and Art.

It is proposed to hold an Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition at Tanganyika towards the end of next year and to this end a representative committee has been formed with the Director of Agriculture and the Commissioner of Customs as Chairman and Hon. Secretary respectively.

The Committee have received an assurance that the Government is friendly disposed towards the project, but any financial assistance from the Government will clearly depend on the degree of financial support that the community as a whole. The manner in which the scheme is received in the Legislative Council will also largely depend on the enthusiasm and response which the scheme evokes in the Territory. The Committee therefore confidently appeal to all sections of the community for donations towards the preliminary expenses. Charges should be made payable to Tanganyika Exhibition Fund and sent direct to the Standard Bank of South Africa, Ltd. Dar-es-Salaam. Expenses will be kept to a minimum and most of the funds devoted to prizes. All subscriptions will be acknowledged in the press.

Financial Support.

It is confidently anticipated that financial and other support will be forthcoming in the course of next year. Those who are interested in the Territory, and it is also hoped that the Empire Marketing Board will be able to render some assistance in giving the project publicity in Great Britain and Ireland.

It is proposed to hold the Exhibition in the Autumn of 1929. After careful consideration the Committee have decided that a site must be selected for the enterprise in Dar-es-Salaam, an important reason for this being that

in no other place in the Territory could accommodation be arranged for the many visitors it is confidently hoped to attract. Special facilities for exhibitors and passengers have been planned.

It is hoped to be able to arrange competitive classes with awards, in the following:—
(1) Agriculture—(a) Cereals, Tobacco, Tea, Copra, Kapoa, Coffee, Vegetables and Fruits. (2) Factories for all products grown by natives and settlers; (3) The Territory—(All live stock and dairy produce, including poultry); (4) Mining and Geological—(Minerals, Gold, Diamonds, Coal, Copper, Tin, Salt etc.); (5) Forestry—(All classes of timber and wood products); (6) Native Industries—(a) Home Products; (7) Non-Native Arts and Crafts; (8) Children's work; (9) Local Manufactures; (10) Collective District Exhibitors; (11) Machinery—(Industrial, Agricultural, including Tractors, demonstrations, and Motors); (12) Transport and Travelling; (13) Commercial Exhibitors; (14) Game and Trophies; (15) Horticulture; (16) Natural History Section.

At the same time as the Exhibition is being held it is hoped to hold a Gymkhana, a general Sports Week, including an array of chess-playing as possible and also an aviation display. The Committee feel that the benefits to the Territory of a successful function of this nature will be readily appreciated by the residents and they therefore appeal for support with confidence, both to private individuals and to Planning and Commercial Associations in the country.

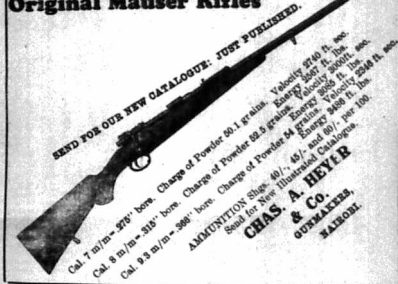
Communications.

Four water-boring machines and accessories had just arrived, and had normally been finished on September 1928. There was great difficulty in obtaining experienced and reliable workmen. It was only with the generous help of the Director and Engineer of the Office of South Africa that three were secured and reported for duty on August 7th. Three of the machines were delivered on November 14th, when an assistant foreman was appointed and given charge of the machine.
