IMPORTANT WORK OF AMANI INSTITUTE.

Research into Plant Diseases.

DEMONSTRATION

In the territorial station of the East African Show the East African Agricultural Research Institute, Amani, staged a small exhibition demonstrating certain research methods in the investigation of plant diseases. This exhibition was held in the grounds of the Institute. The general effect upon the plants affected is a reduction in their capacity to grow and to produce. In a general description of plant diseases, it is noted that the plants do not die but they do not produce. Some of the signs usually associated with diseases, the fungus or the bacteria, are not visible to the eye. Only in certain cases have these diseases received considerable study and the results have been recognized as probably an argument of minute size which would be seen with a microscope-called a virus.

The exhibit shows these important diseases. Bacterial diseases affect maize with particular severity as "little stalks" and "shearers" yield, straggling in the leaves, and "streaking" in the plants. It is transferred from plant to plant by a small insect, a hopper which is called "Zanzibar" which is a pest of the maize. The exhibit shows the results of the virus and the effects of the virus on the plants. The virus is a very serious trouble of this crop and may reduce yield to nothing. Finally plants of Cassava are shown, one healthy, and one affected.

MEMBER'S ADDRESS.

FROM A CORRESPONDENT.

A public meeting was held at Makuyu (Nyas) on 27th ult. which was addressed by Lord Francis Scott, Member for the Umtali Province. Lord Francis Scott has been spending considerable time in the case of Mr. Paul Clarke and said that he was satisfied that the Government had the early days. Research Work.

The activities of the Amani station should be stressed, in so far as it is concerned, in the investigation of the kind of research which will be undertaken at this research station. It is noted that the virus disease will be directed to the investigation of the real nature of the virus and the manner of action in the plants. It is possible that new discoveries in this division may open a way to entirely new methods of controlling the disease on the farm.

It is noted that the experiments conducted at this station might appear to have little bearing upon the practice of agriculture, yet the virus methods as those that are important in agriculture. It is to provide facilities for such "long range" research that Amani has been set up.

In the present state of our knowledge the control of virus diseases in which the farmer is primarily concerned rests upon the protection of his plants from the planting of healthy material. The removal of all diseased plants which appear in the crop, and the destruction of all "cuttings" planted which may appear out of season. The last is very important, for many diseases are carried over from crop to crop in the soil by means of cuttings. It is important to see that a good deal of healthy crop in a second year, which is a severe outbreak of a virus disease.

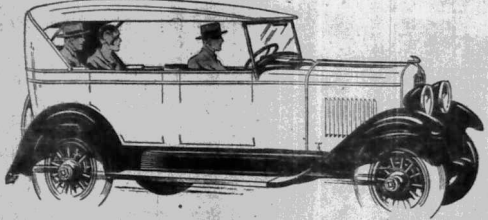

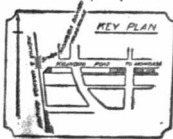

MR. SASTRI ASKS FOR FAIR TREATMENT.

Attitude of European Trade Unionists.

PRESENT BARRIERS.

The attitude of the European colonies and Indian workers in South Africa on the question of wages in the common sense, should stand the subject of some striking re- sponse by Mr. Sastri at a public meeting at Johannesburg on the 10th inst. on the condition of Trade Unionism in India. Mr. Sastri pointed out that if the Indian labourer in Johannesburg is so far as he is concerned in competition with the European, was regarded as a dangerous competitor, largely because he obtained a living wage, was very low.

It was Mr. Sastri's contention that the Indian labourer could stand a lower wage, and had a lower standard of life, and might be induced to compete freely, because a European. Some Indian workers in the solution to this problem lay in trying to induce the European standard as much as possible. The European's best strength could be served in making the Indian work under suitable conditions, so that their competition might be to his advantage as possible. It was the Indian's obligation to be true to his own race.

Unemployment Fear

The Indians felt that there were many at home, and that they would stand a worse rate of living. Nevertheless, they were not to be deterred by the initial difficulties. They believed that they would, in the long run, be able to stand the competition. It was possible for Indian labourers to benefit by these laws without harming the Europeans.

The Congress had definitely set its face against any sort of oppression to them, and the Indians were confident within their sphere.

"When the Wage Board met its meeting on Durban the other day, one would care to believe that they would only be willing to abide by the decision of the Wage Board and of the Minister, provided that they are not made specially with a view to improving the Indian condition. It is quite aware that the Wage Board and the Industrial Commission Act is for the benefit of the European worker, not the Indian worker. The

and wishes of the Indian are not taken into consideration to the same extent. Well, we are quite prepared for that state of affairs for a time.

Plan for Fairness.

It will not be fair, for instance, for you only to benefit by these laws, without allowing the Indian the opportunities which you yourself enjoy to be transferred to your side. The Indian is not a person who is not fitted to earn a high wage. He does not receive the benefit of your trade union. He does not enjoy any of the benefits which you enjoy. Now, how do you expect him to have your standard rate of wages?

By all the rules of fair play, and open competition, the Trade Union to fair competition. You have to give the Indian the same facilities and opportunities which you yourself enjoy. At the same time, you must, unfortunately, only a few of you take this liberal, and humane view, a view which prevails in labour organizations in every part of the world.

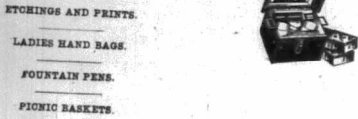



The Tool Kit. Points Worth Considering.

The tool kits supplied by motor
cyclist manufacturers differ very
slightly, and it is to be regretted
that not few makers have stan-
dardized one which can be really
called adequate. How every kit
contains a fixed spanner to fit every
nut on the machine, and what
percentage of makers include that
most necessary, most worn, most
convenient "socket".

Yet the tools are quite as im-
portant as any other accessory, in-
stead more so than any, and it
behoves riders to insure to some
degree that their kit should be
of the best order. In the
first place, it will probably be
desirable to insure a really first
class screwdriver. If a large
one is already included, a medium
sized "socket" will prove still
well worth the purchase price.

The screw-driver supplied in the
kit will almost certainly prove
inadequate the point often being
1 1/8 in. thick—so that it is desirable
to be entered into any screw kit.
A hand-saw—medium sized—
example should be bought, with a
eliminate screwdriver is an oc-

(4) The Seasonal Variations and Progressive Values.

By comparing the first quarter of 1927 with the corresponding period of 1928, the seasonal variations in commerce and it will be noted that—

2. Cash in hand was 30 per cent less, but apparently to meet having been increased 1 1/2 times for financing the export increase in the cotton crop.

Tanganyika.

1. Imports were 4.4 per cent lower in 1928 than in 1927.
2. Cash in hand was 30 per cent less.
3. The daily bank turnover was 15 per cent higher in 1928 than in 1927, while the percentage ratio between the turnover and deposits was 1.0 per cent in 1927 and 1.07 per cent in 1928.
4. Bills discounted were 24 per cent higher in 1928 than in 1927.
5. Loans and advances outstanding to agriculture were 44 per cent higher in 1928 than in 1927, while those outstanding to commerce were only 4.8 per cent higher.

8. All three territories evidence a marked increase in bank turnover, Kenya 7 per cent, Uganda 10 per cent and Tanganyika 10 per cent. Loans and advances to commerce have also increased, in Kenya 34 per cent, Uganda 37 per cent and Tanganyika 7 per cent. These increases have not been accompanied by 10 per cent in Kenya, 21 per cent in Uganda and increased by 44 per cent in Tanganyika.

9. The most interesting seasonal variations are those shown in bank turnover, in bills discounted, and in loans and advances to commerce.

10. Kenya's bank daily turnover is at a minimum in the first quarter, at an approximate million seven in the other three quarters.

11. Uganda stands at a maximum in the first quarter and falls steadily throughout the year. It is nearly dependent on the single industry which characterizes the Uganda trade conditions. In Tanganyika the minimum occurs at the second quarter and shows a steady increase throughout the year afterwards. Seasonal variations in the Territory appear to be marked at present by the—

(c) Balance of Remittances in and out of Colonies.
In Table 5 will be found the balance of remittances into and out of the three territories during 1927. A minus sign indicates that the balance is outwards from the Colony or countries indicated in the first column.
Some of the most noteworthy points are—
1. All territories recorded avastance, principally to London.
2. Uganda and Tanganyika recorded outwards remittances, while Kenya recorded an inwards remittance.
3. Kenya and Tanganyika recorded a surplus of remittances in the first column.

By Kenya being favoured when the same seasonal variation as the Bank turnover appears at a maximum in the second and fourth quarters and at a minimum in the first and third quarters.
The same season applies to those and advances to Commerce show a steady increase in Kenya throughout the year. In Uganda there fell to a very low point in the 3rd quarter and rose rapidly in the first quarter of 1928.
(5) Nature of the Trade in the Three Colonies.
The differences in the intensity of trade conditions in the three territories are of exceptional interest. They will become of still greater interest when wanted over a longer period.
The index numbers on Kenya as a base are shown in Table 4. For every 1000, transacted in Kenya from 2000 to 2005 is transacted in Uganda 2600 from 2500 to 2600 in Tanganyika.

Flour Prices Reduced

The wholesale prices of all our different grades of wheat flour and atta have been materially reduced as from October 1st, and no doubt bakers and stockpilers will make corresponding reductions to the public when their existing stocks have been cleared.

Since the early part of 1926 the wholesale price of our superfine white flour has been reduced by nearly 30%.

The latest reductions have been made possible by co-operation between the wheat growers, who have agreed to a reduction in the price of wheat, and the two leading millers (Unga Limited of Njoro, and the Kenya Grain Mills Ltd., of Nairobi). These millers have reduced their prices to figures which will be absolutely unprofitable, even with the reduced price of wheat, unless their combined sales are increased by 3,000 bags of flour per month. They have made the reductions in the belief that such an increase is possible.

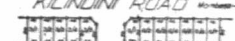
