### WHY DRESS CLOTHES ARE BLACK.

Curious Facts About the Origins of Fashions.

#### A BOOK'S INFLUENCE.

Many and various are the causes which have brought certain fashions into vogue. Battles, sieges, novelties, and even wars have been mentioned as being about a style of dress which dominated its time, and then ceased to be fashions, only to reappear in a few years, or even sooner in times and places far removed from the original source. In the beginning of the 17th century, when the Spaniards were besieging the city of Madrid, the daughter of Philip III, of Spain, made a vow not to change her dress until Madrid was captured. Unhappily, the siege, instead of lasting three weeks or three months, only lasted three years, a prolongation which did not cause the lady's rage. Yet her reputation for veridicality stood so high that it was because the ladies adopted as the fashion their staid and heavily trailing robes which had been favored after the Princess, 'l'habito.

#### Cravats and Spencers.

Even a battle has been the cause of setting fashions. At the battle of Stenak, fought on the morning of August 1, 1802, the French soldiers were surprised by their enemy, and, having realized their mistake in the morning, they were obliged to wear the French cravat, and to wear a cravat which was a compromise between the cravat which they had worn in the morning and the cravat which they had worn in the evening. It was called a "cravat à la française."

Few articles of dress were more popular at one time than the short frock known as the "spencer." The origin of which was a military uniform. During the reign of George III, the Spaniards, who were rather particular in their dress, were recruited in a company of 1000 men, and it was decided that they should be dressed in a uniform which was different from that of the British. ## SANITARY PROGRESS IN THE RESERVE.

First Appointment of Inspector.  
SIMPLE TRAINING

In remarks on the general administrative arrangements of the Kenya Reserve, attention is drawn to the training of sanitary inspectors and staff and to the equipment of a sanitary inspector to a native reserve.

Following a large increase in staff allowed for in 1926, only 100 sanitary inspectors were provided for in 1927. Two additional medical officers were provided for, one a fully qualified officer and the second a veterinary officer and the second veterinary officer was also provided for. The appointment of a medical officer for the Kenya Reserve has for long been desirable. The first step in progress and the provision of a sanitary inspector to a native reserve, though effected by disease, is now showing considerable possibilities of improvement. The loss of a house made a posting possible during the year. The selection of a site suitable for a hospital for the district was not completed in the period under review.

An officer was posted as medical officer of health to Nairobi. This allowed further progress to be made in the bettering of slum insanitary conditions of the city under sanitary administration. The training of the Reserve staff and the appointment of the Medical Officer of Health, Nairobi. The total area is far too large for one officer and it is satisfactory to note

that provision was made in the 1926 Estimate for a separate medical officer of health for the Kiambu and Emburu Districts.

An innovation. The first posting of a sanitary inspector to a native reserve was effected during the year. In the Fort Hill Reserve a certain number of houses are being taken by the natives in the question of provision on a letter type of house. It appears desirable to make and discuss the movement by advising both the natives and the administration the advice that can be given by an officer with special knowledge of the Reserve. The sanitary conditions of the village were improved but the chief work is still to be done. The training of natives in the villages of sanitary house building is so far as can be seen with our present knowledge, was practised by the Government. The lines on which sanitary progress can be attained were indicated and illustrated and was arranged for on the basis of the best for the benefit of the people. The scheme allows for the establishment to be effected by either Government or non-Government agency. An indication of success required and the total cost was afforded. Indication of success or otherwise has not been received at the end of the year.

Native Subordinate Staff. University as to the future site of the Native Hospital, Nairobi, presented the question of buildings required to house and teach boys under training. Towards the end of the year permission was obtained to proceed with the building of a temporary institute. It is hoped that progress can be received during 1928 in this important line.

The scheme for training as originally presented has been considered considerably. Instead of a properly maintained corps it is proposed as a beginning to proceed by a system of apprenticeship as adopted in the workshop of the Kenya and Uganda Railways. As this machine is comparatively small number of boys will be training.

The training of female dressmakers at Mombasa has been continued and the results obtained to be satisfactory.

At the Laboratory organ and sanitation has been continued for natives for some time past. A number of native medical students performing the routine staining and preliminary examination slides is being provided. The training of dressmakers is being continued. Two trained nurses have now important duties in

connection with branch dispensaries in Nairobi. The important new activity in the training of native sanitary assistants at Fort Hill has already been mentioned. Instruction is being given in the manufacture of the following—empty cans; a simple window, a pit latrine, a rock-cord grip, a wire clothes table, and a chair.

Overing in the local development which continues to take place through the year. # Flour Prices Reduced

The wholesale prices of all our different grades of wheat flour and atta have been materially reduced as from October 1st, and no doubt bakers and storekeepers will make corresponding reductions to the public when their existing stocks have been cleared.

Since the early part of 1926 the wholesale price of our superfine white flour has been reduced by nearly 30%.

The latest reductions have been made possible by co-operation between the wheat growers, who have agreed to a reduction in the price of wheat, and the two leading millers (Unga Limited of Njoro, and the Kenya Grain Mills Ltd. of Nairobi). These millers have reduced their prices to figures which will be absolutely unprofitable, even with the reduced price of wheat, unless their combined sales are increased by 3,000 bags of four per month. They have made the reductions in the belief that such an increase is possible.
