WHAT HAS BEEN DONE.

Mr. Moore's Views on the Needs of the Main Traffic Routes.

The coming of the rains periodically acrosses the interest of the Colony in the condition of the roads. Some East African Recipes.

No. 2: The Pumpkin.

BY A KENYA HOUSEWIFE.

Take varieties of growth such as the vegetable market will find difficult to grow in parts of Kenya. But the best of the market will grow in these regions. The fruit should be a golden variety.

In cooking a new variety, for the first time, one must be taken not to add fat, except water. Heat, which is water, while others cook up dry. For the following recipes prevent the pumpkin thus:

Wipe, peel and remove seeds. Cut into half inches and place in a saucepan to boil with a cup or two of water. Stir frequently and if water is quickly absorbed, add a little more. When thick and tender, remove from heat and put through a sieve.

TO SERVE AS A VEGETABLE.
 Steam well and add 1 tablespoonful of butter or 2 tablespoonful of milk cream.

FRIED PUMPKIN.
 1 cup of pumpkin. 4 cup of milk.
 1 tablespoonful of brown sugar.
 2 eggs.
 A pinch each of salt and pepper.

Mix well. Heat 2 tablespoonful of fat in a frying pan. Sprinkle the mixture evenly on the pan and fry over a low fire until a crust has formed on the bottom. Fold the contents and serve.

PUMPKIN SOUFFLE.
 1 cup pumpkin.
 1 cup fine bread crumbs.
 1 cup milk.
 1 tablespoonful of butter.
 2 eggs.
 Salt and pepper.

Beat the eggs and which which in a soft froth. Mix other ingredients and beat well. Lightly fold in the whisked whites and serve.

Take 30 minutes in a moderate oven.

PUMPKIN PIE.
 Be sure to try this. It is delicious.

- 2 cups of pumpkin.
- 2 eggs of milk.
- 1 tablespoonful ground cinnamon.

Mix well. Make a good rich pastry and line a pie dish. Decorate edges with a fork and fill with pumpkin mixture. Bake until tender, about 15 minutes.

- 1 tablespoonful ground cinnamon.
- 1 teaspoonful salt.

Beat well. Rub into flour and add the other ingredients—beating well. Bake in custard tins. It is best to stand these in a pan of hot water while baking.

- PUMPKIN PUDDING.**
- 1 cup of pumpkin.
- 1 cup of brown sugar.
- 1 cup of milk.
- 2 eggs.
- 1 teaspoonful salt.
- 1 teaspoonful ground nutmeg.
- 1 tablespoonful ground ginger.
- 1 teaspoonful ground cinnamon.

Separate the eggs and add yolks to other ingredients. Beat until firm. Beat whites to a stiff froth and add 2 tablespoonful of sugar spread on top of pudding and return to oven a few minutes to brown.

Tips for Motorists.

The rate of progress in motorist knowledge shows no signs of abating, and there is every indication that the year 1929 will represent a great advance upon those of the previous years. Practical knowledge of construction comes as far as ever, and it is important to remember that a corresponding improvement in motorist methods is going on all the time, with the result that the price does not show signs of increasing, although the falling of the cost four years seems to have been checked.

Consequently, the industry of today has an absolutely unparalleled selection of new from which to choose, irrespective of what year's stock has been selling a few years ago.

The 1929 motorist, on an all-round advance in detail design, there are a few outstanding features of construction, the progress of which demands special attention. Flour Prices Reduced

The wholesale prices of all our different grades of wheat flour and atta have been materially reduced as from October 1st, and no doubt bakers and storekeepers will make corresponding reductions to the public while their existing stocks have been cleared.

Since the early part of 1928 the wholesale price of our superfine white flour has been reduced by nearly 30%.

The latest reductions have been made possible by co-operation between the wheat growers, who have agreed to a reduction in the price of wheat, and the two leading millers (Unga Limited of Njoro, and the Kenya Grain Mills, Ltd. of Nairobi). These millers have reduced their prices to figures which will be absolutely unprofitable, even with the reduced price of wheat, unless their combined sales are increased by 2,000 bags of four per month. They have made the reductions in the belief that such an increase is possible.

He made a contact with the settlers which will be one of the pleasantest of his varied Kenya memories.

On leaving Uganda, H.R.H. made an opportunity at Jinja of saying a few words to the Kikabais, and his chiefs and to Uganda officials.

A GIFT OF HIPPO TROPHY.

Kilish, Uganda. The Prince of Wales arrived at Jinja on Saturday morning.

His Royal Highness was met at the station by Colonel Kinnaird, Assistant Member of the Legislative Council for the district, Mr. D. E. Thompson, the Assistant Commissioner, members of the Executive Council, and all about half a dozen people.

There were no addresses presented and no speeches; nevertheless the greeting was very cordial.

The local party left the station immediately, drove through the thicket and through the forest to a small township on its way to the source of the Nile.

On the Prince's departure from the station, a large number of the Kikabais accompanied him along the road to the Kikabais' camp.

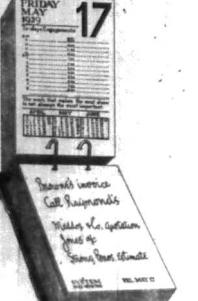

One of the most talked-about developments in highway automobile is the open-air motor, of which many interesting types will be shown at Olympia. One of the simplest and lightest types is that in which a sliding seat is employed the forward section running on rails so that it can easily be slid back over the fixed rear part.

Another interesting type which gives a slightly higher springing consists in fitting the roof of a car with a hood portion consisting of a flexible top carried by a way of remounting of the hood. This one often has been built up on the fixed rear quarter. Thus there are many ingenious designs employing the so-called "flexible" which others enable a simple folding top to be pushed away at the back of the car through an ingenious mechanical contrivance—no matter by the simple opening of a spring handle.

In the permanently closed motor the matter of ventilation has been carefully considered in most instances, ventilation being commonly fitted above the seat which has become a standard feature in the new cars. Some of them from the top with the windproof "zipper" usually mounted at the rear, permits for the extra heat, and independent front seats on sliding fittings. Many cars have discarded the window, employing instead the motor, extending across the sides of the body enclosed down-wards outside the frame to within one inch or so of the running board.

Interior furnishings, upholstery and equipment are more generous and artistic than ever, and the balance in fact tends to be in favour of the driver, with its direct lighting.

Brake Linings.

DEFAULT WHICH CAN LEAD TO TROUBLE

Brake failures, of all the mechanical arrangements which plague the motorist, are, in the most distressing, and the one above all others which calls urgently for immediate attention.

It might be remembered that any motorist is liable to find that the motor is in a jangle with the safety of the driver, the passenger, and other road users.

The trouble may be in the brake rod or cable. Usually the brake rod is not properly adjusted, and a slight adjustment of the latter will put the matter in the right. However, this is only a temporary expedient, and a detailed account of the method of adjusting it will be well to check upon other items which bring about brake failure. For instance, an inspection is advisable of the interior of the brake shoes, or the linings in the case of the external contracting type. It frequently happens that some iron or grit are embedded in the lining, and will cause a noisy, spongy, or loose. It may be removed. A brush dipped in petrol will be of use in the operation.

Extrior Rivets.
Take this opportunity also to examine the corner rivets which may be found in the linings. It is to be noted that they provide a means of fastening the linings to the metal shoe, and they must be levelled down to prevent wear from scratching the drums.

In the case of an expanding brake worked by a cam, steps should be taken to ascertain that it is not working to the maximum scope of movement. If it does it will be necessary to relax the brake shoes.

Dealing with relining operation, naturally the first thing to be done is to remove the old lining by cutting the end of the securing rivets and then punching them out. Care must be taken that the securing rivets of the holes is maintained. All dirt and rust on the exposed surface of the metal shoe or band must be removed.

New Lining.

The new piece of lining cut to the same length as that which it is to replace, is temporarily held in position on the shoe or band by the rivets, and then, punching them out. It will be necessary to remove the lining for contacting the surface to take the exact shape, it should be marked to enable it to be fitted in the proper position.

The contractor must be deep enough to allow the rivets which will be sunk half through the depth of lining.

When the contracting operation is completed the lining is prepared and riveted. The subject rivets should be of sufficient length to allow of their being easily loosened, so that they can be replaced in the case of the shoe or band.
