No word here we know in the world who let their sight in the fighting zone, except on the normal and happy lives of useful citizens in it with the deeper sense of shock that we read of war-blinded men who had no sense of purpose and led blind lives in the world.

The Instrument Board.

Provided for Definite Purpose.

The oil gauge may be just a black button that indicates when the oil is circulating, perhaps in an ordinary case, in which the motorist registers the oil pressure.

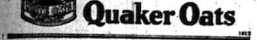

ROMANCE AND BEAUTY OF ZANZIBAR.

(Continued from page 5.)

Sixty years ago Zanzibar was the centre of the Arab slave trade. That is what Zanzibar is today, the campaign against the Arab slave trade and the essential steps taken towards its final and complete extinction. To a student of modern history, therefore, the new novel introducing him to the island arc, or rather to be, the Sultan of Zanzibar and the Sultan of Zanzibar.

At Mtwara, four miles south of the city's small white stands on a sandy looking over a bay—an old Arab house, square, solid, built round 500 years ago by a great Sultan made his home there whenever he could escape from his work in Zanzibar. In the garden are still growing many of the rare flowers and shrubs of East Africa which were discovered by him and bear his name—some of them are, it is said, that you can no longer be identified.

The keen botanist was also a doctor—a fellow-attendant, as it happened, with Joseph (later of Edinburgh) and his life-work might well have been achieved in natural science or in medicine; but for the chance which befell him as Livingston's lieutenant on the Zambesi Expedition of 1848-53. These years determined John Kirk's career. He had heard of the East Africa, which few other hear it ran ever again. Obeying it, he accepted in 1848 an official appointment at Zanzibar, and there for 20 years he laboured for the cause which Livingston had preached—the liberation of mid-Africa by British enterprise. The first developments of British "commerce and civilization" in East Africa owed at least as much to Kirk as to any other man of his day. But his greatest work was the part he played in the abolition of the slave trade.

Rhodesian Tobacco.

A 100,000 ADVERTISING PLAN.

In a speech at Harare Mr. J. W. Downie, Southern Rhodesia Minister of Mines and Works, referred to the tobacco advertising campaign, which he had recommended to the Government, stating that 100,000 should be spent over a period of three years for that purpose.

M. Downie said that recently samples of American cigarette leaf and of Rhodesian leaf had been analysed, the analysis showing that the Rhodesian leaf proved too costly. In order to overcome these disadvantages it was proposed to carry out experiments with various fertilizers and soils at the Salisbury Tobacco Experimental Station, in the coming season. The chief chemist and the tobacco adviser were going to Nymanstad to discuss with the Imperial Tobacco Company any means which might overcome this disability. He concluded by warning his hearers not to go away with the impression that they should plant a large quantity of tobacco this year. The adviser was that they should hold their hand and try to establish equilibrium between supply and demand.

A Contrast.

FIGURES FOR TANZANIA, KENYA AND UGANDA.

The following figures compiled from statistics supplied by the Commissioner of Customs, show the movement of goods into and out of the three territories during the period January to the end of the month in 1927 and 1928.

Tea 1927, 1,611,200 cwt. from Kenya and 1928, 700,713 cwt. from Kenya.

Sheep and Cattle 1927, 12,077 tons; 1928, 10,745 tons; both from Kenya.

Coffee 121,472 cwt. from Kenya in 1927 and 192,807 cwt. in 1928; 2,149 cwt. from Tanganyika in 1927 and 20,940 cwt. in 1928.

Trade imports in 1928 totalled £2,558,203 compared with £2,372,209 in 1927. In both years 37 per cent came from Great Britain, the figures being 1928, £949,211; and 1927, £871,043. In 1928 12 per cent (£319,241) came from India and in 1927, 15 per cent (£349,481). Exports from Germany increased from 11 per cent or £290,013 in 1927 to 12 per cent or £300,000 in 1928. In 1927 imports from Holland were £282,461 or nine per cent and in 1928, ten per cent or £332,220. Japan was responsible for £184,053 or six per cent in 1927, and £184,160 or seven per cent in 1928.

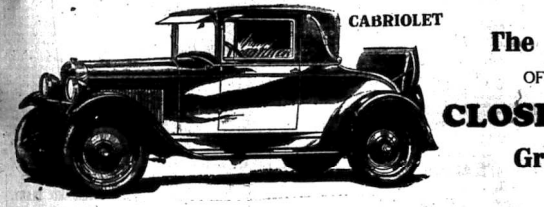

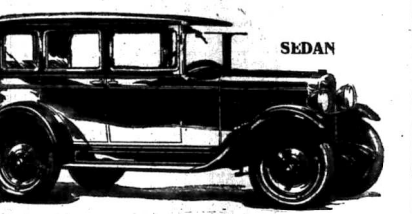

Pappy Day Funds.

We are glad to publish this notice of an explanatory letter from the Acting President of the East African Women's League in reply to an interesting query raised in our columns a few days ago. It is an old tradition in Kenya in connection with the relationship between Pappy Day Funds and their respective branches in the Colony. That there are a number of cases in this country in which the Service men and their families find it exceedingly difficult to struggle along from day to day without assistance, is regrettable the case. That the Colony should award to the large sum of £2,000 a year, to be used for the relief of war widows is a credit to the generosity of the Government and an indication of the fact that the community have not forgotten their obligations. That it would be a less creditable an act, at the time of making that contribution, numerous cases were allowed to exist at our own doors. We believe that the letter from the Acting President of the E.A.W.L. will ensure a more understanding which has prevailed for some years. It is not clear that the explanation that the society accords that reputation to their property families who are suffering from the hardships of circumstances in Kenya, can be supplied from the very large sum of money collected in Kenya

through the channel of the Central Fund. At the present moment, the work of investigating and recommending such cases for assistance is being undertaken by the East African Women's League which is admirably organized well over the country for public work. There is also an extensive force, another body, the League of Mercy, which was created for the express purpose of providing help in instances of distress and it would be interesting to know how far the work of the League of Mercy could be lightened and their limited finances made to go further, in all cases of suffering in which the victims have a war connection. Those applications were detached from the League's general list of cases requiring the attention and recommended to the British Fund for help. The advertisement that those who support Pappy Day would feel that their contributions would be likely to return to the Colony in the form of direct help to Kenya people whose war service has entitled them to special consideration than those of the League of Mercy would be better for other war service, alternative, and one that should be investigated, would be a request for an annual grant from the Central Fund (in proportion to the Colony's annual contribution) to such a body as the League of Mercy for the express purpose of assisting war service men and their families during periods of hardship and distress so that the work could be done in the Colony. It would be possible to be properly understood if the E.A.W.L. would provide for public subscription the number of names of war service men recommended under the Central Fund and the information of financial assistance given. It would be interesting to know how the League of Mercy stand how many similar cases with war service claim it is helping and what result. There should be a regular system of the present system and a grant-aid system certainly the easiest and quickest way.

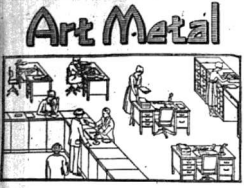

Flour Prices Reduced

The wholesale prices of all our different grades of wheat flour and atta have been materially reduced since from October last, and no doubt bakers and storekeepers will make corresponding reductions to the public when their existing stocks have been cleared.

Since the early part of 1920 the wholesale price of our superfine white flour has been reduced by nearly 30%.

The latest reductions have been made by co-operation between the wheat growers, who have agreed to a reduction in the price of wheat, and the two leading millers (Unga Limited of Njoro, and the Kenya Grain Mills Ltd., of Nairobi). These millers have reduced their prices to figures which will be absolutely unprofitable, even with the reduced price of wheat, unless their combined sales are increased by 3,000 bags of flour per month. They have made the reductions in the belief that such an increase is possible.

Minerals for Farm Stock.

(By Major P. F. Wood of the Goldfish Shorthorn Herd, Merestary, Natal.)

I have just arrived in Kenya and I would think that your ladies season is in a somewhat advanced stage. It is due to the climate, or the prevailing wind, that I am interested to know. KENYA "STIFFS"
To the Editor, "E.A. Standard."—Sir: Although I am only an amateur rider to the Colony my business takes me over the whole of South, Central and East Africa, and I think I can claim to have had knowledge of the problems facing the horse in Kenya in these regions. Kenya, however, to the outside is more or less a puzzle, and the information one gets is contradictory with different people here only intensify the problem. These men are the footmen of the great agricultural wealth of Europe and New Zealand, and it seems to me that what is really wanted here is more men and women to do the work. Many years with a sound export trade from East Africa have proved to me that real progress can be achieved here only by the best material with its greatest skill.

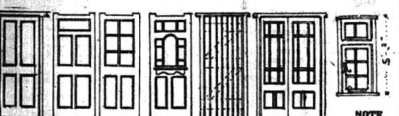

London, Oct. 31.

Among the East Africans over in this country are Major-General Bragg, who is staying at Herby, George F. Miller of Tika, who is staying at the Victoria Hotel, Mr. A. P. Dodds, Mr. J. H. Fisher of Kampi Ya Miti, who are staying at Tower House, Freshfield, Lanes, and Mr. T. J. Oswald of Nakuru, who is staying at The Towers at W 4. A. Khamis of London is staying at 20, St. Paul's Road, London. Mr. V. Johnson, Member of the Executive of the Chamber of Commerce of Uganda, is making his headquarters at the Royal Lancaster Club, Mr. H. G. Cook is staying at Twickenham, and Mr. Charles H. Dighton of Nyabingi is making his headquarters at 10, St. James's, Andrew Chalmers and the Misses.

The newspapers are still full of the "Prison" songs but now they have more especially turned their attention to the sporting side of the subject party of the Duke of Gloucester. Every old picture of any animal connected with East Africa is doing service and it is only a question of time before we have not one of the Nandi Bear left in its appropriate habitat, but only in a few newspaper papers that we still see the Nandi, the Grevy's Gazelle and the Grevy's Zebu. For the time being the writers have been busy with their own affairs, but the fact is that the Nandi is almost extinct.

The head office of Herby's Bank (Brisbane, Colonial and Overseas), London, has received from the Bank's various managers reports on trading conditions in various countries, and in connection with Kenya states that the latest trading conditions which prevailed during July contained in August, both in European countries and in the East, but of an improvement in the latter, and the value of the Prime of 10 also showed a decided impetus to business. The building operations have been very active, and the coffee market is firm for good reasons, but not so for the delay of the opening of the crop, and what-growing areas continue producing, especially as regards maize. The seed market is still weak. As to Tanganyika, the Department of Agriculture estimates this year's cotton crop at approximately 25,000 bales, which, though about equal to that of last

year, is disappointing as previous reports from the growing areas gave rise to expectations of a yield of about 30,000 bales. With reference to Uganda, various conditions are reported. The reports of cotton to be planted in the coming season are not so satisfactory. Prospects for the new cotton crop are not so bright. The showings have been good and appear to be in general on a par with last year.

I am told by Mr. F. C. Lindfield, who will be re-elected as a member of the 1924 East Africa Parliamentary Commission, and as he had just returned from a strenuous work in Harrogate, Division, which he is conducting at the west Station, he had not been in "a" when the death of Stan Grey's brother, Mr. Charles Grey was announced. The Colonial Office had been in touch with him, as when he was in Africa he had spent a few days in Tabora Hospital, where Mr. Grey died. Mr. Lindfield was able to assure both the Colonial Office and Lord Grey that the staff at that hospital was exceedingly efficient and kind, and that Mr. Grey would have received every possible attention. Lord Grey was very pleased to receive this assurance from Mr. Lindfield and felt very relieved to hear his remarks and reported the best possible care and kindness after his terrible accident.

MAN WHO DISCOVERED AUSTRALIA

Finding Out Early Expedition Discarded.

DISAPPOINTED EXPLORER

The London Times prints a lengthy account of the expedition of Pedro Fernandez de Quiros, discoverer of Australia. It is an interesting document by the Quirós, who was a half-breed son of a Spaniard and a native of unknown descent living on the coast of the Bay of the Bights in the north of Australia. Flour Prices Reduced

The wholesale prices of all our different grades of wheat flour and atta, have been materially reduced as from October 1st, and no doubt bakers and storekeepers will make corresponding reductions to the public when their existing stocks have been cleared.

Since the early part of 1928 the wholesale price of our superfine white flour has been reduced by nearly 30%.

The latest reductions have been made possible by co-operation between the wheat growers, who have agreed to a reduction in the price of wheat, and the two leading millers (Unga Limited of Njoro, and the Kenya Grain Mills Ltd., of Nairobi). These millers have reduced their prices to figures which will be absolutely unprofitable, even with the reduced price of wheat, unless their combined sales are increased by 3,000 bags of flour per month. Topics for Motorists.

Water in the Crankcase.

How it Gets there and what it does.

Water in the crankcase or oil sump of a motor engine will not condense to rust, emulsification and sludge formation. This will be especially true in cold weather or where road dust, dirt, carbon or metallic particles have been allowed to accumulate to any extent.

The oil filter and air filter are factors in this regard. But above all and especially, it is not so equipped with these accessories, it is important to remember that periodic changing of oil and careful flushing of the crankcase and hub-inlets of the engine will be most advisable in the interests of prolonging the life of bearings and piston rings, the prevention of ridge wear on cylinder walls and the assurance of more dependable operation.

Why Water is Present.

Just how water may gain entry into such a carefully built and enclosed machine as an engine will be of interest. The general entry of water from an external source is remote, provided reliable petrol and motor oil are used which can be depended upon to be water-free.

Far more frequently will it be developed within the engine itself, as a product of combustion or condensation, as we will see in the course of an article in a book published by the Texas Oil Company.

Condition of Engine.

As a product of combustion, the absorption degree to which water may find its way into the lubricant system will depend upon the condition of the engine. In other words, where piston rings are worn or cylinder walls scored or so-called to result in abnormal clearance, an effective seal cannot be as readily maintained by the lubricating oil as in an engine where the proper clearance exists between the pistons and cylinder walls.

High clearances will be conducive to leakage. A number of determinants may thereby result. For example, loss of compression may occur through blow-by, or leak-

age of combustion fuel vapor on the explosion stroke.

There will also be the possibility of water leakage past the piston rings and into the crankcase. The extent to which water vapor is developed in the process of combustion can be realized by holding a glass receptacle over the end of the exhaust. The exhaust as it passes to the air is usually gaseous in form, though a certain amount of saturation may occur through partial condensation in the muffler. In passing, form water cannot be so readily observed, hence the idea of using a glass to serve as a crude condenser. After a few minutes of the collection of the exhaust, drops of water can be actually noted on the walls of the container. The colder the latter the more rapidly will condensation occur. This is another matter that takes place to a less degree, for the majority of the exhaust is naturally carried to the air via the muffler, except in an engine where the piston rings are poor. At all events, however, some of the exhaust will pass to the crankcase and the latter the more really will subsequent condensation result.

It is the opinion of authorities that virtually as much water as is present is developed in the process of combustion as there is fuel consumed. Each ounce of this will ultimately reach the crankcase to mix with the oil therein as actual water will of course. In other words, however effective the piston rings and lubricating film-function in the maintenance of an airtight seal, it would be wise to attempt to give a figure in gallons of water for example per gallon of petrol or per hour of engine operation as already stated.

Condensation from the air.

Water, of course, may also be condensed from the air within the engine. The normal conditions of design, air has full access through the crankcase breather.

Here again the variable, involved will probably even an approximate estimate of the water to be ultimately expel. It will depend upon the moisture content of the air, the weather, the altitude, the atmospheric temperature, the frequency of starting and stopping and the extent to which the engine actually becomes properly heated.

Condensation from excessively moist air may, of course, also occur within the petrol tank, especially where the amount of air in the tank is high and where the air is stored in a warm garage and then driven out under comparatively low atmospheric temperature. This factor seems to be considered even where the high grade of petrol are used.

Under widely varying temperature conditions and development of water in the petrol tank will be most prevalent, and in winter more so than in summer.

Water in the carburetor is indicated by misting. In this event the carburetor drain should be opened to remove any excess water that may be present. It would also be advisable for the motorist to thoroughly inspect the tank for presence of water at the earliest opportunity, and to drain the petrol from the tank and strainer.

Separation of Water.

Unless a device specifically designed for removal of water from the oil is service to prevent emulsification and sludge formation. But these developments will occur, not occur as rapidly with new or comparatively fresh oil as later on when the oil has been in service for perhaps several hundred miles.

Another factor to consider is the extent to which water will be held in suspension will depend upon the degree of contamination of the oil from other sources. The higher the degree of purity the more rapidly will emulsions be dissolved and water completely free from the bottom of the crankcase or oil sump.

Draining off perhaps a pint

from this latter every hundred miles when the engine is cold, approximate precipitation has occurred, about a factor of halving down water and foreign matter content of the air, the weather, and of serious sludging. It is not so difficult to comprehend, and is certainly worth the time and trouble required, especially where a comparatively costly engine is involved in which where continued service is desired with maximum retention in time lost or upkeep expense.

Causes of Rust.

In view of the fact that under average operation in cold weather the occurrence of condensation, the retention of an abnormal amount of water in the crankcase and the ultimate presence on the cylinder walls and in the engine oil will be prevalent, rust formation, where such an engine is allowed to stand for any length of time will be practically inevitable, for under comparatively low temperatures cylinder walls will not be completely dried off after stopping.

Research has indicated, however, that if provision is made to maintain the temperature of the engine cooling water sufficiently high (in the neighbourhood of 100 degrees F.) this possibility of rusting will be decidedly reduced. In effect this amounts to using means to prevent the engine and crankcase from cooling down abnormally when standing. This can be partially accomplished by covering of the radiator, storage in a warm garage, jacket use of the crankcase. This latter, in however, as a preventive of lubrication difficulty is still in a state of experiment.

Another effective means of reducing the possibility of rust formation is water accumulation on cylinder walls especially in a condition of standing. This may be avoided by spraying the cylinders with an abundant supply of oil at starting. Elimination of the by-product in cold weather and on the same high humidity high fluidity will help to accomplish the
