A NATIVE LOCATION AT MOMBASA.
Tangled Jungle Becomes Neat Township.

AN EXCELLENT SCHEME.
[STANDARD CORRESPONDENT] Mombasa, Nov. 15. Who only Kilindiini Road know this paraphrase—our parading of Biting used by the natives when taken in conjunction with a reference to a phase of their life which is practically unknown to the average Mombasa or other European. Mombasa (the Head of the "E. A. Standard") may recollect an article appearing in these columns some months ago with reference to the Kilindiini Sites, an old area that has been located for a new settlement.

Much traffic has about now flowed along Kilindiini Road and there, the dull rattle of the motor cars being distinctly audible in the location which is now being intensively developed by the natives themselves! What was, a little over a year ago, a remarkably excellent cover for the forenoon of munging in some shivering town containing some 223 houses built or nearing completion.

The scheme of development is of particular interest and as one or two prominent up-country people including Mr. A. C. Tanahili and Major Grierson are concerned in the venture its completion with the Highlands is not so remote as might appear at first sight. The idea is that the natives rest place from the Company the average rental of these plots work out at 7/- per building. On these they are allowed to erect temporary dwellings by temporary means of character which are the result of easy removal or demolition. The health authorities for example will not permit of such a combination or concrete buildings of any permanent nature and, as the plots are let on a temporary basis only the natives themselves are not likely to wish to build anything of an expensive or lasting kind.

Four Inspectors.
Your correspondent had a walk round the village the other day in company with Mr. P. Arliss, Inspector, the agent in charge. Two things struck him the most: the "nativistic" character of the village and the fact that it is an equally essential "European" system of laying out and planning. The huts are built

of mud and are appropriately treated to withstand weathering—and "mankat" the frontage of the buildings are, together. These make most comfortable and comfortable dwelling and have the advantage of being cheap. Each dwelling has a deep "scup" for the drainage of the water which is being installed upon by the natives and each house also has its own little compound for the cultivation of the staple maize plant. As to the houses, they are so desired, occupiers may have a central plot drawn which costs only a few shillings more.

Here and there one may see houses needed with period this finished—so in that fashion so much of the houses are being built. However, it is not 7/- but for the most part, the houses are of the most plain and useful type. No one is even now, however the bulk of the houses are not yet started.

As a result of this new European area having gained a hold on the natives' attention many African, Arab and Indian are seeking the approval and hygienic parlance of the Old Town and the nearer and up to the new town. This tendency is being encouraged by the authorities encouraged by the authorities who realize the value of getting the natives gradually acculturated. A group of a good proportion of the native population in the Salim Road, on the other side of the station, although, of course, this is done in the hands of the old dwellings, in conformity with the new planning scheme than to the fact that the natives are interested.

It is also known Mombasa may be interested to know just where the new site is situated. The hairdresser of the moment is meant either to be carried or to be looked into a bangle specially made with a ring clip to fasten it easily. It may be of precious metal, or it may match the frock, bridge and or fabric with which it is worn. The "matching hairdressing" is usually of synthetic, covered ribbon or a special crepe for chignon, and is large enough to play a conspicuous part in the ensemble. If intended for evening use, it is of the same material

as the frock, bordered with lace only along the lower sides which drop down on the sides when the top part is tucked into the stuff of the frock.

The woman who makes her dress make most all her attention must be given to the hairdressing, which must be well finished, or adorned with order of some thin metallic or jeweled ornament. This is a thing that is to be worn, for it is the only one that is to be worn that will give the impression that you are about to dance out of the door, you must also have a large hairbrush without any extra labor. You may start with a comb, but you must have a comb of silver crepe or chrome.

A black comb is a special feature of white and green, a very effective touch.

Another idea is to add a wide border of plain perrette to a printed apron.

INVALID COOKERY.

Invalid Diet-Tea (Quick Method)

Select one pound of nice fresh beef, without fat. Cut it into

Small pieces, put in a soupçon with two parts of cold water, leave to boil for three hours over gentle heat and bring to boiling point. Add one salt spoonful of salt, and immediately from half to three-quarters of an hour strain and set in a cool place. The meat left after straining may be boiled a little longer and powdered with spices for potting. This makes an economical and tasty breakfast food.

If it is necessary to serve the beef tea at once, pass it through a clean cloth wet saturated with cold water, and rub it. Not a particle of fat will then be left.

Chicken Soup.

Put a chicken into a pot and put it in a jar containing about two pints of cold water. Place the jar in a soupçon of boiling water and allow the chicken to cook slowly at the side of the jar for three hours, adding more boiling water to the soupçon from time to time if necessary. Strain by putting a muslin cloth over the mouth of the jar and letting the broth flow into a jug. If the invalid is very delicate, seasoning should be avoided.

Chicken in Argyle.

Prepare a chicken as for boiling. Place it in a soupçon with sufficient cold water to cover it, add a pinch of thyme, an onion, a table-spoonful of vinegar, a thick slice of brown, and salt to taste. Simmer gently till tender. Meanwhile cook half an ounce of gelatine in sufficient water to cover it. When the chicken is done, add the gelatine to the liquor in which it was boiled, and replace it by boiling. Slice the chicken, cut it into small pieces, place in a basin, and when the liquor is sufficiently reduced, strain this over, and allow to set.
