Miner Memorial Scholarships.

Five Miner Memorial Scholarships have recently been founded at the King's School, Canterbury, under a Trust Deed, out of funds collected by the Lord Milner Memorial Committee, to perpetuate the memory of the work done for the British Empire by the late Lord Milner. Their value is £100 a year for five years and one Scholarship will be awarded each year. Candidates must be over 15 and under 14 years of age on 31st Dec. These Scholarships are open to "boys of British parentage and European descent."

The Poultry World.
The Christmas Market.
Fattening the Turkey.



Those who are raising turkeys for the Christmas market should be seriously considering the preparation of the birds, so that they will be in their best at Christmas. In England, the birds are placed in crates for fattening, and in many cases are crammed. In this country, experience tells us that turkeys which are penned for fattening will not only fail to fatten, but will lose weight.

I have tried a good many methods, and have come to the conclusion that clean penning is impossible. I allow the turkeys practically free range until the end of November; from then onwards they are penned in a large pen with plenty of grass. As to feeding I find the best method to give them as much as they will eat. When they have cleaned up one dish of food give them another. It will be found best to give fairly small quantities at a time, so that they clean it up at once. Feed every four hours; but if it is found that they are not clearing it all up straight away, decrease the quantity but not the number of feeds.

The best turkeys for the Christmas market are those hatched all about the end of March. My turkeys were hatched the last week in March up to the third week in April. The cockbirds weigh from 11 to 14 lbs, and hens from 9 to 11 lbs, now, without any extra feeding. I have not the same advantage as many turkey breeders as if the birds were given free range they wandered on the road, and I have had six lost over by now. When it is possible to give the birds free range, from three months old until seven months old they cost very little to feed; it is only during half-year and when fattening for the table that there is any expense. Of course, if kept in semi-confinement they will require good feeding at all times, and naturally the ultimate profit is reduced.

Marketing.
It is advisable when reviewing the results of the flogging of the market last year, to decide early what is to be done with the turkeys. It is useless to expect that the birds will ever make the prices they realized Christmas 1926. There were many factors in the average turkey farmer's favour that year. One was that very large concentration was held up by the roads and did not get in until after Christmas another was that turkey raising was nothing like the extensive industry it is today.
Do not stick out for an excessive price. If the live weight will show a decent amount of profit, although the price is not what you would like, start sending into market the most forward of the birds. Where possible look the birds before hand. Of course, one drawback to looking birds in that with a large flock it is very difficult to have to despatch single birds.
Feeding.
In feeding, it is best to give plenty of soft food, with just one small grain feed once a day. The grain feed will prevent the birds from getting jaded appetites. Should the birds appear to be losing off their food, let them out for free range for a day, and only give them one small (grain) feed in the evening. They will be found to be quite ready for the extra feeding next day. Plenty of green food is necessary for turkeys during fattening, and I prefer green income to anything else at these times.
The perfect Christmas turkey should be about 11 to 12 lbs. It should be a compact bird, not too long on the leg. The breastbone should be firm and straight, the hanger and straighter the better, as this will provide the delicate slices of white meat.
A very large number of turkeys which come into market have cracked tendons in England.

This would reduce the table value of the birds, considerably. There can be no good slice of meat cut from a turkey which has been fattened for four months old. Their tendons are very hard and if allowed to stand when young they will be full of blood when the time is reached.
RENDERING PULLETS.
In the winter the pullets should be rendered, but the comb will not get too fully grown and they remain that way some years, until they begin to lay, but the rendering of the comb and wattle commences weeks before the birds actually produce eggs. The birds will cast the comb but the wattle will not fall off until actually laying.
Whilst growing they are exceptionally easy to look after, but they should not be "spoiled". The care they have to work for their feed the healthier and happier they will be. Their staple diet should be a "growing" mash of bran or maize, food must be allowed to be, but immediately eggs arrive the food must be altered to suit the bodily demands of laying. Grain should be well distributed, and if in a grass run, turkeys should be allowed to browse on the pasture, and on the farm where the corn should be thrown into close litter, free from dust.
Free range is best for growing stock, a very good formula being 1/2 lb of molasses, 2 lb of each of Sauer ground oats and bran, 1 lb of mixed germ meal and 1 lb of each fair meal and dried mill.
Give the grain ration just before the birds go to roost, and you will notice that when the birds begin to lay the comb and wattle will suddenly drop. Pullet grown birds require less food than do birds that are growing, but the former should have it in more concentrated form to meet the needs of production.

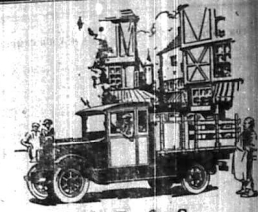

ROADS AND RAIN.

Local Character of the Showers.

Mr. Gallon-Penn writes as follows:—
The short rains are still occurring all over East Africa, but they are very local in extent. The most Nairobian showers are those which occur in the Mombasa-Kisumu and Mombasa-Kilimanjaro sections which is best in parts. Nairobian showers are very heavy over the Tanganyika region. At the conditions of country roads vary from hour to hour. It is not possible to give any definite information regarding rain falling in that region. The cost of a fair day but certain parts of Tanganyika and Uganda have had very local showers.

The following is the state of country roads as per telegraphic information received yesterday evening:—

Kisumu-Mombasa—Roads are closed owing to the weather. Nairobi-Kilimanjaro—Very bad for the first 20 miles out of Nairobi, after that passable.

Uganda-Kilimanjaro—Bad, rain having recently fallen. Mombasa-Voi—Fair. Araba-Bongala—Good for the first 40 miles out of Araba.

Government Procedure.

11. "That this Convention is opposed to the present Government practice of legislating partly by Table under Ordinances, such as the sanction of the Executive Council, and suggest that all Ordinances receive the prior sanction of the Legislative Council, except in special cases of emergency, when subsequent confirmation by Legislative Council shall be obtained." (Trans. Kenya Farmers Association.)

Local Government.

12. "That this Convention is strongly opposed to the application of the principle of Local Government to rural areas at this stage of the Colony's development." (Limuru Farmers Association.)

Native Affairs.

13. "That this Convention refers to Resolution No. 20 of October 1927, passed in the following terms:—'In view of the large number of natives apparently interested on a matter of crime, as shown by the number of criminal proceedings being instituted in this Convention that Government should be urged to institute a special period, to which such offenders be sentenced for an indeterminate term, on those something similar to the present practice in U.S.A.' and requests Government to inform the Executive of Convention and the Association putting forward this motion, whether it approves of the suggestion and whether it recommends to give effect to the recommendation." (Kericho and Bore Farmers Association.)

14. "That in cases where mile stones, public notice boards or other public property is in adjoining native areas, on damaged or defaced, it is the opinion of this Convention that the local native authorities should be held responsible." (Kericho and Bore Farmers Association.)

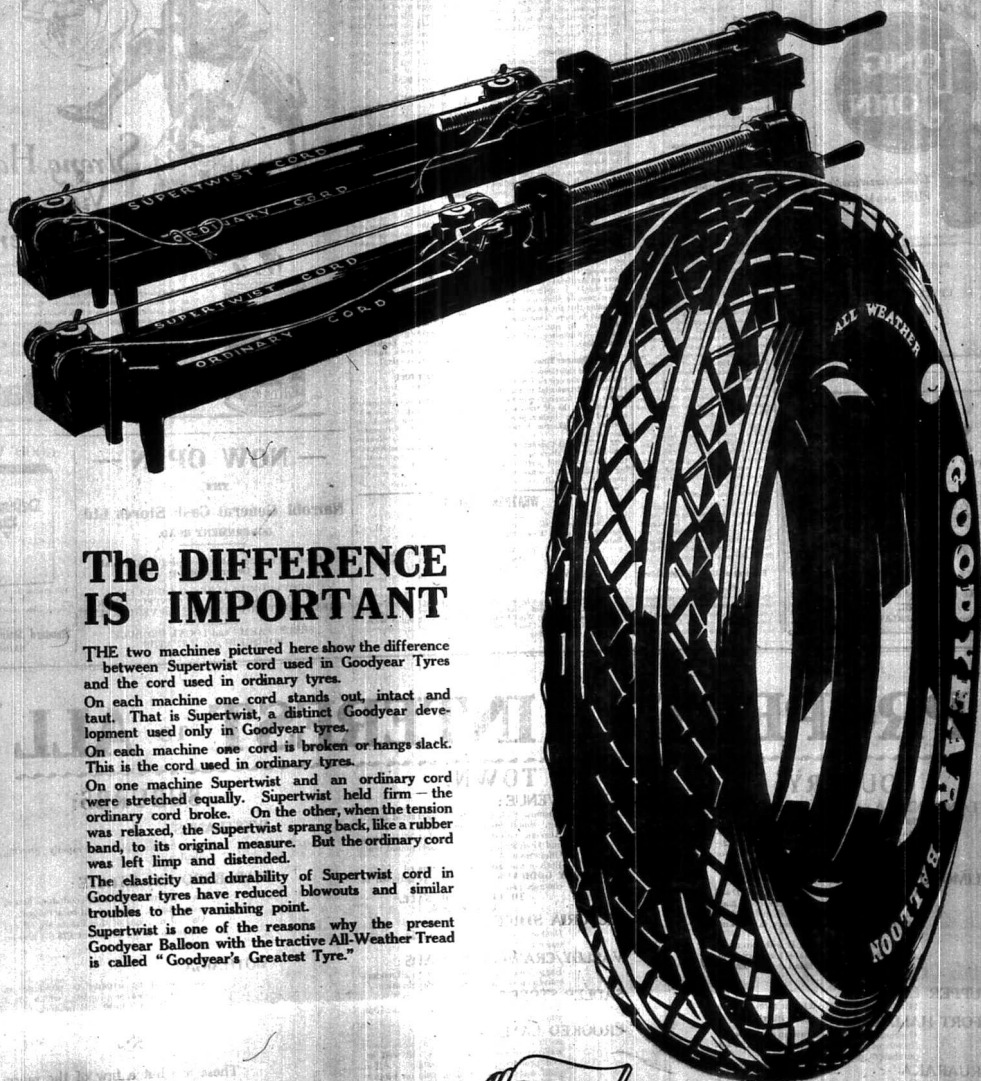

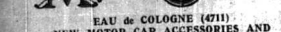

First Aid Hint.

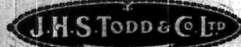
