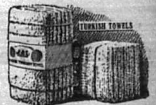

KIKUYU ASSOCIATION AND THE COMMISSION

Request for 12 Council Representatives.

The Standard has received, with a request for publication, a copy of the memorandum prepared by the Kikuyu Association for presentation to the Education Commission. It is as follows:—

(I) Land. The first and foremost thing in our country is land. We want the 105,000 Crown Lands, unalienated or assigned, and that we are granted title deeds and that our land may be secured in our own hands, according to our custom. As long as the said Crown Lands Ordinance is in force we are not able to do this, and we wish the Government to amend the said Ordinance so that we may be able to do this.

When the East African Commission was in Kenya, we placed our grievances in this regard before them, and the Chairman said that he would be prepared to see that we were given a reply on this matter in England; so we wish this matter to be finally settled by title deeds, and will still remain with a view to this.

(II) Federation. With regard to the question of Federation of the East African territories, the Legislative Council of Kenya, we feel we are not yet ready to enter into the same. As we are still in the process of settling our land, we do not wish the establishment of the Settlers' interests above those of the African people.

(III) Representation of African interests. In the Legislative Council, we want to have three members representing Africans in the following:— 4 African members, 4 Official members, 2 Natives.

(IV) Registration. The Kikuyu Association is against the Registration Certificate and wants the system abolished. (1) The system is unnecessary. (2) It is a nuisance. (3) It is a source of trouble. (4) It is a source of expense. (5) It is a source of delay. (6) It is a source of confusion.

(V) Chieftain and Headmen. The Chieftain and Headmen are not getting very good pay; they are not treated with any respect by the Government, and by many Africans who get more respect from the Government than from their own people.

(VI) Education. We want the Government to spend more money on education, and to employ more African teachers.

(VII) Agriculture. We want the Government to provide more land for agriculture, and to provide more tools and implements for the farmers.

All too soon the sky speaks into view and in a few more seconds the Moth glides gently in the midst of an alighting crowd.

Already, in the short time it has been in the country, Commander Robinson's aeroplane has proved in every way satisfactory and the fact that it is being operated from an aerodrome 6,000 feet above sea level has in no sense proved to be a drawback. For instance, the landing speed at Ngorong is only 40 miles an hour, or five miles an hour higher than at sea level, and the rate of climb, fully loaded, is 400 feet per minute at sea level. The actual distance taken in landing is extraordinarily small, being in calm weather, about 150 yards, whilst the distance taken to get up is from 100 yards to 150 yards. Moreover, the engine has been found to deliver just as much power as on aerodromes in British and to give 70 m.p.g.

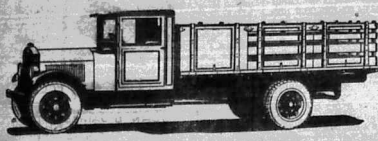
Boying Weaved This Week

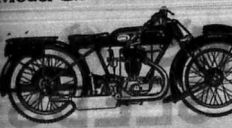

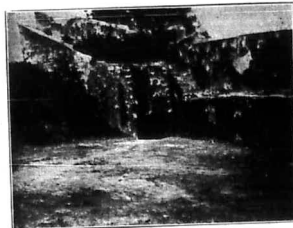

FEDERATION AND FINANCE.

To the Editor, "The Standard."

Sir.—Attached has certain points of view on the subject of the Federation of Australia, and every few weeks it comes from me on an account of the Federation. The first point, not counting the same raised from the United States, is the financial position appears now too sound.
