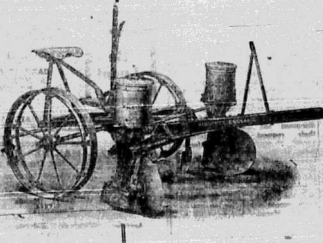

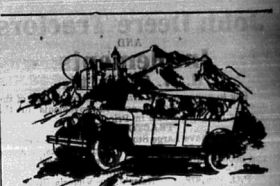

watch us and copy our example. "Loving the other man" will often show itself most markedly in self-interest that will not lead him away but help him to gain victory over self. Not a few lines have on elsewhere been broken through but examples set, not willfully but in mere carelessness.

We may all carry on our meditation and speak of this love in action as involving the recognition of at least two great responsibilities corresponding to our respective positions.

The first is the responsibility of privilege. Not one of us present here today but is called by recognition this. Those of us who come from the West are proud of our privilege, too numerous to mention. Our institutions are indeed a wonderful one, but corresponding to the great responsibility of privilege is the responsibility of duty. "Lord God of Hosts be with us, yet not we forget, lest we forget." But not only those who have come from other lands have this responsibility, you too, whose home is in Africa are here because you have accepted the privilege of membership in Christ our Lord and have been chosen by your fellow Africans to lead and represent them.

It is a fairly easy for all of us to make our privileges our boast instead of seeking exactly that grace which will enable us to use them worthily as "loving the other man."

The other great responsibility is that of opportunity. The familiar words of Jesus Christ are "In the time" world, we are told in the Revelation "Verily I come suddenly and no man knoweth the day or the hour." "Whoever may be our position as regards the responsibility of privilege, each one of us has special opportunities, and these opportunities may be used worthily as well as unworthily. Here too the guiding principle must be love of God and love of the other man; if we are to use them right, some must express these feelings as a high and holy duty, in purpose and practical results, which mean, much the same to the man who acknowledges God as His Father and Guide.

The Guiding Influence.
If, in Kenya today, the aim of all were to use both privilege and opportunity under the guiding influence of love to God and love to the other man, there would be no doubts of an ultimate result to the glory of God and the good of all who live here.

And this surely is the message of the Church of Christ, in loyalty to her master, and who are carried together in spirit, as representing one important branch of that Church, need to place on the message not only in words, but also in their lives, the spirit of our deliberations. We are not here in Kenya just to increase our numbers, but to find comfort and joy in the presence of our Master to try and see a little more clearly what needs to be done and by His Grace and Power to do it, so that by our lives and testimony, individually and of the Church, may be manifested the true and principle "love of God" and "love of the other man."

THE BISHOP OF CENTRAL TANGANYIKA—Coming now to some of the more important matters that will come before us, I would first briefly refer to the division of our diocese on All Saints' day last, when the Very Rev. G. A. It is with the unanimity of the Conference, I am sure, that there will be no serious division of opinion in our own discussions, but there are one or two points I should like to mention here.

First of all it is important to remember that the basis of agreement is not a draft constitution drawn upon paper, but a simple statement by men who were and are together, that forth in general terms important matters upon which they agreed.

I emphasize this fact because the plan has been raised at Home that the description in our back agreement of the powers of the proposed synod is to be distinguished by wage and mode much more than by name. If this description is accepted as a whole, I am sure some of us will object, in our own minds, to certain words which are used in the description of the proposed synod approved in the Report of the Anglican Conference and the legal advisers of the best of some of our members. It seems to me that this point is important as it is, in one of those upon which we are called to question of detail that men, serious men, may be settled with the aid of our expert advisers at Home.

Thus looking at the matter from the wider point of view we may not fairly claim that this proposal for a province is one example of the principle of working which I have dwelt upon above, namely, that of "loving the other man." I have been used to dairies where the milk was carried on the coast of New Zealand, and I would say that if they carried on the same thing as they do here, they would never see a bush, while their dairy land in this country runs something up to £100 and more per acre.

It has been proved over and over again that where proper farming methods are carried on, instead of the usual scratching and sowing the native to do everything, as good results have been put as in any other country, but that is all in the farm, and not meeting about in town, and the native is not the only one who can be expected to do a job of work. I have not yet seen one do a real job of work for that matter, and I don't think I ever shall.

Native labor has never yet proved anything but unscientific and expensive in any country in the world, and I speak from personal experience of natives elsewhere, besides Kenya. There seems to me to be no reason why he should be employed at all in other dairying or wheat farming here.

People here too often blame the country, and the natives, when they do not get the results they expect. There is nothing whatever the matter with the country, it only requires a few real farmers to work it.

I would venture to suggest that dairy farmers here would find it would save them well to import a few more of the kind of men who are known as the "Dutch" labor from home, to look after their dairy herds. Old-fashioned red wearing stock at home, who understand farming, to some extent, and settle on their farms. (It is a small farm for themselves on the estate, to work much as tenant farmers in England do.) One thinks of the acre would be more than enough, and that the man who is the best of the big farms in this country. The average farmer here must have had less than going to waste, and occupied by native managers of his farm, and this type of man is the type we want here. He would get more out of 100 acres than most people do now out of 1,000 acres, and be better off than the tenant farmer in England.

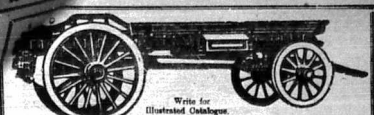

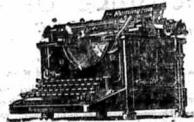

KIKUYU MEMORANDUM FOR THE COMMISSION.

Political Views of the Fort Hall Association.

OPPOSITION TO EUROPEAN ASPIRATIONS.

The Kikuyu Central Association has prepared a memorandum for presentation to the Hilton Young Commission.

In the course of this document the Association expresses its alarm at the suggestion that non-official Europeans are to be associated in a larger degree with Government in the trusteeship of the territory.

Adequate safeguards against further alienation of native land are requested.

Other changes urged include abolition of the Kiprandi system, removal of restrictions on cultivation of coffee by natives, encouragement of development of the reservoir, and the exemption of women from payment of poll tax.

Government is asked to accept the principle that native requirements should be a first and major charge on the Colony's revenue; that restriction be compulsory; that the number of schools be increased, hospitals provided and selected natives be permitted to pursue their education in England.

The Association is opposed to an Unofficial European Majority in the Legislative Council and declares that Government is already under the influence of the settlers. At the same time direct native representation is requested.

Finally, until these measures are introduced the Association considers political federation premature.
