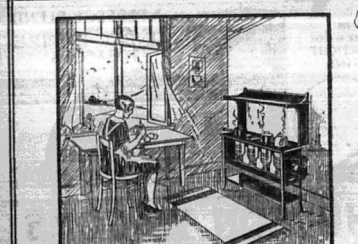

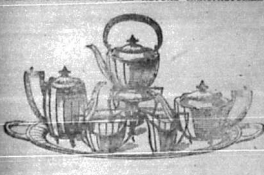

ENGLAND-SOUTH AFRICA AIR ROUTES.

Why Machines Choose the Eastern Way.

In the House of Commons recently Viscount Bledlow, (Cons. Shrewsbury) asked the Secretary of State for Air how much time would be saved in taking the route across France, the Mediterranean, the Sahara, the Congo, and thence to Cape Town, rather than by the East Coast, whether landing grounds would be so readily and cheaply met, and to what extent as to these points and as to commercial and revenue-producing possibilities the two routes would vary?

Sir R. Hoare: On the assumption that my Noble Friend desires a comparison between the route which is outlined in his question and the normal flying route to Cape Town, the answer is as follows: The saving in distance, if my Noble Friend's suggestion were adopted, would amount, it is estimated, to about 800 miles, representing approximately eight and a half hours' flying time. On the other hand, more than three-fourths of the western route would be over foreign territory, of much of which no detailed survey has been made. The establishment and maintenance of landing grounds and the equipment of them with adequate supplies of petrol, and all other work is very expensive, while in regard to commercial and revenue-producing possibilities the suggested route appears to compare very unfavorably with the normal flying route.

FEETHAIR & CLOSER UNION COMMISSION REPORTS.

Dangers of Premature Kenya Legislation.

In the House of Commons recently, Col. Wedgwood (Lab. Newcastle-under-Lyme) asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies whether that section of the Fortham Report which recommends communal representation for municipal elections in Kenya will be legislated on prior to the report of the Kenyan Young Commission; and whether the general approval of the report indicated by him includes this section dealing with the franchise.

The Secretary of State for the Colonies (Mr. Amery)—I have no recent information from the Government of Kenya which would indicate when legislation is likely to be introduced or passed on this subject. The condition on which general approval was given to the Fortham Commission's recommendations in their report relating to Nairobi did not further distinguish between sections of the report. Col. Wedgwood—May we have an assurance that the report of the Kilham Young Commission will not prejudice the very serious point by any premature legislation on this question in Kenya or elsewhere. Mr. Amery—Naturally that is a point which will be taken into consideration by the Government. Col. Wedgwood—Would it be possible to make that known to the Government of Kenya? Mr. Amery—I think they fully maintain its importance.

CINNAMON OIL.

Effect of a Drop in the Price.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT. Mombasa, March 23. The recent decline in the price of Cinnamon oil, which is manufactured in Swatara by distilling the leaves of the cinnamon tree, has caused a marked fluctuation in the market for this commodity. Making a very close study of the market, several observers feel that the drop in cinnamon oil prices will be very rapid.

Moreover, reports, the Director of Agriculture, informs the public that the drop in cinnamon oil prices will be very rapid from its fact that the price, which used to be about 100 shillings per ton, has now fallen to 75 shillings per ton. This is a very serious situation, as the Government should see fit to take some steps to regulate the sale of the synthetic article, or find some new outlet for the use of Cinnamon, the base of the oils derived from clove and cinnamon.
