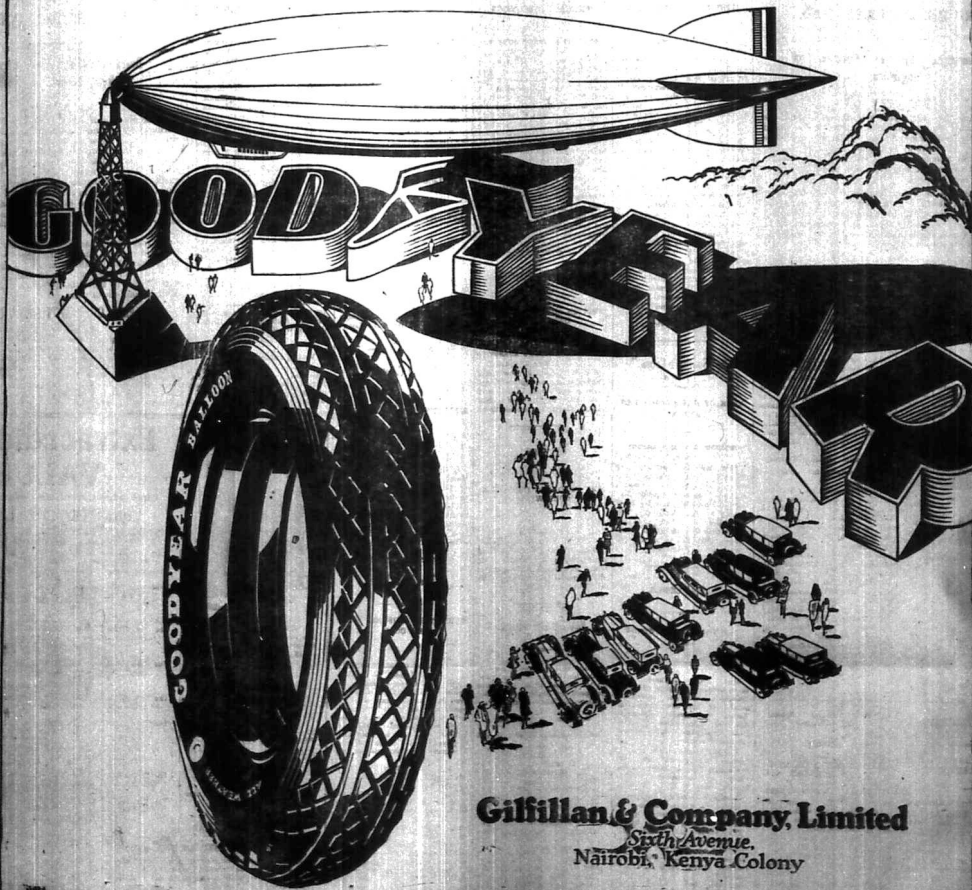

A Letter from India.

Mr. Sastri's return—Prison for his work—The South African problem—Dominion status again. Indian self-help—The demand for equality—A necessary preliminary—Sir John Simon's opinion—Casting the vote.

Romney, (By mail). The Right Honorable Sir James Bryce, Mr. Speaker, London, S. Africa, returned to London last month and was of course laden with all the warmth and glory which an ambassador of his country, Mr. Bryce, was held by almost every class and section of Indians to congratulate and welcome back the great patriot who has upheld the honor and reputation of the country so well in such a hostile field as South Africa was when he first went out. The extreme set of opinion, however, here has been greatly increased by Sastri's recent utterances regarding the folly of entering the British commonwealth and entailing the importance and benefits of dominion status, and not a few of their organs indicated in the usual sleepy manner, the country at large has been so pained to indicate to Sastri that the message in which he discharged his mission has been of great esteem and approval.

Sastri himself was overwhelmed by these manifestations. In the course of his replies to the numerous addresses he received he has abandoned the position of Indian in South Africa (and incidentally in the rest of the world) and taken the crest of the entire situation. The great majority of Indians that have hindered their progress in Africa, he said, were their poor standard of living, rather than the whites or the ground that he cultivated on economic progress to them, apart entirely from the danger that the synthetic and unduly methods of living common among Indians constituted to the community. The education problem affected the whites, whom he lowered the general estimation of the country as a whole. Let the Indians improve their status, he said, and they will adjust themselves so that they may be admitted without detriment to the general standard but that equality of status for which they clamor. That said, Mr. Sastri, in the real truth, and he firmly endorsed the demands of the whites. If the Indians want political equality with the other peoples of the Empire they must first become their equals in every other respect—socially, mentally, morally. To this end he appealed to Indians in Africa to assist their fellow-men in Africa with money, teachers, advice, to

submit this general improvement. The same problem, he added, existed in Egypt and indeed in every other part of the British Empire. Solve it in the present case of Dominion status and India is concerned is solved.

A Few Proofs.

The position in S. Africa, said Sastri, is not hopeless. But its development, in the very nature of the circumstances, must of necessity be slow—slow if it depends not upon a mass resolve, but upon a complete reorganization of the entire Indian community. Nevertheless, there was, even among the whites resulting from the Cappers agreement that the Indian community was all that was anxious to obtain. As for the answer, Mr. K. V. Reddy, Mr. Sastri declared that he had already created a residential institution, and would be able to send a number of his students to South Africa.

Dominion Status.

Regarding the same dominion status, Francis Montiel Sastri presented a lengthy attack upon the Government in the Assembly on a straight question asking whether there was any intention on the part of the Government to grant dominion status to India by the end of the year. The Home member, Mr. Curzon, replied that he was not prepared to enter into any controversy on the subject but that he had the authority of Government to say that the Declaration of 1917 and the statement to the same effect made by the Viceroy at the opening of the present Assembly Session would be applied to India. This statement coupled with a speech at Cochin, when the Home member, Mr. Curzon, was enjoying a short spell before commencing his last leg in India, have given a considerable way towards solving the problem. Mr. Sastri, in his speech, has his hitherto done, on the work of the Government. This he declared, was not to produce or bring a constitution for India. The Commission was only in India to study the conditions, and the Report of 1917 had worked

in the country, to find the general conditions in the country, and indicate in general terms the lines on which the most important reforms or the future constitution should be based. It was said that had done this Parliament would take up the question and after fully discussing it with British and Indian leaders, would frame a constitution of India in consultation with Indian opinion.

This statement coincides in substance exactly all that Indian politicians have been asking for this long while since the Indian Bill was appointed and certainly would be the best thing out of the best, however, have not yet expressed any opinion on the statement and presumably in pursuance of the hitherto decision will not do so. They have already framed a constitution—the Indian Conference—and this has been so in supposed to have been adopted by the whites on the subject which he said in the country. They are, therefore, content to leave their own opinion, to abide by the terms of the Constitution which they should be accepted by Parliament and submitted to the present system of Government. Apart from the thousand other considerations that render such a suggestion futile, there is the great consideration that the majority which a white has refused to accept the Indian Report, which they declare menaces their existence as a separate community. The Indian Report, it may be mentioned, completely ignores communal distinctions and provides that every Indian is to be treated as a citizen of the country with equal political rights. With such a large body of people as the Mahomedans, whose claims to have any sanction and respect ever be considered as a political demand by India, so that the position appears to be the same as before—there is no hope of more unanimity with the Government's suggestions have been raised by Sir John Simon, which refer to the above. Through those who know the gravity of the Indian position, it is understood that nothing will be stated with any degree of assurance.

Development of Indian Education in Kenya.

(Continued from page 1.)

Whitcomb Road. The upper school will be accommodated in the splendid new building in Strang Road. This building has been designed to accommodate pupils entering for the Intermediate and senior examinations of London University. The demand for education up to this stage has already risen. Another feature of the new school will be the provision of a well-equipped laboratory.

One of the first and most interesting experiments to be carried out here will be in connection with the boarding system. In the first place, a building capable of accommodating forty boys will be erected close to the main building. This will be the first time the boarding school system has been offered along with the first building on the new farm.

This should the community take kindly to the institution. Additional accommodation may be provided in the future. The headmaster of the new school will be Mr. J. H. Maxwell, who has a first-class honours, Master of Arts degree and the teacher's diploma of Oxford University. There will also be one European assistant and the remainder of the teaching staff will be Indian. The school which will accommodate about 400 boys will be opened next month.

Girls' Education

The policy in regard to Indian girls' education in Nairobi is unsettled. The point at issue is whether Indian girls in Nairobi should follow the example of Mombasa and attend one large Government school. Some of the Indian community have not failed to agree on the subject and at present sectional schools are being conducted, usually with substantial Government grants in aid. One such school has just been held by the community without a capital grant from Government—the Shree Saranai (Oltara) school which was formally opened by Lady Bath on Friday afternoon last.

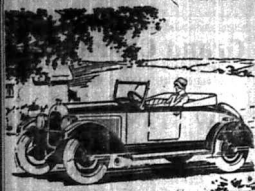

Indian Education in Kenya.

Outside the political sphere, in which desire and aims are not always very to understand or appreciate and where there is always a danger of pursuing false theories, to the exclusion of practical things, the requirements of the Indian community in Kenya concern primarily medical and educational services. To the masses, there are of much greater moment than political problems. There is no need to stress the importance to the whole country of improved conditions of health for the Indians of the Colony, or the provision of adequate modern facilities for the education of the Indian children born and reared in the Kenyan atmosphere, accustomed to regard the Colony as their home and perhaps retaining a deepening sentimental regard for Mother India. The present political objects may tend to leave the community behind in the forward movement which is inevitable and essential in the development of public institutions and organizations in a young country, particularly if these political objectives disregard the fact that despite their progress is bound to be made either with or without the consent of the protagonists of the policy. But the Government of British Colony cannot and will not disregard the responsibilities and duties imposed upon it by the occupational sphere of the services of the public utility workers to the moral and physical welfare of the community as a whole. Whether political disagreement is referred to any form of non-cooperation or voluntary abstention from public work is beside the question and of minor consequence when the interests of health and of education of our generation are at stake. The extent to which requirements may be satisfied directly by the finances available and in both material and educational services, rightly or wrongly. Government looks to somebody to help in this regard. In the field of education, in which we deal to us in a formative special article to-day, the Indian community leaders and wealthy men, have always been willing and anxious to play a generous and honourable part. The demand by the Government for the best education for their children is a pleasant relief from the burden of the political department. The article we publish suggests that Kenya is doing something worthy and worth while for its Indian people and that a sound educational foundation is being laid. The work would be assisted and strengthened in its beneficial effects and results if the leaders of Indian thought could see their way to place political aims in their proper place and to give their hands in the Legislative Council and elsewhere, to the furtherance of this vital side of their community's progress. They certainly owe it to their children to do so.

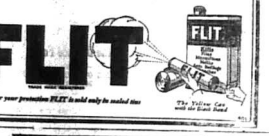

The Use of Silage in Times of Drought.

An Inexpensive Method of Providing A Succulent Feed.

The percentage of farmers who adopt the valuable advice which is frequently given regarding the use of silage is comparatively small. This fact is worthy of consideration in view of the fact that silage is one of the most valuable crops that can be raised on the farm.

It is not the purpose of this article to describe the different ways of making silage, but to explain the methods of silage preparation, but merely to impart information regarding the importance and also to mention the crops which are suitable for the purpose. When the farmer realizes that he should make silage, and knows also that he can grow a silage crop, then further information on the subject may readily be obtained.

Crops for Silage.

Maize.—For the greater part of the District, maize is without doubt the most suitable crop for silage. Not only is it superior to other crops in respect of reliability and high yield, it is to be grown on any soil and up to 60 tons per acre may be produced.

Other Crops.—Crops of less importance, which are particularly suitable for silage are Napier Grass, Guinea Grass, and Lucerne. Almost any succulent plant may be made into silage and silage of good quality—but it is often not economical to use certain crops for this purpose, owing to their low yielding capacity or because they are of greater value in the form of hay.

Mixed Crops.—Any of the crops mentioned may be mixed in the silage, and if there is a sufficient amount of one crop to improve the feeding value of the silage, the addition of a leguminous crop, such as cowpeas, is highly recommended. The cowpeas may be grown either with the maize or sorghum or separately. In the latter case, the better method is preferable.

Summary.

Losses of stock due to drought may be largely prevented by the provision of silage. Silage is a succulent feed readily made without great expense. The most suitable crops for silage, in order of merit, are maize, sorghum and sunflower, but also any crop may be used. Turning a crop into silage is often a means of saving it from being totally wasted.

Cowpeas, mixed with other crops, increases the feeding value of the silage. Silage should be made as early as possible in the season, and should be made in a silage pit or silage bin, and should be covered with a layer of earth or mud, and should be kept in a cool, dark place, and should be fed as soon as possible after making.

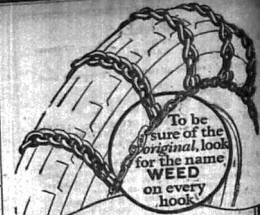

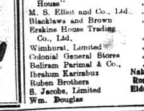

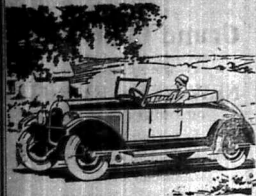

Sir Samuel Wilson, Permanent Under Secretary of State for the Colonies leaves Europe on 15th instant to conduct inquiries in East Africa with a view of ascertaining whether it is possible, by adjustment or modification of the recommendations made by the Closer Union Commission, to reach on the spot a basis of agreement. He will only be able to remain one week in each of the East African Capitals but during that time it is not improbable, according to the Governor of Tanganyika, that a Conference of Governors will be held at Nairobi attended by Sir Samuel Wilson. In sending him out on his special mission, the Imperial Government has made it quite clear that their policy will have no power to bind anyone to anything and that his report cannot be valuable before the General Election. Thus the new facts which have been added to the already long and involved story of the Hilton Young Commission and its controversial Report. No one can pretend that it is likely that Sir Samuel Wilson, in the short space of a month, plus a Conference of Governors and a rapid tour through the territories, will be able to solve the many problems presented by the ideal of Closer Union. The suggestion made by the Governor of Tanganyika that proposals prepared by Governments by their bodies and by individuals may be of assistance, rendered necessary by the curtailed character of the visit, is in fact a palliative of the impossibility of success unless other steps are taken immediately. It is found that the time at the

dignity of this Special Commission is inadequate to his task, so on the face of it seems to be a mere cloak for every ground for objection to that shortage of time and to being rushed off its feet when it is just necessary to make so vital a decision, and in believing that the useful work will be done by so hurried and incomplete an enquiry. Neither can the fact be overlooked that it is impossible to-day to know what changes may occur at the Colonial Office as a result of the pending General Election in Britain. But we believe that Sir Samuel Wilson's visit will be a far from useless purpose if he is prepared to tell East Africa frankly what difficulties have to be surmounted to reach the Closer Union Commission's Report and to what extent Government is prepared to meet the already stated point of view of the territories. When this subject of Closer Union was last discussed in East Africa, few people were aware of what was intended or what was happening either here or at Home. On the present occasion, on all the negotiations and enquiries there must be a clear understanding. Irrespective of the facts of the case, we believe that the difficulties cannot be satisfactorily solved unless and until East Africa takes its own share in both hands and attempts to find a solution on its own. A Conference of Governors has just concluded in London and a further Conference of Governors in Nairobi will be a complete, acceptable arrangement. The suggestion made of framing an acceptable basis of agreement is primarily the province of the Territories and it is necessary to be discovering that both Governments and individuals may be of assistance, rendered necessary by the curtailed character of the visit, is in fact a palliative of the impossibility of success unless other steps are taken immediately. It is found that the time at the

stage, is for a representative body of unofficial people to come together and to throw out the principles of a scheme acceptable to the Colony Administration. It is not nearly so great or important as fundamental, but the basis laid taken by itself, the report will not solve a measure of agreement although it has a great value in its simplification of major issues.
