

Dr. H. L. Gordon, whose lectures on psychology and the native mind aroused considerable interest in East Africa some time ago, approaches the Closer Union Report from a new point of view in a special article published below. He points out the "equilibrium" visualized by the Report logically means inter-marriage. Dr. Gordon concludes that the Commissioners had no special qualifications enabling them to assume "ideals" on which to base an Imperial Policy and decide the great problem of Racial Destiny, including the probable progress of the African Race and the future of white settlement in East Africa. He declares that such problems can only be brought to solution by long scientific enquiry and the believer that disaster must follow in the path chosen by the Commissioners if their unsupported assumptions influence future legislation.

THE LOGIC OF "EQUALITY"—INTER-MARRIAGE.

By Dr. H. L. Gordon. In the course of their deliberations, the Closer Union Commissioners found need to add to the questions in their terms of reference this final question: "What kind of policy is advisable?" To answer this question they found it necessary to form and express opinions on certain complex questions of racial importance to which we know each member of us is fully aware. We are obliged to regard questions not within the sphere of the Commission, as it could not be our authority for they are intricate questions involving in turn, together, history, anthropology, ethnology, psychology, sociology and ethics.

The Report and its recommendations are based upon certain assumptions which are "guiding lines" (Chapter VI). The third and fourth of these are, to suppose racial questions.

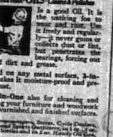

**Tea Planting in Tanganyika.**

Big Returns Obtainable After a Long Wait.

Two pamphlets dealing with the growing of tea in Tanganyika Territory have been received from the Tanganyika Department of Agriculture. These have both been written by Mr. M. F. Bell and are entitled "The Cultivation" and "The Planting Prospects" in the South Western Highlands of Tanganyika.

The booklet first mentioned is a short straightforward manual of cultural instructions, from the preparation of the land to the sowing of the plants during the first four years of growth, at the end of which stage they come into "bearing." Harvesting operations are dealt with in a subsequent booklet.

The tea plants in use of existing plantations, in the matter of soil and climate. Cleared forest land on the slopes of hills, such as in the hills, and where the natural growth is of sufficient density to permit of windbreaks being left to protect the plantations against the best time for plantations so far as soil is concerned, while there must be ample room—not less than fifty or sixty inches of rainfall appears to be the minimum requirements—while irrigation facilities must be present to make up for any deficiencies of rainfall. All this implies in many cases an elaborate system of contour drainage to prevent waterlogging, as well as a well-thought-out system of roads to permit of access to various parts of the plantation during harvesting operations. About 1,000 plants to the acre is the average, and must be planted when put out to a depth of twelve to sixteen inches. When the plants are eighteen months to two years old, they have to be "central"—that is, a ground right back to within three inches of the ground, in order that new branches may shoot

not so low as possible and form a low bushy tree.

**My Outlook.**  
It is when one reads the booklet which deals with tea planting prospects that one realizes the somewhat formidable nature of the undertaking that the would-be tea planter has to face. The booklet states very clearly in two details of the cost of establishing and maintaining a tea plantation. This an estate of 1,000 acres, carrying 600 acres of tea and fifty acres of planted timber, and with provision for a factory—a provision that would ordinarily require the resources of a company to undertake—would require an expenditure of £40,000 before it came into full bearing, that is £40 an acre.

In the case of an individual settler, starting on a 600-acre farm with 300 acres of tea on the farm he would in actual years to expect over £2,000 during the four years of preparation during which there would be nothing coming in. This does not include any allowance for a factory; it is assumed that the crop will be processed at a necessary or co-operatively owned concern.

**The Reward.**  
If the settler is successful in establishing his plantation, he should have nothing to complain of in the way of return. Assuming fifty acres a year, the first crop from the first year's planting at the end of the fifth year should bring him in a clear profit of £300 odd, and ultimately at the end of the eleventh year, when the whole plantation of 300 acres is in full bearing, he should be making an income of £2,700 a year clear; and as this return could be the substantial selling price of tea at 1s. 6d. a pound, he would upon no ordinary basis be getting more than the interest in a ordinary one that provides his subsistence.

As the booklet has been compiled in special reference to certain areas in Tanganyika Territory, which, according to the author, present all the conditions necessary for successful tea-growing, it may be that those areas have the necessary resources at their disposal who will feel inclined to prosecute further inquiries on the subject and so, kindly inquiries addressed to the Department of Agriculture at Dar-es-Salaam, will check the necessary information.

**The Labour Factor.**  
On the question of labour, which points out, is second only in importance to the question of suitability of any country for tea cultivation, the author says there is no doubt as to the suitability of the African for this work; but, he cautions, settlers must make up their minds to treat labour really well. This is to say, good pay, full food ration, or a cash equivalent, really good housing, proper medical attention, and all possible help and encouragement to parents and every sort of native children.

Proceeding the author says: I took Coligny plantation several years to learn the lesson, but once learned here, which accounts for the very good labour position at that island to-day. The reply so often made to these remarks is that the settlers cannot afford all this "padding" to the natives. This lays the whole situation open to the most obvious remedy—that it is only those who can afford to treat their labour properly who can expect to grow tea—for although there are good returns, considerable capital is required to bring this crop into bearing, much of which must be spent on native labour. There is a danger elsewhere by which settlers may grow small acreages of tea. If a settler's labour is provided, but in this instance also, the main risk must not be lost sight of, and that is the proper treatment and payment of native labour.

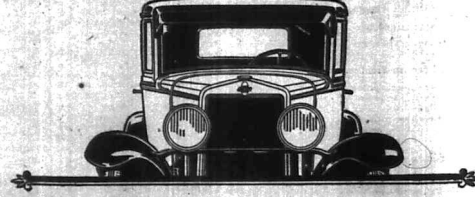

**THE ART OF MAKING CREAM PUFFS.**

(By Martha Magnus).

Many amateur cooks tell me that they are desirous of making cream puffs - or cream buns - as they are sometimes called - but hesitate to try. My answer is that, with reasonable care, cream puffs are no more difficult to make than sponge cakes, though they are much more appetizing. The fillings and the size of the buns may be varied according to taste.

**The Recipe.**

Required: One breakfast cupful of flour; one cupful of baking-soda; one-half cupful of butter (three eggs. (lift the flour before sifting).

Method: Heat the butter and sugar together in a small saucepan to boiling point. Add the flour all at once and beat thoroughly. Cook for about three minutes, stirring constantly to prevent burning. When sufficient



The additional air, which caught at the moment, is beautifully retained by means of a parchment colored best flour, skillfully cut and arranged after the manner of a little pointed cone. The effect is similar with a soft milk meringue.

If cooked, the dough will form a stiff ball which does not stick to the pan.

Remove from the fire and, while hot, add the three eggs, one at a time, beating for a minute after each egg is dropped in. Beat for three minutes after the third egg is added.

**To do the Trick.**

The "trick" of cream puff making is to add the eggs while the flour mixture is hot, and to beat well, especially while putting in the first egg, so that it will not become lumpy in the hot dough. The other beating is necessary to make the mixture of good consistency.

Make moderate sized cream puffs, and bake in a shallow tin, and round them into even shapes. Place at once in a hot oven (400 degrees Fahrenheit) for fifteen minutes. Then gradually lower the heat until you have a moderate oven (350 degrees Fahrenheit). Bake about forty minutes.

The high temperature at the beginning of baking causes the buns to "spring." The lower temperature at the end gives a chance to dry thoroughly in the centre. If they are doughy in places when taken from the oven, they will fall when cold.

This recipe makes ten medium-sized cream puffs. Often they are filled with sweetened whipped cream mixed with chopped glace cherries. The most economical way you can make the puffed paste and fill them with some creamy mixture. The most economical filling is a cream made from thickened custard, or a thin meringue mixture.
