CAPTAIN MALCOLM CAMPBELL'S SPEED RECORD ATTEMPT.

Fails to Exceed Major Segrave's Figures.

IDEAL CONDITIONS AT VERNEUK PAN.

Series of Mistortunes Causes Earlier Attempts to be Abandoned.

After a number of unfortunate occurrences which caused unavoidable delays, Captain Malcolm Campbell made his attempt on the world's land speed record at Verneuk Pan, South Africa, on Sunday.

His attempt was not successful in exceeding the speed recorded by Major Segrave of 231 miles per hour. Captain Campbell's average speed for two journeys over a measured mile was 215 3/4 miles per hour. The conditions were stated to be ideal.

The attempt was made in the late afternoon, but during the early morning, when conditions were perfect, it was found that the timing apparatus was out of order, later followed a private car. After that another opportunity was lost by private cars straying on to the track. Later engine and tyre trouble caused delay in the start.

SPEED OF 218 MILES PER HOUR.

Verneuk Pan, April 21. Agriculture.

The Use of Farmyard Manure.

Improving Quality by Care before Distribution.

There is generally little attention paid to the manner in which the average farmer, but however small the quantity may be, is worth while to take care of a unit each time so it can be distributed on the land. The value of manure which has been properly stored for use compared with that which has not, is more than enough to pay for the trouble and expense involved in caring for it.

There is a great deal to be made in the least use of the manure, and not simply throwing it out on to any convenient bit of ground where it may happen to fall, that the farmer wastes a lot of obtaining it, says C.D. in the "Hilary's Chronicle."

Analysis of kiln-dried manure compared with those of the fresh product show that when manure dries too quickly, there is very little plant-food left. When on the other hand the manure is kept still wet, there is not much loss, excepting of organic matter. It is when the hay is exposed to man that it varies between these two desirable extremes. It is neither quite wet, nor quite dry for most of the time, and the losses of both organic matter and plant-food are excessive. There must be care for the development of bacterial processes, which are responsible for the change that takes place, but there must also be care to keep the dry hay and the wet hay undergo less change than the one which it absorbs than the two to its condition.

Well-stored manure may be worth more, ten for ten, than fresh manure, depending a good deal on the conditions under which it was produced, but it takes so much fresh manure to make a ton of stored manure that the cost of the manure to be spread on the ground after it has been produced. The necessary process of drying will take place after the

manure has been ploughed in and they will take place without loss of valuable plant food. These considerations are quite apart from the fact that leaving manure to take these when manure accumulates for a considerable time before it is spread on the land. To a dry climate it is probably more convenient to place the manure where it will dry out quickly and remain dry until it can be carted to the land. Hence the convenience of keeping the hay wet, there is the added labor of distributing the wet product as compared with the dry form.

If the amount of manure is small, a small square of thatch will provide a shed that will protect the manure from bad weather, enable it to dry out quickly and ensure the minimum of loss. It is very necessary that when adding to the pile the daily supply be mixed so that rapid drying will take place. If it is of course advisable that the shed provided for the manure be located some distance from the house.

When it is not convenient to depart from the usual plan of allowing the manure to accumulate in the house until it can be applied to the land, the position may be considerably improved by throwing a few loads of waste water hay or any similar material into the house as soon as they have been obtained. This "chamber" material will improve the sanitary condition of the house as well as reducing the loss of plant food through leachings.

In regard to the use of the manure in the most economical way, there are a number of important points to be observed. The effect of manuring naturally appears to be of greatest value when it is put on shabby, but the highest return per ton of manure is obtained when the manure is spread as it is. Another point which

must not be forgotten is that large amounts of any sort is highly unproductive fertilizer. It is in fact, all a balanced fertilizer as regards the needs of one soil and crop. Few lands, unless light and sandy, and obviously low in organic matter, are not particularly likely to need a nitrogenous fertilizer so greatly by it if it is given. The effect in the case of grass crops especially may even be a decrease in yield, due most probably to the phosphorus-nitrogen ratio in the soil having been adversely affected.

The greatest agricultural value may be obtained for farm manure by using it on the lighter, more sandy soils, on the grass and other lighter crops rather than on the heavy soils, and by always using appropriate quantities on the lands that have been manured. It is an excellent plan to mix dry stilled farm manure with super and to distribute the mixture with the fertilizer attachment of the plough, but it is not advisable to mix super with the ordinary half-ton super for broadcast distribution, though the greater effect may be obtained from the super by placing it close to the soil as it does with the fertilizer attachment, and the use of super by adding it to the manure might easily prove to be a comparatively extravagant practice if not carefully managed.

Sand for Concrete.

A farmer is often doubtful if certain sand available on his farm is clean enough for use in the construction of concrete and in this direction the following rough methods of testing may be used:

(1) Take a little moist sand on the palm of the hand, and rub it lightly with the fingers of the other hand. If the palm remains clean, then the sand is fit for use, but if

a thin film of sticky matter adheres to the palm, loam is present. To be sure, scrape off a little of the deposit adhering to the palm, place it between the teeth, and if it loams if it does not feel gritty.

(2) The appearance of dry sand may indicate if it is clean or not. Loam particles of dirt can be seen sticking in little lumps to the sand grains. Fine roots will indicate the presence of vegetable matter.

(3) A most accurate method than the foregoing is to use a 50 lb. tin. An ordinary clear brassy tin will do. Fill the tin with the bulk of the sand to be tested, and fill it with sand, then about fill it with water, shake the tin and slow the contents an hour two days to settle. Examination will now reveal all the mud at the bottom, and if the sand-water foam, this foam will be deposited on top of the sand and will be easily recognized by its color. Should this layer of foam be more than three-eighths of an inch, that is more than five per cent, then it is necessary to wash the sand by using a 12. However, the thickness of the layer is not the mud is clean enough—J. W. Clapham, Lecturer in Engineering, School of Agriculture, Glas.

Murray, Ngara Plains. In each plot there will be carried out trials of fertilizer, rotation and different kinds of crops and the effect of sowing, timing and green manuring will be demonstrated.
