New Machinery for Migrant.

2. CANE CULTIVATION.

["E.A. Standard" Special]
On arrival at Mweini, Mr. Mwangi gets some idea of the amount of work entailed in the sugar industry. The yard is just now abuzz with the noise of the machinery which will go into commission as soon as the season opens. There is a new C.I. sulphur burner awaiting erection, new superheaters and pumps, two new crystallisers, and a set of tanks all waiting to be put in the factory, to say nothing of three or four new rollers for the mills to produce straw-berries. In addition the whole of the mill and factory machinery and installations will be thoroughly overhauled and brought abreast of the times.

Mweini suffers many disadvantages but none they have not been able to overcome so far. Being a long way off stores and spare parts. Every contingency has to be allowed for and this means heavy outlay and incidentally a loss of interest. Long railway journeys to and from the Coast mean much money spent in transport as stated above. Mweini labour does not seem to be particularly efficient and this makes labour dear. With Indian hands labour has sufficiently appreciated the Company has had to import European labour at great expense. This has been done and many European agents, growers, blockholders, owners (farm and factory) have been a help. It is not a permanent hit with the Company of Mweini. Water supply is another source of trouble, it being some ten miles off, especially during the dry season. This has been overcome to a large extent by the water-raising tower, over which returned water is pumped and Mweini ordinarily believes disadvantage was only to be overcome.

Indian Cane Growers.

With the progress of Mweini we have the Kilim Kilim cane growers prepared. Many were just building land for speculation, some making a little jagua and others growing a little maize, and had been put all generally hanging on. The soil and the facilities for planting and we have a perfect little colony

very much on the map and that our country is being rapidly washed, although the impression created is that we are to regret to say that such washing is for the good of Kenya but an opportunity to visit the race that has done so much to bring Kenya to the present stage of prosperity and civilization. It is unfortunately a very real impression which is created, I am, however, certain that no one who receives intelligent criticism more than the Englishman who reputation for his sense and justice is world-wide and who has been more than once on hand by treating his criticism into satire.

"The great problem of government and progress in Kenya," he continued, "from the fact that there are in Kenya three races—most of their members being British, subject to the influence of Africa, the Asiatic and the European, each race doing its own thing in the development of the country. The solution of the problem lies in co-operation and not in antagonism and I hope that every opportunity will be given to allow co-operation to become an established fact in all things that concern the progress. Full co-operation can only develop from a full and sympathetic understanding of each other's views and every effort should be made by each community and their spokesmen to arrive at that understanding."

A Tenth Year. "The past year has been such as to bring out the best characteristics of our race. In many parts of the Colony the absence of sufficient rain has rendered farming with reasonable profit an impossibility. Compelled with the drought conditions, we have had and will have an unusual infestation of locusts which brings the devastation of growing crops in their train. Yet the position here, I am proud to say, have faced splendidly with that combination of fortitude and hope which we know are the distinction of our race. The rains are late but can only hope and pray that 30 George's Day may inaugurate such a soaking that our springs

will be restored. It is naturally true that locusts may be dispersed. "Intelligence has been made recently to the Governor of water conservation. I know of no more important work which could be done. The Government of Kenya that these conservation of water supplies of the Colony and agriculture, and the fact that both of them are of the greatest importance to the country."

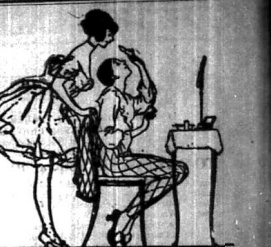

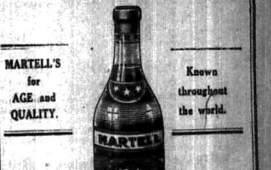
