RAINFALL GENERAL IN TANGANYIKA.

Excellent Prospects of Good Crops.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORT.

The following report on the crops in Tanganyika Territory for the first half of April has been prepared by the Tanganyika Department of Agriculture:

Coastal Area: North.

Uganda.—Crop situation good. Native are still planting. Good rains have fallen throughout District.

Kenya.—Rains below. Planting good.

Magadi.—Coastal belt twenty miles still awaiting rain. Inland of this amount of rain falls and crops coming forward. Whole district still in urgent need more rain.

Coastal Area: South.

Buiki.—Heavy rains general. Cultivation crop progress reported on March mentioned. Cereals plentiful. Lower unfenced, land cultivated, completed valley up-lands. Rotten rice six feet in three feet destroyed some maize low lands.

Kilifi.—Good rain reported. Cereals coming to state prospect. Cotton coming forward. Early planting flowering in parts. Out crop looking better.

Lindi.—Fair rainfall during last month random portion generally good. No rain report. Kiboko generally economic crop, but covers state, bare stalk on millet, reported on Kenia and Southern Coast cover.



A MONUMENT TO LIVINGSTONE.

To Be Erected Near the Victoria Falls.

WORLD-WIDE APPEAL.

On the banks of the Zambesi, near the Victoria Falls, which he discovered during his historic travels through Central Africa, is to be reared a fitting monument to the memory of David Livingstone, missionary, explorer and philanthropist. It is in over fifty years since his worn-out body was laid to rest, yet no monument at present exists in the land in which he worked and where he won such national esteem and regard.

The fact of a widespread feeling throughout the Empire that a mark of appreciation should be reared to the memory of the celebrated man who opened up Africa to the world, and who sent his noble soul to the memory of a brother Scot who endeared world service. The aim of the Society is to build near the Victoria Falls monument which will have a symbolic design representing the central figure, supported by the symbols for the four continents, and for which he lived and died.

The cost of the undertaking is estimated at £15,000, and a working appeal is made for funds to enable the project to be carried out.

HINDU TEMPLE FOR LONDON

London, (By mail). We are to have a Hindu temple erected in London in order to satisfy the great demand for such a place of worship in this country. The scheme is to be carried out by the Vedic Mission in Bombay and it will cost at least £25,000 for the formation of a small colony of Hindus and the erection of a temple. A site has already been chosen in one of the suburbs and plans of the temple shikharas have been submitted to His Holiness Jambhadr, Banaras. His Holiness has consented to the plan itself will cost £12,000, and it is understood there will be special buildings for studying Hindu philosophy, music, painting and other fine arts, and a school. A Hindu priest will be sent to look after the Temple.

AN INDUSTRIALIZATION PROCESS

London, (By mail). An industrial revolution is taking place in England in the southern counties. It has been first observed and commented on by the majority of the public. It is so essential that it is obvious to the ordinary casual observer. Old families please have suddenly become modern. A new kind of a year ago, now lined with the workshops of a new industrial process. There are already 30,000 factories in Greater London, and an average of at least one new one is being built in the outer suburbs. The change is most rapid to the west of London. There is no doubt that a few years ago were almost blank. The process is going on with constantly accelerating speed. There is hardly a place on the Portsmouth Road which is now without an important industry. Yewell in the west is now the home of many industrial undertakings. The planning and education are other factors mentioned by the factory inspectors.

What is new clear to everybody is the ancient proof of two great industries that are taking place in the face of industrial England—the transfer of industry generally from north to south, and its decay in consequence from the old crowded manufacturing cities to healthy and desirable and changeless.

New sources of power in water and electricity are receiving the processes of a hundred years ago industry in consequence of the cities and towns were made. The population in consequence is migrating to the countryside. This movement is being on an official station. In five years the number of hand workers in modern districts has increased by 10 per cent. In the north Midlands 10 per cent. The increase in the east is 20 per cent. In the west it is 30 per cent. The increase in the south is 40 per cent. In the same period has been only 10 per cent in Wales. There is here a decrease. The Reply.

The Chief Secretary replied that all native coffee planters in the Moshi district were members of the Native Association, and that there was no legal obligation on any member to sell any portion of his coffee to the Association. The great majority of individual native coffee growers previously sold their coffee to a European firm at Moshi which acted as selling agent for the Native Association and were paid for their coffee by the agents on receipt of London selling prices. No money on account of sales of coffee had been handled by the Native Association as far as Government were concerned. The Chief Secretary added that the native coffee growers receive less than 20/- per ton for their Arabica coffee of the same grade. The accounts of the Association according to the P.C. Northern Province, were in the account of the Native Planters' Association during February and March 1929, could not be made in future.

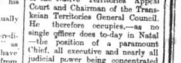

Agriculture.

The Use of Waste Products on Farms.

Big Developments of Significance to the Farmer.

The following interesting article dealing with the possible uses of waste products on farms, and written by "Mentor," recently appeared in "The East African Farmer's Weekly".

The success of chemistry in agriculture associated chiefly, so far as the industrial world is concerned, with the production of chemical substances, has of late years centered upon a much wider sphere of industrial development and on the production of waste materials which, and so long ago would have been regarded as not having the slightest connection or association with chemistry in the sense that they have usually occupied. As far as the agriculturalist has been concerned he knew that such commodities as artificial fertilizers, dips, stock medicines and a hundred and one necessities as in use on the farm were the outcome of chemical research and were the products of ordinary chemical processes, in fact were merely the result of the refinement, separation or recombination of ordinary chemical substances. The organic products of Nature were regarded as something beyond the powers of the chemist to reproduce or copy for his own use. The basis of such products was the mysterious process and method of operation are unknown, and which from the three elements of air, earth and water, can recombine and build up an infinite variety of forms and matter having but one character or principle in common—that of life.

Benefiting Nature.

Yet all organic products are after all but the result of chemical forces and reactions carried out in Nature's laboratory, and as chemical reactions opened up new fields of knowledge and as our own research has led us to have that govern the combination and separation of the elements, and new elements were discovered, so we were the more enabled to have taught the chemist, not the secret of Nature's processes, but how his products might be imitated and so translated into the production of many substances and materials, for which no counterpart in Nature can be

The Care of the Carburettor

Dismantling, Cleaning and Re-Assembling.

THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION.

Although the theory underlying the working of a carburettor may not be fully understood by all car drivers, the actual construction of the instrument is quite straightforward and presents few difficulties in dismantling. For thoroughness, there are two expedient methods of returning to the original state, so on the case of a minor repair. Some of the parts are fairly delicate, however, and are easily damaged.

One of the chief features of the float is its simplicity, and only a three-way float valve that is worked by which they are so material does not require the use of any special tools.

Location of the Parts

The main body of the carburettor is secured to the engine by means of a flange pipe. The top of the instrument contains the butterfly throttle and the choke which carries the top of the float chamber on which is situated the needle valve. The float chamber itself together with the main and pilot jets is a separate casting integral with the body to receive a float projecting from the center of the float chamber and hold it in a position which passes through the float chamber.

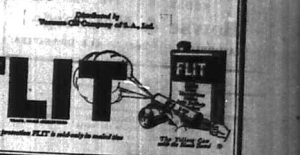

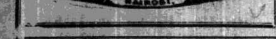
