### Tsetse Fly Research Work.

Progress That is Being Made in Tanganyika.

A feature on Cattle Tsetse was recently delivered in Tanganyika by Mr. Seymour, the Director of Tsetse Research. The Director's address is as follows: The tsetse flies, which cause the disease, are found in the general country, and then come on to cattle when they are in the bush and was being done in the Territory.

Tsetse flies, twenty two species in all, are today confined to Africa, with a doubtful tsetse from Arabia, but at least three dozen species have been found in the United States. A picture of one of them female was shown, and the name of the insect, the transmission of the American disease carried by the Tsetse—namely human sleeping sickness and nagana or trypanosomiasis in cattle—were also explained. The trypanosomes which cause these diseases pass through a cydial phase in the bodies of the selected parasites in the mosquito, but can also be transmitted "directly" by contact biting flies passing rapidly from a sick horse to healthy ones.

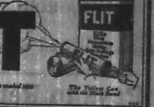

MR. SASTRI PASSES THROUGH THE KENYA CAPITAL.

Mombasa Plea for Greater Activity by Moderate Opinion.

STATING THE COMMON ROLL CASE.

Results Can Only be Obtained by Being Fair to the Other Side."

The Rt. Hon. Srinivasa Sastri arrived in Nairobi on Saturday and after remaining half an hour in the capital continued his journey to meet Sir S. W. Hoare in Uganda.

Several representatives of the Indian community joined Mr. Sastri at Kin and discussed Indian questions with him en route to Nairobi.

Speaking at Mombasa Friday Mr. Sastri stated his adherence to the belief that the Common Roll was the best in the end for everybody in Kenya but agreed that it could only be made possible through an Anglo-Indian agreement.

It should be the endeavour of the Indian people to persuade the British not to attack them but by calm and moderate reasoning and by being fair to both sides.

If the Indian people were content to go what they could today and to wait for the rain until the day after to-morrow then, if the Kenya question was to be solved in that way it seemed to him a symptom not to be neglected of how more serious problems of the Empire should be solved.

Mr. Sastri refuted a report from the Bombay correspondent of the "Standard" that in speeches he had made comparisons between the Indian and European communities to the detriment of the former.

Special Plans to get People to the Coast.

A series of accidents followed by a huge volume of water in a cutting near Tororo last night.

The extent of the damage may be judged by the fact that three hundred and sixty yards of railway track was involved and, in the actual case, the 120-ton trucks of a motor train were completely derailed.

The break occurred on Wednesday night on the Uganda extension which was accordingly closed, just as it was to open.

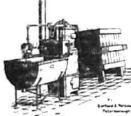
