Association Football Matches Series Start.

RAILWAY DEFEAT GYMKHANA.

Association football made a sensational commencement on Wednesday evening when Railway beat Gymkhana in a Dobiee Cup match.

The game had originally been scheduled to be held on the 14th but had to be postponed on account of the rains rendering the grounds unplayable.

There were several hundreds gathered round the ropes when the Railway opened with a quick raid which ended in a corner, Doby heading over. The Gym. centre then made several attempts to open the scoring, this time from thirty yards out, but the ball went straight to the keeper's hands.

So far there was little in it. Gymkhana's first line was the better combining lot, but they were poorer backed up by their forwards, and this, combined to avoid finishing was many a feasible opening.

Fortunately enough, when Railway did score, it came by way of an effective opening up movement by the inside right. Modernising a Used Car.

Tackling the Problem of Bringing a "Ten-Year-Old" Up to Date.

IS IT WORTH WHILE?

There are quite a number of prospective motorists who cannot afford a brand-new car and are limited, therefore, to a used machine of low price, and who are yet sufficiently interested in the mechanism of the machine to want the car to be brought to a really satisfactory running condition.

A frequent difficulty of owners in the expense entailed if the car has been run for a good many years. A ten-year-old machine, for example, can be brought for a very small amount of money, as it is then rather a moot point as to how much additional expense should be incurred, because it is quite easily happen that the bill for putting the car in good running order may be quite as much as the cost of the car, and in some cases a considerably greater cost.

The origin of high tension ignition systems, whether they be coil or magneto, is to be found in the induction coil invented by working before the days of internal combustion engines.

The Logic Coil. The system worked well but in common with other coil systems of the period was supplanted by the magneto, originally introduced by Robert Bosch.

It may be explained that the coil consists of a soft-iron core, generally made of a bundle of wires, over which are wound two or three layers of comparatively coarse insulated wire.

One end of the lead, as we have seen, is connected to the contact breaker. The other end, which is connected to the spark plug, is connected to the secondary winding of the coil.

The high-tension current was supplied by means of a magnet type of induction coil, but instead of a lead being drawn to the sparking plug, the lead ends were connected to the inner end of two Leyden jars.

The system worked as follows: The high-tension current from the coil charged the inner coating of the Leyden jar, and when a man took the jar in his hand, he was struck by a shock.

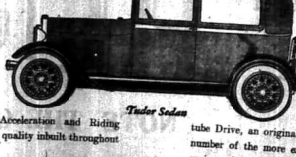

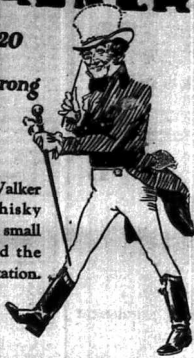

necessary to enable his page 187) to carry out the proposed scheme. 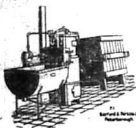
