AN IMPORTANT STEP.

The fact that the land question is the core of the problem in Africa is becoming more widely recognized.

Half a million acres have been set aside to the native area. Including native reserves, native purchase areas now inaugurated, mission land, etc., the total area set aside for natives in Southern Rhodesia will be 29,500,000 acres.

**ANTHROPOLGICAL CURIOUSITY.**

#### FIGURES FOR FEBRUARY, MARCH AND APRIL.

The following statement prepared by the Acting General Manager of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours Department shows the tonnage of goods carried during February, March and April, 1929, compared with the same period of 1928.

Export traffic routed to Kilindini Harbour February, 1929, 98,907 tons, 1928, 26,150 tons, March, 1929, 29,500 tons, 1928, 22,260 tons, April, 1929, 22,414 tons, 1928, 23,982 tons. The total export traffic routed to the Coast for four months of 1929 was 104,209 tons as compared with 100,134 tons for the corresponding period of 1928, an increase of 4,075 per cent.

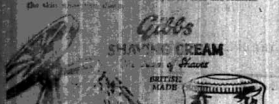

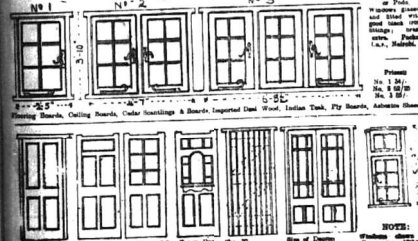
