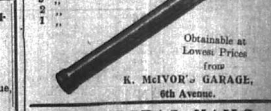

(Continued).

Mr. Evans suggested that there was no need to arrive at an figure of the actual cost of production...

1. That of maintaining a price that would not affect margins but would keep those who by reason of unfavourable conditions of commerce...

2. A production of pigs and the exportation of new sows with the consequent increased volume of production.

Mr. Curran then proposed and Mr. McCall seconded: "That from figures and information furnished to the Conference it appears that there is conflict of opinion with regard to the cost of production of pigs...

The discussion then turned on the proposal to reduce the present price by 5 cents per lb. Mr. Dixon Grey asked for information as to what would be an economic price to pay for pigs to export the produce.

Col. Tucker gave the following tentative figures—Side of the quality produced by his history company with Canadian bacon marketed in England at Shs. 94/- per cwt. in February. Assuming Shs. 100/- per cwt. were secured in that market, it is calculated to 80 cents per lb. The cost of exporting to England and marketing might be taken at 25 cents.

During the first Pig Conference held in Nairobi recently there was a considerable amount of discussion as to the possibility of holding a pig conference to discuss the industry in dealing with the pig production costs... Mr. McCall asked if there were any other members of the Conference who would like to give advice in this regard.

Travelling Boats. An extract of a letter from Mr. Morley White was read to the Conference on the subject of travelling boats.

Mr. Thompson proposed and Mr. Grey seconded: "That the Conference recommend that those who are engaged in the pig business should be given the right to register all pigs in the Colony to help the smaller producer."

The Chairman gave his opinion that it should be possible for the small breeder to produce a superior stock except for the large breeder. As present breeders appeared to be out of touch with farmers who related to very good stock and he hoped the League would bring the two parties together.

Mr. Jenkins (Livestock Officer) gave the Conference some sets of figures for the cost of production of pigs under different conditions. From his observations with regard to the breeding system in the Colony, showing the total weight cost per lb. under different systems of management as 41 cents and 41 cents where all food was purchased at present prices these costs were increased to 65, 60 and 48 cents per lb. dead weight respectively.

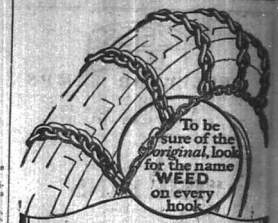

It can be said that the Model A Ford Motor car like the Austin, have created their own market. HOW TO CELLULOSE A CAR WITH PROFESSIONAL ASSISTANCE.

The Most Satisfactory Method.

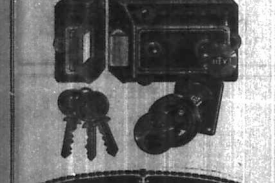
